WFO file 124-7641, Bufile 124-8875 contains a report of SA JOHN R. ALE, dated 3/24/59, in which ROBERT WALLACE FERGUSON, date of birth [redacted], place of birth Lexington, Mass., who had relatives in Jefferson, New Hampshire. [This file also indicates that FERGUSON was a covert employee of the CIA from 1951 to 1959 and was being investigated for a position with International Cooperation Administration which was apparently a CIA cover.]

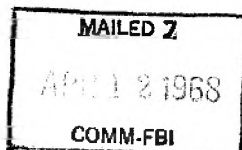
