Mrs. Itayem declared she had observed an artist's sketch of the suspected slayer of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., which she stated appeared in the 4/13/68, edition of "The Washington Post." According to Mrs. Itayem, this sketch closely resembled a man who knocked on her apartment door two or three months ago trying to locate someone in her building. This man wore a black trench coat and at the time Mrs. Itayem thought he possibly was a seaman. She felt that this man probably frequented the 9th Street - New York Avenue northwest area and wished to bring this fact to the Bureau's attention. Mrs. Itayem was thanked for her information. *e*

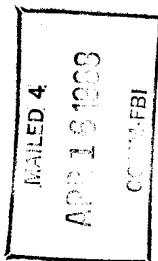
