



This is the message phoned to me at my effice, and said I had been selected in some way as being trustworthy to deliver this message. The person is afraid for personal safety if this is not delivered secretly; the said person claimed not to be a crackpet, but very religious and conscientious, and felt it must be told. I have never taken part in any kind of disturbance anywhere, and have lived too long a seber-minded, minding-ewn-business person to start trouble for any person, group, or our country. The person felt conflict would continue until this person is caught, especially if the colored feel a white person was responsible.

I don't like to be secretive, and have never been so until now. Yet, I'm afraid for the first time in my life--of the negroes and the Communists. And my home and business would be hindered if I had to be protected by the police. I hate not to sign any letter, but cannot this one.

One to keep my word, and one interested in peace and justice.







(U) He stated he did not have any explanation as to why the name was written on the back of the ledger but he believes that such a notation was made by Galt himself. As Quintel recalls Galt lived in Apartment 18 for about one and one-half months during 1967. Quintel believed that this was probably August and September but he could be mistaken. He was under the impression that Galt had worked at Expo 67 (this is why he thought it was during August and September that Galt was there as the Expo closed in September of 1967). When he left Galt stated that he was returning to the United States to care for some sick relatives Quintel indicated that Galt, upon arriving at the apartment, had asked about parking facilities and was quite irritated when he was advised that parking facilities were available but there would be an additional charge of \$20 a month. Quintel thought that Galt had been referred to an Esso service station nearby which had parking facilities. He further advised that Galt had bought a suit of clothes from the Tip Top Shop. He stated that Galt was a quiet man and had only two visitors that he could recall, both of them "elderly women" about 40 to 42 years old-Innes advised that they are reviewing the records again at the apartment in Montreal to try to obtain further information concerning Galt. IXELL 1 In the event Galt did work at Expo 67 it would have been necessary for him to be photographed to obtain an identification card and it would have been necessary for him to have a work permit if he were an American citizen.
