INFORMATION CONCERNING HIS ENTIRE MINUTEMEN ACTIVITIES  
FROM LATE NINETEEN SIXTY SIX UNTIL HE LEFT MINUTEMEN IN  
THE LATTER PART OF DECEMBER, NINETEEN SIXTY SEVEN.

WHEN HE BECAME A MEMBER OF NATIONAL HEADQUARTERS, WHICH WAS AFTER THE PATRIOTIC PARTY CONVENTION IN JULY, NINETEEN SIXTY SEVEN, HE HEARD FROM A NUMBER OF MINUTEMEN IN THE HIGHER ECHELON, INCLUDING ROBERT DE PUGH, WALTER PEYSON, ROBERT BAGWELL, JERRY MILTON BROOKS, AND OTHERS THAT THE MINUTEMEN HAD A PLAN TO PLACE CYANIDE GAS INTO THE AIR CONDITIONING SYSTEM AT THE UNITED NATIONS BUILDING IN NEW YORK CITY. THIS PLAN WAS OFTEN MENTIONED TO THE POINT WHERE IT WAS CONSIDERED A JOKE AMONG THE MINUTEMEN WHEN THEY WOULD TALK ABOUT WHAT THEY WERE GOING TO DO WHEN "THE FIGHTING STARTED." HE HAD NO ADDITIONAL INFORMATION AS TO HOW OR WHEN THIS WOULD BE DONE.

DURING OCTOBER, NINETEEN SIXTY SEVEN, DE PUGH ORDERED DE PALMA TO LOCATE HOUSE WHICH COULD BE USED AS A HIDE OUT. DE PALMA LOCATED SAME WHICH HE STATED WAS IN A TOWN CALLED PLATT, WHICH HE STATED IS IN THE NORTHERN PART OF KANSAS CITY WHICH HE ALSO REFERRED TO AS NORTH KANSAS CITY. HE FURNISHED COMPLETE INFORMATION AS TO HOW TO LOCATE THIS HOUSE. DE PALMA STATED DE PUGH WANTED THIS HIDE OUT IN ORDER TO KIDNAP THE U.S. ATTORNEY OF KANSAS CITY, BRING

HIM TO THIS HOUSE FOR QUESTIONING, TORTURE AND ULTIMATE KILLING. DE PALMA STATED THE USA WAS SURVEILLED ON SEVERAL OCCASIONS AND ONE PLAN WAS TO ABDUCT HIM WHILE HE WAS DRIVING HOME. THE SECOND PLAN WAS TO KILL HIM BY PLACING A BOMB IN HIS CAR AT HOME. NEITHER PLAN WAS ABLE TO BE COMPLETED AND HE HEARD NO ADDITIONAL PLANS OTHER THAN THE FACT THAT IF DE PUGH WAS ARRESTED THE USA, AS WELL AS A&T SPECIAL INVESTIGATORS FRANK BELECKY AND JAMES MOORE, FBI SA ARNETT, J. WHITE, KANSAS CITY RADIO STATION EMPLOYEE, WERE TO BE KILLED.

DE PALMA STATED THAT DE PUGH TOLD HIM THAT IN THE EVENT THERE IS NOT A SUFFICIENT RACIAL RIOT CONDITION IN THE UNITED STATES TO START A REVOLUTION, THE MINUTEMEN WOULD CREATE A REVOLUTIONARY CONDITION BY ASSASSINATING RAP BROWN, MARTIN LUTHER KING AND STOKELY CARMICHAEL. THEY FIGURED THAT THE REVOLUTION WOULD START WITH THE COMING SUMMER, NINETEEN SIXTY EIGHT, RIOTS AND THIS IS THE TIME THE MINUTEMEN WOULD TAKE ACTION WITH THE ULTIMATE GOAL OF TAKING OVER THE GOVERNMENT. DE PUGH ALSO MENTIONED SEVERAL PRIME TARGETS FOR STRIKE TEAMS IN THE LINE OF ASSASSINATION.

ONE OF THE TARGETS MENTIONED WAS THE NINE SUPREME COURT JUDGES. FURTHER, THAT IN CASE OF A NUCLEAR ATTACK OR A CHAOTIC CONDITION IN THE COUNTRY THAT A RELOCATION CENTER FOR THE PRESIDENT, VICE PRESIDENT AND THE CABINET WOULD BE GEORGETOWN, COLORADO. AT LEAST ONE STRIKE TEAM WAS TO BE SENT TO GEORGETOWN, COLORADO, TO ASSASSINATE THEM. DE PUGH THEN STATED THAT WITH THE ASSASSINATION OF THE PRESIDENT, THE SUPREME COURT JUDGES AND THE CABINET HE AND THE "EXECUTIVE COUNCIL" OF MINUTEMEN WOULD THEN MOVE IN TO MAINTAIN ORDER IN THE GOVERNMENT UNTIL A GOVERNMENTAL BODY COULD BE FORMED FROM THE PATRIOTIC PARTY. DE PALMA STATED THAT THERE IS NO EXECUTIVE COUNCIL OF THE MINUTEMEN AND THAT DE PUGH HIMSELF IS THE "EXECUTIVE COUNCIL."

~~XUMXWENING~~ ~~FORATIVEN~~ ASSASSINATION OF NEW YORK ATTORNEY GENERAL LEFKOWITZ, DE PALMA STATED THAT LEFKOWITZ WOULD BE IN THE SAME ASSASSINATION GROUP AS MARTIN LUTHER KING, RAP BROWN AND STOKELY CARMICHAEL.

CONCERNING MONTANA, DE PALMA STATED THAT SHORTLY AFTER HE GOT INTO THE "INNER CIRCLE," BELIEVED TO BE ABOUT SEPTEMBER, NINETEEN SIXTY SEVEN, DE PUGH TOLD HIM BRIEFLY

ABOUT A BUNKER IN A NATIONAL FOREST IN MONTANA, PLACE NOT SPECIFIED. HE STATED IT WAS BUILT INTO THE SIDE OF A HILL AND THE INTERIOR APPROXIMATELY EIGHT BY TEN FEET. HE STATED THIS BUNKER HAD BEEN IN EXISTANCE FOR APPROXIMATELY TWO YEARS AND HAD BEEN MANNED CONSTANTLY DURING THIS PERIOD BY TWO MEN. THIS BUNKER IS ALLEGEDLY ONE AND ONE HALF DAY HIKE FROM CLOSEST ROAD. DE PUGH STATED THAT IN THE EVENT "WE" WOULD HAVE TO HIDE THIS WAS A LOGICAL SPOT AS IT HAD "EVERYTHING WE COULD POSSIBLY NEED." DE PALMA SAID HE ONLY MET ONE MINUTEMAN FROM MONTANA AT A TRAINING SESSION IN INDEPENDENCE, MISSOURI, IN JULY, NINETEEN SIXTY SEVEN, AND HE DOES NOT KNOW HIS IDENTITY. HE DOES NOT KNOW ANY MINUTEMEN FROM IDAHO NOR ANY BUNKERS IN IDAHO THAT ARE CURRENTLY OR HAVE BEEN IN EXISTANCE.

DE PALMA, ROY BRANSON AND MIKE LNU ATTEMPTED TO BUILD A BUNKER NEAR PARIS, IDAHO, IN NOVEMBER, NINETEEN SIXTY SEVEN, WITHOUT SUCCESS DUE TO EXTREME WEATHER.

DE PALMA STATED HE WAS FIRST ADVISED OF CONTEMPLATED BANK ROBBERIES BY DE PUGH AND PEYSON SHORTLY AFTER HE WAS ACCEPTED INTO THE INNER GROUP.

DE PUGH ORDERED ROY BRANSON AND DE PALMA TO GO TO SALT LAKE CITY ABOUT THE MIDDLE OF NOVEMBER, NINETEEN SIXTY SEVEN. ON THANKSGIVING DAY, NINETEEN SIXTY SEVEN, THEY WERE JOINED AT SALT LAKE CITY BY WALLY AND LINDA PEYSON AND MIKE LNU. AFTER PURCHASING GEAR FOR THE TRIP TO IDAHO, THE FIVE LEFT FOR IDAHO TO BUILD THE BUNKER. AFTER REMAINING IN THIS AREA ABOUT FIVE DAYS THEY RETURNED TO SALT LAKE CITY AND BRANSON LEFT THE GROUP.

PEYSON HAD BEEN DISCUSSING WITH DE PALMA ABOUT THE "OLD MAN." THIS TURNED OUT TO BE A HOUSE AT SALT LAKE CITY THAT HAD BEEN RENTED BY PEYSON AND MIKE LNU. DE PALMA DESCRIBED THIS HOUSE AS FOLLOWS:

HEADING NORTH OUT OF SALT LAKE CITY THERE IS A FOUR LANE EXPRESSWAY. THIS GOES PAST TWO OIL REFINERIES LOCATED ON THE LEFT SIDE OF THE HIGHWAY. GOING ON THIS HIGHWAY THERE IS A SERVICE ROAD ON THE RIGHT HAND SIDE. PROCEED ON THIS EXPRESSWAY UNTIL YOU COME TO THE SECOND OIL REFINERY WHICH HE BELIEVES IS CHEVRON OIL REFINERY. JUST BEYOND AND POSSIBLY ONE EIGHTH MILE ON THE RIGHT HAND SIDE OF THE EXPRESSWAY AND ON THE RIGHT HAND SIDE OF THE SERVICE

ROAD IS A WHITE HOUSE SETTING OFF THE EXPRESSWAY ABOUT ONE HUNDRED TWENTY FEET. IT IS A RANCH TYPE HOUSE WITH THREE AND ONE HALF TO FOUR ROOMS. DIRECTLY BEHIND THE HOUSE IS A BIG GRAVEL BANK WITH A NUMBER OF PIECES OF HEAVY CONSTRUCTION AND EARTH MOVING EQUIPMENT. JUST BEYOND THE HOUSE THE SERVICE ROAD REJOINS THE EXPRESSWAY. WHEN HE WAS THERE THERE WAS A SIGN ON THE FRONT OF THE HOUSE WHICH SAID "TOPAZ MINING COMPANY." ATTACHED TO THE HOUSE WAS

A ONE CAR GARAGE AND PARKED IN FRONT OF THE HOUSE WAS A WHITE MILK TRUCK WHICH BELONGED TO MIKE LNU AND HAD KANSAS LICENSE PLATES. DE PALMA STATED THAT INSIDE THE HOUSE HE SAW THE MULTIGRAPH MACHINE WHICH HAD PREVIOUSLY BEEN IN INDEPENDENCE, MISSOURI, AND A PAD LOCKED CLOSET WHERE NUMEROUS RIFLES, SOME OF WHICH HAD TELESCOPIC SIGHTS MOUNTED THEREON AND MANY UNMOUNTED TELESCOPIC SIGHTS, HANDGUNS, DYNAMITE, BLASTING CAPS, PULL IGNITERS, PRIMER CORD, FUSES MINUTEMEN SUBVERSIVE FILE AND MINUTEMEN TRAINING LITERATURE WERE LOCATED.

DE PALMA DOES NOT KNOW WHAT HAPPENED TO THIS MATERIAL SINCE HE LEFT SALT LAKE CITY DURING THE EARLY PART OF

DECEMBER, NINETEEN SIXTY SEVEN.

DE PALMA STATE THAT DURING THE PERIOD THAT HE WAS IN SALT LAKE CITY ON THIS OCCASION PEYSON LEFT FOR ABOUT THREE DAYS STATING HE HAD BUSINESS IN SEATTLE, WASHINGTON.

DISCREPANCIES AND/OR OMISSIONS BETWEEN STATEMENTS FURNISHED BY DE PALMA TO ATTD ON JANUARY SEVENTEEN, NINETEEN SIXTY EIGHT AND INFORMATION FURNISHED BY HIM TO THE BUREAU ON APRIL EIGHT LAST, RESOLVED. DE PALMA COULD FURNISH NO INFORMATION CONCERNING MURKIN.

DE PALMA HAS ADVISED HE HAS NO OBJECTION TO THE DISCLOSURE OF HIS IDENTITY AND IS WILLING TO TESTIFY AGAINST DE PUGH AND WALLY PEYSON IF NEEDED. FOR INFORMATION BUREAU AND BOSTON, DE PALMA DEPARTED NEW HAVEN THIS DATE FOR RETURN TO NEWPORT, RHODE ISLAND, AND ADVISED SHOULD HE CHANGE LOCATION OR ADDRESS HE WILL EITHER NOTIFY AGENTS IN PROVIDENCE RA OR NEW HAVEN AGENTS THROUGH HIS MOTHER IN BRISTOL, CONNECTICUT.

SUBJECT: MURKIN

A search of Bureau indices on the name Harvey Lowmyer and Harvey Lowmeyer along with numerous variations of the last name, <sup>MADE</sup> was in an effort to identify the individual who purchased the suspected murder weapon in this case. All references obtained were reviewed for possible suspects. Based on this review, the following three possible suspects were obtained and their names searched in the Identification Division files for fingerprint records:

Memorandum of S. F. Latona to Mr. Trotter dated 4/11/68 captioned "Murkin" advised that fingerprints of Henry G. Lohmeier and Donald Everett Lohmeyer were not identical to any of the unidentified latent fingerprints in this case. This memorandum further advised that in searching the name John Lohmeyer through Identification Division files, nine individuals with the name John Lohmeyer with various middle names were turned up and prints of each of these nine individuals were compared against the unidentified latent prints in this case with negative results.

General Investigative Division Extra-Duty Supervisor O. L. Dobbs was advised at 11:30 p. m. , 4-13-68, by the Jacksonville Office that the Jacksonville Police Department arrested Clyde (NMN) Courtney at 7:40 p. m. , 4-13-68, for vagrancy and called the FBI as Courtney resembles artist's sketch of King's killer published in crime magazine. Courtney was interviewed by Special Agent Honeter of the Jacksonville Office.

Courtney is described as a white male, age 33, born Louisville, Kentucky, on [redacted] five feet nine inches, 131 pounds, brown eyes, dark brown or black hair, receding hairline at temples, slender build, sharp features, social security number [redacted] previous arrests: about eight years ago, Louisville, Kentucky, charged for accessory before and after armed robbery, received three years, served 17 months and paroled, presently off parole. Courtney doesn't own a car. His California driver's license was taken away three years ago due to accident in Loma Linda, California. In August, 1967, he was residing with his sister, Mrs. G. E. Smith, 3198 Cannes Street, Riverside, California, and employed by his brother-in-law, G. E. Smith as a Plumber's Helper. Smith is Plumber employed by a sub-contractor, name unknown, but has service agreement with Sears for plumbing work.

Courtney left Riverside, California, in November, 1967, with Smith in Smith's car. They arrived at Courtney's mother's home, 1012 Winkler Avenue, Louisville, Kentucky, (Mother - Mrs. Lula Sensabough) prior to Thanksgiving, 1967. Courtney lived with his mother and was employed as a janitor at St. Anthony's Hospital and Jefferson Community College, Louisville, Kentucky, under the supervision of a Mr. Kramer at both places. Kramer left St. Anthony's Hospital and went to college to work and Courtney went with him. Courtney left Louisville, Kentucky,

at 6:00 a. m. , 4-3-68, with a neighbor, (FNU) James, 1010 Winkler Avenue, Louisville, Kentucky. They drove to Cordelle, Georgia, and arrived 6:00 p. m. , 4-3-68. Courtney registered at Peaceful Motel, Cordelle, Georgia, and he had some pay slips showing he was working for above firms but complete period not covered. He had a letter from District Attorney, Domestic Relations Court, San Bernardino, California, addressed to Courtney at mother's address postmarked February, 1968. He is separated from his wife and agreed to pay \$70 a month support.

Courtney stated that on the evening of 4-4-68, (no exact time recalled) he was at Mr. Pullman's Bar five miles outside of Cordelle, Georgia, with Mr. C. H. Massey, a carpenter who resides on 10th Street, Vienna, Georgia, when they heard about King's death. He was with Massey nearly every day. At 6:00 p. m. , 4-8-68, he left by bus from Vienna, Georgia, and arrived Jacksonville, Florida, 4-9-68, at 6:00 a. m. He stayed at city mission a couple of nights and at 41 West Beaver Street with a friend on the night of 4-12-68. Courtney stated he was arrested by Jacksonville Police Department when he was found hitchhiking on highway to New Orleans. He has a job to work on an oil rig in the Gulf of Mexico. The oil company furnishes room and board and he only had a nickel in his pocket. He had a paper bag with some clothing, including a shirt used when he was a janitor, pants or trousers, etc.

Press inquiries at Jacksonville answered "No apparent connection with King murder."

Eric Galt, the prime suspect who resembles the artist's conception of the subject, owns a white Mustang, was in Memphis 4/3-4/68, and whose handwriting resembles the subject's, continues to be a mystery man. He is known to have lived in Birmingham from September to December, 1967, and to have been in a Memphis motel 4/3-4/68, but no other record of his existence has yet been found. All offices are continuing an extensive search of every logical source for some reference to this individual.

It is noted that Galt claimed to have been a "barger" working on Mississippi River barges between St. Louis and New Orleans. Many small companies operate such barges and all are being contacted as quickly as possible. We have been advised, however, that seamen working on the barges never refer to themselves as "bargers" but that this is a European term. Despite the fact that Galt has been described as having a Texas or western accent, full consideration is being given to the possibility that he is not a native American and appropriate checks are being made including records of Immigration and Naturalization Service, Passport and Visa Office of the State Department, and other such repositories of information concerning foreign nationals in the United States.

All offices are arranging for local law enforcement agencies to issue all point bulletins on Galt's automobile in order that he may be quickly located for questioning. *Teletype being sent through for approval.*

A full description of Galt's Mustang automobile has been entered in the National Crime Information Center so that we will be immediately aware if any inquiry is made concerning this car by any law enforcement agencies in the country. *44-38861-859*

There has been recent press publicity regarding an alleged search for King's killer in Mexico. We have made no such search. It is noted, however, that Legat, Mexico City advised that Mexico City Police, on the basis of an alleged resemblance of Claude Chester McLaren, Jr., to an artist's conception of the subject, questioned him as he was boarding a plane 4/8/68 in Mexico City to travel to Houston. McLaren identified himself as employed by a firm in Venezuela. He had traveled from New Orleans to Honduras 3/30/68 and entries on his passport verified this fact. McLaren was photographed by the Mexicans, and although it appears that he was out of the country during the pertinent period, his photograph is being obtained to display to pertinent witnesses.

It is noted that the subject, when purchasing the rifle in Birmingham, paid for it with \$20 bills, and the suspect who rented a room in the flophouse in Memphis from which the fatal shot was fired also paid for his room rent with a \$20 bill. The landlady at the flophouse furnished three \$20 bills, one of which was given to her by the suspect, but she does not know which of the three bills was received from him. The binoculars purchased in Memphis 4/4/68 were also paid for with \$20 bills. The individual using the name Galt, when he purchased the white Mustang in Birmingham, also paid in cash with \$100 and \$20 bills. The serial numbers of the \$20 bills obtained from the landlady are being processed in the National Crime Information Center to determine whether this money may have been bait money from a bank robbery or otherwise recorded as stolen property.

The Philadelphia Office determined that Barclay Laundry, 253 South Tenth Street, Philadelphia, has used a laundry tag such as the one found on clothing abandoned near the crime scene with the rifle which is believed to be the murder weapon. The Barclay Laundry last used such a tag 12/19/67 for the laundry of one Fred Neibauer, a Philadelphia school teacher residing at 2213 Spruce Street, Philadelphia, whose Social Security No. is [redacted]

No pertinent information concerning Neibauer could be located in Bureau files and no record for him could be located in the Identification Division. (Laboratory examination has now eliminated the Philadelphia laundry.)

Extensive publicity is currently being given to a suspect reported by the Mexican Consulate in Memphis who allegedly is being sought in Mexico. This concerns one John Scott Candrian a 22-year-old Memphis State University student who resides in Chicago and who obtained a tourist card to visit Mexico from the Consulate in Memphis on 4/3/68. He indicated he intended to enter Mexico 4/13/68. It is known that Candrian entered Mexico through Arizona on 4/10/68. He is due to return to Memphis State University when classes resume after Easter vacation on 4/15/68. Candrian does not fit the description of the subject and there is no evidence to connect him with this case. We have not sought his whereabouts in Mexico but in view of the publicity being afforded this individual, he is being thoroughly processed to eliminate any possibility of his involvement.

With regard to reports of false police radio broadcasts following the shooting of King, we were previously advised by the Memphis Police Department that approximately thirty minutes after King was shot a man with a Citizens Band radio in his car flagged down a Memphis police car and called attention to broadcasts being received on his Citizens Band radio from an unidentified person who claimed he was following a white Mustang occupied by three persons. The unknown broadcaster gave a running description of the route allegedly being taken by the Mustang and toward the end of the transmission claimed that the Mustang had just gone through a red light at the main intersection of Raleigh, Tennessee, at 95 miles an hour. Police contacted the Sheriff's office in Raleigh who advised that two Sheriff's units were at the intersection and no such incident had occurred. The unknown broadcaster was never identified and police considered the broadcast to be a hoax. Full consideration is being given to the possibility that the subject was broadcasting over the Citizens Band for the purpose of drawing police on to a false trail.

All investigation is being expedited and you will be kept advised of developments.
