ASSASSINATION OF REV. MARTIN LUTHER KING APRIL 4, 1968

The following information originated with the Criminal Police in Utrecht, Netherlands and was passed to us today through the Security Officer of the American Embassy in The Hague, Netherlands.

GREET SHOWS OTHER AVISE.

On April 8, 1968, a Dutch citizen, FREDERIK JOHANNES KOEK, residing in Ijsselstein, The Netherlands, reported to the Utrecht District Office of the Dutch Federal Police the following:

On April 6, 1968, KOEK viewed a Dutch television program dealing with the Rev. KING's assassination. Part of the program were scenes, apparently from television clips or from movie film, of a meeting addressed by Rev. KING on the evening prior to the assassination. The film showed scenes of the audience, which were seated and apparently Shortly thereafter, KOEK noted in the April 6, 1968 edition of the Dutch newspaper "Het Parool" the artist's drawing of the suspected assassin. He felt there was a strong resemblance between that drawing and a man he had noted in the audience on the TV program. The Dutch Police obtained the TV clip and made enlargements of two views of the audience, including the man in question and two enlarged views of the man himself.






