STEIN ADVISED THAT THE FOLLOWING MORNING DECEMBER FIFTEEN, SIXTY SEVEN, GALT PICKED UP STEIN, RITA, AND MARIE AT THE FRANKLIN HOTEL AND TRANSPORTED THEM IN THE WHITE MUSTANG

TO A VOTER'S REGISTRATION PLACE ON LANKERSHIM BLVD., LA. GALT LET THE THREE OF THEM OUT OF CAR IN FRONT OF REGISTRATION PLACE AND THEY WENT INSIDE TO REGISTER. THEY WERE IN PROCESS OF REGISTERING FOR WALLACE'S AMERICAN INDEPENDENT PARTY WHEN GALT ENTERED. STEIN GOT IMPRESSION GALT WAS KNOWN TO PEOPLE IN REGISTRATION OFFICE. GALT SAT BEHIND THEM AND OBSERVED THEIR REGISTRATION. UPON COMPLETION OF REGISTRATION THEY ALL RETURNED TO FIVE SIX SIX SIX FRANKLIN AVE., WHERE RITA AND MARIE DEPARTED. STEIN OBTAINED CLOTHING AT HIS RESIDENCE AND WENT TO GALT'S RESIDENCE ON NORTH SERRANO AND THEN LEFT FOR NEW ORLEANS VIA YUMA, ARIZ, TUSCON, ARIZ, AND EL PASO, TEXAS.

WHILE ENROUTE NEW ORLEANS AND MOSTLY IN TEXAS

GALT MADE SEVERAL PHONE CALLS FROM PAY PHONES TO PARTIES UNKNOWN TO STEIN. GALT DURING TRIP INDICATED THAT HE WAS FROM ALABAMA AND PLANNED TO RETURN.

GALT TOLD STEIN THAT HE RECENTLY RETURNED FROM 'MEXICO' WHERE HE FORMERLY HAD A PART OWNERSHIP OF A BAR WITH A MEXICAN. BAR LOCATED NEAR OCEAN AND HE RECENTLY SOLD OUT TO MEXICAN PARTNER.

IN CONVERSATION WITH GALT, STEIN GOT IMPRESSION THAT GALT WAS INVOLVED IN CAMPAIGN TO NOMINATE GEORGE WALLACE IN CALIFORNIA. GALT INDICATED THAT HE HAD TO CONTACT SOME PEOPLE IN NEW ORLEANS, EITHER AN ENGINEERING FIRM OR CONTRACTING FIRM, STEIN WAS NOT CERTAIN. DURING TRIP STEIN TOOK PHOTOGRAPHS OF COUNTRYSIDE AND POSSIBLY OF GALT, HOWEVER NOT CERTAIN. STEIN FURNISHED THIS UNDEVELOPED FILM TO FBI TO BE DEVELOPED. FILM FORWARDED TO BUREAU ON TWA FLIGHT SIX TWO ARRIVING FRIENDSHIP AIRPORT APRIL FOURTEEN SIX ZERO SEVEN AM.

IN NEW ORLEANS GALT EXPRESSED DESIRE TO STAY AT A MOTEL RATHER THAN AT STEIN'S MOTHER'S RESIDENCE. STEIN DIRECTED GALT TO A MOTEL IN THE ONE THOUSAND BLOCK OF CHARTEN ST., NAME UNKNOWN, BETWEEN URSULINE AND ST PHILLIPS STREETS, NEW ORLEANS. ARRIVED IN NEW ORLEANS ^{DEC}EMBER SEVENTEEN, SIXTY SEVEN, NEVER STOPPING OVERNIGHT ALONG WAY. GALT REGISTERED AT MOTEL AND BOTH PROCEEDED TO STEIN'S MOTHER, CLOVINA ALONZA'S RESIDENCE, ONE NINE ZERO SEVEN AND ONE HALF ROYAL ST., NEW ORLEANS, AND GALT LEFT.

ON DECEMBER EIGHTEEN, SIXTY SEVEN, HE MET GALT ON STREET NEAR ROYAL ST. RESIDENCE GALT STATING THAT HE HAD LOST HIS WAY TO MOTEL. GALT SAID HE HAD CONTACTED THE INDIVIDUALS HE WAS INTERESTED IN AND WAS READY TO RETURN TO LOS ANGELES. GALT LATER SAME DAY TELEPHONED STEIN AND STATED THAT A STORM WAS BLOCKING THEIR ROUTE AND THEY WOULD LEAVE THE FOLLOWING DAY.

STEIN, GALT, AND RITA'S TWO CHILDREN DEPARTED NEW ORLEANS ON DECEMBER NINETEEN, SIXTY SEVEN AND DROVE STRAIGHT THROUGH, STOPPING ONLY FOR FOOD AND GASOLINE.

GALT PAID CASH FOR ALL PURCHASES ON TRIP. HE MADE NO PERSONAL CONTACTS DURING ENTIRE ROUTE. DURING TRIP GALT EXPRESSED VIEW THAT IF NEGROES WANTED TO BE FREE MEN, SHOULD GO NORTH OR WEST, IF THEY WANT TO BE SLAVES SHOULD STAY IN SOUTH.

THEY RETURNED TO LA DECEMBER TWENTY ONE, SIXTY SEVEN, WHERE GALT LEFT STEIN AT FIVE SIX SIX SIX FRANKLIN AVENUE, AND STEIN HASN'T SEEN GALT SINCE.

MARIE MARTIN ADVISED SHE TRADED TV SETS WITH GALT DURING MID FEBRUARY. GALT HAD CONSOLE SET AND WANTED MARTIN'S PORTABLE. OBSERVATION OF CONSOLE SET REFLECTED IT TO BE "AIR" MANUFACTURED BY WARD'S ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT, MODEL GHJ FOUR EIGHT FOUR SIX A, PRODUCTION CODE FIVE ZERO FIVE FIVE, MONTGOMERY WARD'S SERIAL NUMBER ONE ONE ONE EIGHT THREE THREE TWO.

NEW ORLEANS LOCATE MOTEL, OBTAIN REGISTRATION CARD AND SUBMIT TO LAB, ASCERTAIN TELEPHONE CALLS MADE BY GALT, AND INTERVIEW MOTEL EMPLOYEES FOR POSSIBLE IDENTIFICATION OF PERSONAL CONTACTS.

CHICAGO ASCERTAIN FROM MONTGOMERY WARD LOCATION OF STORE WHERE TV SET PURCHASED BY GALT AND THEREAFTER SET OUT LEADS TO INTERVIEW STORE EMPLOYEES FOR NATURE OF TRANSACTION.

EGERTON, WHO FELT IT HAD SIGNIFICANCE IN INSTANT CASE. KEY IS
ATTACHED TO A METAL TAG ON WHICH APPEARS THE WORDING AT TOP, "FAVOR
DEVOLVER A PASEODELA REFORMA 325." AT BOTTOM OF TAG ARE THE WORDS
"PLEASE RETURN TO PASO DELA REFORMA MEXICA 325." ON THE FRONT OF
THE KEY IS THE LEGEND "1131 ALBA" AND ON THE REAR "MR 39034."

EGERTON, AFTER CONTACTING HIS SUPERIORS, IS HOLDING KEY UNTIL
APRIL FIFTEEN, NEXT, AND WILL MAKE SAME AVAILABLE FOR PHOTOGRAPHING.

POSTAL EMPLOYEES BEING CHECKED TO DETERMINE ORIGIN OF KEY IN
BIRMINGHAM AS TO SPECIFIC MAIL BOX AND LOCATION. SINCE COLLECTION

ALBERT JAMES WALTON, INMATE, CHILlicothe CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTION, CHILlicothe, OHIO, AND FORMER PCI, ADVISED GEORGE (LNU) AT FORT PAYNE ALABAMA, MEMBER OF KKK, OFFERED HIM FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS TO KILL MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., IN CLEVELAND, OHIO, WHERE HE WAS TO APPEAR FOR A SPEECH. GEORGE (LNU) IS IDENTIFIED AS GEORGE KILLIAN, THE EXALTED CYCLOPS OF THE KKK AT FORT PAYNE, ALABAMA, AND HIS WHEREABOUTS ON APRIL FOUR DETERMINED TO BE IN FORT PAYNE, ALABAMA.

KILLIAN IS KNOWN TO TALK "BIG" AND THE FORT PAYNE, ALABAMA, KLAVERN IS ALWAYS PRESSED FOR FUNDS. BOTH WALTON AND KILLIAN ARE KNOWN TO EXAGGERAT. MACK ELKINS IS A FRIEND OF WALTON AND KILLIAN, AND ELKINS' DESCRIPTION IS FAR FROM THAT OF UNSUB. OPERATOR OF TRUCKING COMPANY, DE KALB COUNTY, ALABAMA, REFERRED TO BY WALTON IS EDGAR HAMMONDS, WHO IS KNOWN TO BIRMINGHAM AGENT AND IS NOT IDENTICAL TO DESCRIPTION OF UNSUB. THE NAME LOWMEYER DISCREETLY CHECKED AT DE KALB COUNTY, ALABAMA, SHERIFF'S OFFICE WITH REFERENCE

An individual identifying himself as Dr. Bitz, a Sociologist at the American University, telephonically contacted the Bureau concerning this matter. Dr. Bitz stated that he was offering the information for whatever value it may be to the Bureau.

He pointed out that the three names of the suspect killer, Eric Starvo Galt, were the names of individual enemies with whom James Bond had locked horns in the novels by Ian Fleming.

Dr. Bitz pointed out that this would indicate an individual with a paranoid character and one who might engage in espionage-type fantasy.

"O2B-6" or "D2B-6" are not markings of his company. His tape is 5/16 inch laundry-marking tape made by the Textile Marking Machine Company, Syracuse, New York. His laundry purchases this tape from F. H. Ross and Rudolph Ramelli, both of Jackson, Mississippi. This tape comes in eight to ten colors; however, red is not a good color, in that the ink from the machine tends to fade and run on red tape.

EMMONS made available a sample of cloth with several samples of tape markings, yellow in color. He numbered the lettering on the tape as "O2B-6", "MIF14," and "MIF15." He made available other items described in paragraph one which are enclosed for the Bureau.

The managers of the Rudolph Ramelli Company and F. H. Ross Company, both of Jackson, Mississippi, advised that the only machine handling Thermo-Seal to his knowledge in the central and southern portions of the state is the Phoenix Laundry in Hattiesburg, Mississippi. They do not handle northern Mississippi.
