LEVIN who formerly operated the Astor Launderers, Cincinnati, Ohio, as of February, 1964 was residing or employed at 3527 Mill Pond Road, Charlotte, North Carolina. Another entry on the record indicates that as of December, 1964, LEVIN was operating the Imperial Draperies Cleaners no location shown but believed to be Charlotte.

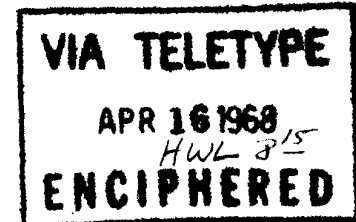

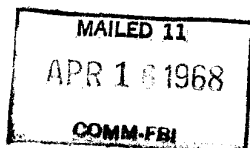

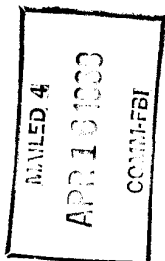
