LATENT PRINT EXAMINATION

A box, together with a shipping bill, a slip of paper with notation "Dr. Rev. Martin L. King will be dead by 4-4-68," and other items used to ship stationery supplies from A. L. Garber Company, Ashland, Ohio, to Pittsburgh Plate Glass Company, Miami, Florida, was submitted by Miami Office for examination.

Two latent fingerprints and five latent palm prints were developed on these items. One latent fingerprint has been identified as a fingerprint of a Miami agent.

An envelope and a two-page letter received by the Attorney General naming a possible suspect have also been examined and three latent fingerprints were developed on the letter.

Lifts of latent prints and other items from rooms at 107 14th Street, Atlanta, Georgia, have been examined and two latent fingerprints and eleven latent palm prints of value located.

These latent prints have all been compared with latent prints previously reported in this case, but no identification effected.


The fingerprints of a suspect, possibly identical with one named in letter to the Attorney General, are not identical with latent prints in this case.
