On 4/11/68 Dr. IRVING HALL, 712 39th Street W., Bradenton, Fla., telephonically advised the Sarasota RA that between the hours of approximately 8:00 and 10:00 p.m. 4/7/68 he and his wife viewed a television program over channel 3, educational television station WEDU-TV, Tampa, Florida. HALL stated the program was a panel-type discussion concerning the study of the march on Washington that was to be lead by Rev. MARTIN LUTHER KING in the Spring of 1968. HALL stated a white male who was a member of the panel who was sitting on the floor near a Negro who was standing and who was the moderator made several comments that dealt with KING leading the march. The white male, according to HALL, reportedly made a comment to the effect, "If KING leads the march on Washington the march will be a Negro march and the poor white people will be getting screwed."

HALL stated that upon viewing the artist's conception of the assassin of KING and comparing the description that had been set forth in local newspapers regarding the assassin, he believes the white male on the above television program who made remarks critical of KING's leadership appeared a similar description to the artist's conception of the assassin.

on 4/7/68 his channel experienced a live interconnection which was broadcast in the Tampa area under the auspices of Public Broadcast Laboratory which program originates from New York City and which the local station would not have any record of on radio or TV tape. He said that all he could say was the FBI would have to contact "AV" WESTIN, Director, Public Broadcast Laboratory, 342 Madison Avenue, New York City, and they would have the film. He volunteered the information that he recalled Public Broadcast Laboratory sent a crew along with Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING some time in the past sort of following his career and were closely following any plans to march on Washington. He said he personally had no way of even knowing in what cities or where the panel discussion took place that was broadcast on the night of 4/7/68 through his Channel 3 station.

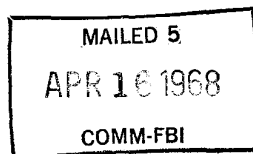

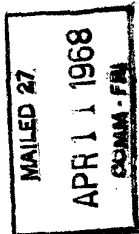

The Laboratory has determined that laundry tags on clothing believed to have been abandoned by the subject are similar in all respects to laundry tags used by the Home Service Laundry and Dry Cleaning Company, 5280 Hollywood Boulevard, Los Angeles, although it cannot be definitely stated that the tags in question were made by this laundry's marking machine.

Lucy Pinela, present manager of Home Laundry and Dry Cleaning, believes she has seen undershorts of the type in question and says the laundry tag in question would have been used sometime after mid-February, 1968; however, all records, as well as tools, were removed by Jay Wallis Vernon, also known as Jerome Wallis Vernon, former manager who operated the laundry until 3/24/68 and last appeared at the laundry 3/27/68.

The laundry Vernon managed is about five blocks from the Rompage Hardware Store which has been identified as the source of a pair of pliers believed to have been ~~abandoned by the~~ killer.

Vernon has FBI number 743-226 B and his fingerprints are not identical with any of the latent prints developed in this case. His handwriting is not identical with the handwriting in this case.

Vernon was born [redacted] at Pampa, Texas, and was a Bureau Army Deserter Fugitive in 1953 after he failed to re-en to his duty station, Fort Campbell, Kentucky, as ordered. He surrendered to the Sheriff's Office, Craig, Colorado, 10/25/53. He became a Bureau Air Force Deserter Fugitive when he deserted from Mather Air Force Base, California, in 1963 and he was arrested by FBI Agents, 10/18/63 at Las Vegas.

Vernon has been on probation since 8/31/67 on a local forgery charge. He purchased the Home Service Laundry 1/15/68 and removed all cash and records, 3/25/68, failing to keep an appointment the same day to discuss payment for the laundry with the former owner. Although his present whereabouts are not yet known he has been placed in Los Angeles on 4/6/68.

The white Mustang owned by Eric S. Galt was located in Atlanta, 4/11/68, as a result of an inquiry made by local authorities to the FBI National Crime Information Center. The car was in the parking area of a low class white housing project adjacent to the intersection of Memorial Drive and Connally Street. The project has 795 apartments containing a total of 3,245 rooms.

Investigation established that the car was parked in Atlanta between 8:30 a. m. and 9:00 a. m., 4/5/68, by a white male, 5' 11", 165 pounds, neatly dressed in a suit, possibly blue. He walked away after locking the car. He had no hat, did not wear glasses, and carried no luggage. One witness saw him refer to a small notebook about three by five inches in size.

When Galt purchased this car in Birmingham, 8/30/67, the odometer reading was about 20,000; it is now 39,100. Stickers on the car show it was serviced by Cort Fox Ford Company, Hollywood, California, no date given; was serviced by Beckman Chevron Service, Los Angeles, 2/13/68, mileage: 34185; and an official Mexican tourist sticker indicates the car has been in Mexico.

In the trunk were various items of clothing and bedding, four floor mats, an air filter cartridge, a hunting knife and tools. Also found in the trunk was a piece of cardboard torn from a paper tissue box on which is written "Ginger and Anita Katzwinkel, 1535 Surano, Apt. 6." Below the address appear two words believed to be "Olkahombe" and "Broult." The word "day" is written above the words "Ginger and Anita."

The car has been completely processed for latent fingerprints and has been minutely examined in all respects. All items from the car are presently being examined in the Laboratory and Identification Division at Washington.

Records of an apartment house located at 1535 North Serrano, Los Angeles, show that Galt paid rent in cash for an apartment at this address for the months of November and December, 1967. When the receiver for the apartments went to collect rent approximately 1/18/68, Galt had left the premises. He received a letter from Galt dated 1/21/68, postmarked in Los Angeles 1/22/68, which stated, "Dear Sir, I am writing to inform you that I moved from the apt. I informed the original manager so I am enclosing the keys. I made a deposit on keys but as I lost one will forfeit deposit. Sincerely." The letter was signed Eric S. Galt. This letter is being flown to the FBI Laboratory.

Apartment six at the above address is presently rented to Jennie Morgan who has lived there since 2/12/68. She has no knowledge of Galt or the Katzwinkels. The information operator at Los Angeles reported a listing for Anita Katzwinkel, 1831 North Gramercy Place, but it has been determined this telephone was disconnected 4/8/68. The cross listing directory shows Anita Katzwinkel as residing in apartment 303. This apartment was occupied by Mr. and Mrs. Thomas M. Flikeid beginning in October, 1967. They paid rent 4/1/68 saying they were moving within thirty days and on 4/5/68 the manager found a note in the apartment indicating they had moved out.

Every possible lead is being immediately covered in Los Angeles to locate the Katzwinkels and to develop further information on Galt. Atlanta is also making every possible effort to trace Galt's movements.

There is no record of Ginger or Anita Katzwinkel in Bureau indices or the Identification Division.

CAS STATION, DEFENSE ATTACHE, DEPARTMENT OF NATIONAL INVESTIGATIONS (DNI), DOMINICAN NATIONAL POLICE - SECRET SERVICE SECTION DOMINICAN IMMIGRATION CHIEF, DOM TWO, DOM ELEVEN, DOM ONE NINE, AND PSI WILLIAM R. KING. THEIR AND LEGAT'S COMMENTS IN SUMMARY ARE AS FOLLOWS. (S)

FRANCISCO ALBERTO HENRIQUEZ VASQUEZ AND PERICLES FRANCO ORNES ARE INTELLECTUAL RATHER THAN ACTIVE COMMUNISTS. RECORDS AND SOURCES INDICATE THAT NEITHER HAS BEEN ABROAD FOR MANY MONTHS. THEIR LACK OF INVOLVMENT IN ACTIVITIES MAKES THEIR CONTACT WITH COMMUNIST MEMBERS, REMOTE.

SENSITIVE SOURCES UTILIZED BY DNI, CAS STATION DEFENSE ATTACHE SUGGEST NO MAIL RECEIVED BY EITHER INDICATES POLITICAL CONTACTS OFF THE ISLAND. THESE AGENCIES ADD THAT THESE TWO PERSONS ARE NOT ENGAGED IN ANY RADIO CONTACT ON OR OFF THE ISLAND. (S) (X)

A FIDEL CASTRO SUGGESTED OR DIRECTED ASSASSINATION PLOT INVOLVING SUCH NEWS NOTABLES AS THE VICTIM, STOKELY CARMICHAEL AND H. RAP BROWN WOULD NOT BE MADE KNOWN TO A DOMINICAN PROFESSOR, REMOTE FROM THE SCENE AND WHO IS ONLY INTELLECTUALLY CONNECTED WITH THE CAUSE. (U)

MORE THAN LIKELY HENRIQUEZ AND FRANCO WERE DISCUSSING EVENTS BASED ON PUBLIC SOURCE MATERIAL WHICH HAS BEEN ABUNDANTLY AVAILABLE REGARDING THE HISTORIC ISSUES OF THE PAST WEEKS. THEIR COMMENTS REGARDING THE ALLEGED TRAINING OF CARMICHAEL AND BROWN, IN ADDITION TO THE ALLEGED ADVOCATION OF THE VICTIM'S DEMISE, WOULD APPEAR AS HOPEFUL CONJECTURE. (U)

LEGAT BELIEVES THE FOREGOING TENDS TO DISPROVE HERNAN HENRIQUEZ LORA'S ALLEGATIONS. (U)
