"TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

"Please pass on to all the authorities wherever possible - to discontinue the search of a white man, as the killer of Martin Lucifer King, because the smart killer is right now in his own family. He is one of his own Civil Rights Urinators and a negro, not a white. I was among them myself in 1965, there were many young nuts, such as was I, and also many whites. However, God opened my eyes in Alabama, when I witnessed the behavior of our marchers under King's leadership. He was a devil's minister, taking all the money he could from the jews, and was doing his work under their leadership and demand. Those were communist jews.

"While marching in Alabama in 1965-it was in spring-we were instructed by King's advisers-red-rat-jews to do the following:

"A group of our negroes forced their way into a nice restaurant; on a given signal, all the negroes grabbed the sugar bawls off the tables, stood up and urinated into them, amid laughter, replaced the bals on the tables-MLK laughed approvingly.

"This is the reason why I, and many others, turned against him, and it was God's will that he was shot by one of his own disciples, a negro, not a white. Please stop all your sham broadcastings and grateful homage for that killed Martin Lucifer King - he was against our best President LBJ - for the nut hippie Bobby Kennedy, who hates the President because he was not appointed as Vice Pres. when his brother JFK was murdered the same way as was MLK. Senate should prohibit all marches at least for the duration of this war, and specially in our Capital. Now the white people are to be more against us for the crazy revolts, murders and damages.

"I am mailing the Police drawing of suspected killer of Dr.K. which appeared on page 2 in yesterday's Daily News, as a white man, who actually is a negro, but a brown one, made white with cream etc. - however, I made it with a crayon darker so they may find him in Atlanta in the King's family.

"You must understand that I cannot reveal my real name and address, although I actually do live in Harlen. Please do not hesitate to use my information, because it is God's truth.

"I am mailing 7 Of these letters to various places - why 7? Because yesterday was Good Thursday, the last supper of Jesus Christ, as a reminder of HIS seven words on the Cross:

'Into Your Hands I command my soul!'
'May your Easter be blessed!'

"Sincerely,

"Coon Amen, 23 years old"

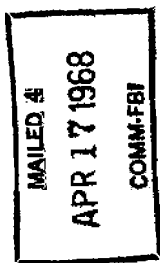

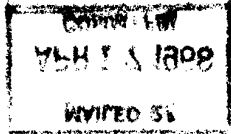

Dear Sir:-----

In the morning news, you are quoted as having said, "The FBI, has pursued King's assassin, in a manner,, that has hardly been assuring, to a tense, and troubled nation", and several derogatory statements, which makes one wonder if you know of any better way to get the job done than the way the FBI, is trying to get it done, together with other law enforcement officers of the nation--if so, quit speaking, and criticising, about something, which from your statements, you know nothing about; as a matter of course, in cases of this kind, with nothing to go on, except more or less rumors, different statements, will be made from time to time, as conditions, and circumstances, make it necessary, and if you know any better way to do it, it is high time you made it known to the FBI.

The FBI, is the finest institution of its kind ever produced in this country, and it is high time more of our people uphold them in their work, and not put interference in their way of helping enforce the law, as we see from some members of Congress, outside the statements you have made, which makes one think of the old adage; that if you want to know all about anything that amounts to anything, just ask some one who knows nothing about it, and he will tell you just how it should be done.

If constructive criticism cannot be made, it is a good time to make no statements at all, in particular, those which would be an interference, in the enforcement of the laws of our Country.

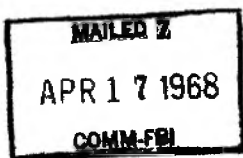
