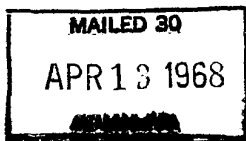

On 4/11/68, SA KENNETH J. HASER was advised that no record of ERIC STARVO GALT or ERNEST GALT could be located in the files of the Office of Security, the general correspondence files or the Visa Office, Department of State. A check was also made on 4/11/68, of the files of the Passport Office, Department of State concerning KARL GALT with negative results.

It is noted that the Visa Office, Department of State maintains records on fewer than 1% of all U.S. visas issued throughout the world. Visa records are maintained in the issuing Embassies or Consulates abroad, nonimmigrant files being retained for 4 years after issue and immigrant files, 16 months, and then destroyed.

From a review of passport files in the surname of GALT, it was noted that several such individuals were born in England or Scotland; it is also felt that there are several GALT families in Pennsylvania of German descent. It is, therefore, suggested that the Bureau consider having Legats London and Bonn check with the Embassies there in an effort to locate a visa file on suspect GALT.

MARRELL ~~MC~~ COLLOUGH, MALE NEGRO, RESIDENT TWO SEVEN ZERO GASTON, APT. SIX, MEMPHIS, EMPLOYED AS WAREHOUSEMAN AND WHO HAD BEEN DOING VOLUNTEER WORK WITH SCLC AND RELATED SANITATION STRIKE SUPPORT GROUPS IN MEMPHIS, ADVISED IN INTERVIEW NIGHT OF APRIL ELEVEN, LAST, THAT HE WAS STANDING ON PARKING LOT OF LORRAINE MOTEL ON EVENING OF APRIL FOUR, LAST. HE SAW DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING STANDING ON BALCONY OF SECOND FLOOR OF MOTEL LOOKING IN WESTERLY DIRECTION. MC COLLOUGH HEARD AN EXPLOSIVE SOUND OR GUNSHOT, AND SAW KING FALLING BACKWARDS. IMMEDIATELY MC COLLOUGH LOOKED WEST TOWARD REAR OF BUILDINGS IN FOUR HUNDRED BLOCK OF SOUTH MAIN ST. SAC Hitt was telephonically advised of information developed by the Newark Office. Hitt was instructed to send some Agents and survey the situation at the address of 113 14th Street, Northeast, in Atlanta to determine the feasibility of conducting a raid to locate Galt.

SAC Hitt advised the Bureau at 2:15 a. m. , that a survey of the neighborhood had been conducted and it would practically be impossible to conduct a raid at this time. He pointed out that 113 14th Street, Northeast, is a four-story house with 30 to 40 rooms. It joins the house next door which is approximately the same size. He pointed out that this is in the middle of the "hippie" section and there is a nightclub next door which is the hangout for the hippies. The nightclub is known as the "Catacomb." He stated that as of 1:30 a. m. , it was as busy as the middle of the day with about 50 to 100 people milling around in the house.

ACTION:

Atlanta will contact the owner of the house and the mailman in order to determine the identities of the individuals residing at this address. Agents will not mention the name of the subject.

In view of the nature of the neighborhood and the necessity of being discreet in covering this matter, SAC Hitt was authorized to use surveillance truck to observe the residence in question.

The Civil Rights Section of the Investigative Division has requested we make an effort to compare the name "Harvey Lowmyer," signed by the subject on the invoice for a Remington Model 760 rifle purchased in Birmingham, Alabama, on 3/29/68, with signatures appearing on fingerprint cards of suspects. Even though the name "Harvey Lowmyer" is not comparable with the fingerprint card signatures of most of the suspects, a detailed analysis has been made of the writings, looking toward any similar individual letters that might at least furnish some indication or direction. Based on this survey, it has been noted there are a few similar letters appearing in the signature of one "Bobby Ray Graves" when compared with the questioned "Harvey Lowmyer" signature. These similarities are largely pictorial and their significance cannot really be assessed because of the limited nature of the material involved. In addition, it should be noted that Graves is listed as being 6'1" to 6'2" tall with weight of 185 lbs., whereas the composite description of the suspect seems to indicate he is about 5'8" tall and weighing 150 to 160 lbs. It should be further noted that Graves' fingerprints have been compared with the unidentified latents and found to be not identical.

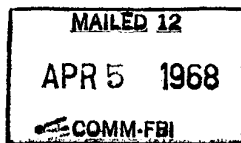

Springfield PD this date advised ALLEN RICHARD THAYER in custody, and that he fits general description of individual who shot MARTIN LUTHER KING, Jr. THAYER interviewed this date by Bureau Agents and advised he could not account for his whereabouts on the pertinent dates as pertained to this case. He did advise, however, that he had been traveling across the United States for several weeks and that to the best of his knowledge he was in Denver, Colorado, on the day that he heard that KING had been assassinated. THAYER advised at no time was he in Alabama or Tennessee this year. THAYER and companion traveling in 1959 gold Chevrolet.

THAYER is described as 5'11", 155 pounds, dark brown hair, combed straight back; blue eyes; complexion, dark; tattoo, skull and crossbones left forearm; previous arrests, armed robbery, Ontario Canada, breaking and entering, Hartford, Connecticut; DOB [redacted] at Bristol, Connecticut.

THAYER advised he knows nothing concerning the murder of KING nor has he any animosities toward KING. Springfield PD filed charges against THAYER for defrauding an innkeeper.

Dear Sir:

This letter comes in regard to the assassination of Martin Luther King.

Several of us were talking coming from church this morning, and some of the thoughts I believe may give some leads to different clues to the situation.

The T.V. has indicated nothing except a white man is being sought, even sketches have pictured a white man or men. This may be a means to an end of deceiving, making your investigation more secretative, which it should be. But this is not my point.

King was the only one of the main leaders that stood for non-violence. Carmichael SP?, Rap Brown etc are all for violence. They have separated in their mission, and no doubt anxious to get rid of King. Carmichael has told the colored here in D. C. to get their guns and kill the people, while some little time ago Brown told them to burn the city down.

This being the case there is a great possibility that a colored person shot King; could have been one of Carmichael's followers. 2

Since this thought has been brought to our thinking, I have a different reaction to his last speech, also to the words spoken by his wife yesterday over T. V.

King thinks he has died as a martyr, and has left that impression on the world and for History.

I have a few questions which I wish to ask for consideration.

1. Was King staying in a colored section of Memphis and was the hotel run by colored? 44-38861-816
 2. Was the rooming house across the street where king was staying operated by colored?
 3. Was the manager reliable and trustworthy? Was he free from taking bribes? APR 15 1968
 4. Assuming the manager was colored, did he not have any suspicion of the white man he rented to? Did not the unusual exacting requirements of the out look and conditions of the room cause any suspicion? (Note: the face of the man could have been changed by treatment of same).
 5. Are we sure no one else was in the room with the man under discussion?

6. Is it not uncanny that a man planning the assassination would have with him any belongings that there was a possibility of being left behind? Could not this be an act to mislead?

7. Has the thought of the possibilities of many bribes entering into this been considered fully? they could have started from the top on down.

8. If King was so confident that his life was at stake, why did not his followers make some attempts to guard him?

9. Why was King standing on the balcony before leaving, if this was not preconceived? A person intending to kill him would have been watching for him to come out of the front door. Tis true some may say he had stepped out to see if his car had come for him, some one else could have checked on this. The words spoken and the placement of the car could easily have been prearranged.

King knew he could not controll a mob such as he planned to have assemble in the Nation's Capitol. He knew the extent things would go. His wish was no doubt to think he was dying as (supposedly) a martyr, than to continue with what he knew ~~lie~~ ahead of him, and the City.

His defiance of any court or law that could stop his planned march was a step to far.

I do hope these remarks and questions will be of some small assistance. Our Nation and the world are in such a dreadful condition, we feel we do want to help in some way.

History repeats itself. The Bible is the inspired Word of God, and this can be the end, but I want to do what I can and pray for a better tomorrow. We can be so grateful though that this world is not our home, but Jesus has gone to prepare a place for all those who have accepted Him as their Saviour. This is our only real Hope.

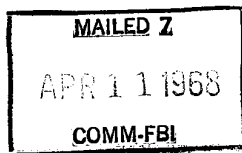
