TWO TWO ZERO MC GRATH SAID HE HAD SEEN A DRAWING OF GALT IN THE NEWSPAPER AND BELIEVED THIS MAN TO BEAR RESTRIKING RESEMBLANCE.

MC GRATH FURTHER STATED HE HAD SEEN THIS PERSON AND THE OTHER MAN IN COMPANY OF CHAROLD EDWARDS NICHOLS ON A PREVIOUS OCCASION.

MC GRATH SAID THAT THE MAN IN QUESTION CAME TO THE BAR AT THE
BLUE DOLPHIN AND MC GRATH SAID, "YOU LOOK LIKE YOUR PICTURE," MEANING
THE DRAWING IN THE NEWSPAPER AND THE MAN REPLIED, "YEH, BUT I AM A HELL
OF A GOOD SHOT." MC GRATH SAID THAT KATHY SHEETS, A WAITRESS AT THE BE
WAS NEARBY AND OVERHEARD THESE REMARKS.

EFFORTS BY BUREAU AGENTS TO LOCATE MC GRATH IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING ABOVE TELEPHONE CALL WERE NEGATIVE. MC GRATH WAS NOT AT HIS PLACE OF EMPLOYMENT AND HAD NOT RETURNED TO HIS HOME AS LATE AS TWO TEN A. M.

MC GRATH WAS TELEPHONICALLY CONTACTED AT EIGHT THIRTY A. M., APRIL SIXTEEN, LAST, AND ADVISED HE HAD TO ATTEND A UNION MEETING AND WOULD STOP AT THE HAYWARD RESIDENT AGENCY AFTER THE MEETING AT APPROXIMATELY TEN THIRTY A. M. AT ELEVEN FIFTEEN A. M., MC GRATH TELEPHONICALLY ADVISE HE HAD TO GO TO WORK AT NOON AND WOULD NOT HAVE TIME TO COME TO THE HAYWARD RESIDENT AGENCY. AN APPOINTMENT WAS MADE TO MEET HIM AT HIS PLACE OF EMPLOYMENT, THE BLUE DOLPHIN, A FIRST-CLASS SAN LEANDRO RESTAURANT, WHEN HE FINISHED WORK AT EIGHT P. M.

SAS RICHARD J. MC MULLEN AND WILLIAM HUTTON, JR. MET MC GRATH AT
THE BLUE DOLPHIN. IN THE INTERVIEW, HE RELATED THE ABOVE INCIDENT, BUT
THIS VERSION WAS SOMEWHAT DIFFERENT THAN THAT SET OUT ABOVE. HE SAID
THIS INCIDENT OCCURRED AT APPROXIMATELY SEVEN TO SEVEN THIRTY P.M.,
APRIL FIFTEEN LAST. IT IS NOTED THE MAN HE REFERRED TO WAS SUBSEQUENTED
IDENTIFIED AS DALE C. ALLEN AND HE WILL BE REFERRED TO AS ALLEN ALTHOUGH
MC GRATH DID NOT KNOW HIS NAME AT THAT TIME. HE SAID HE HAS SEEN ALLEN

OTHER MAN WITH NICHOLS ON A PRIOR OCCASION AND BELIEVES HE ALSO WORKS

FOR NICHOLS. MC GRATH SAID THERE IS A LOT OF HORSEPLAY IN THE BAR AT

THE BLUE DOLPHIN. MC GRATH HAD JUST BEEN LOOKING AT A NEWSPAPER

SKETCH OF ERIC STARVO GALT AND NOTED THAT ALLEN BORE A STRIKING RESEMBLANCE TO THIS.

IN JEST HE ASKED ALLEN, "HOW DID YOU GET OUT OF MEMPHIS?" TO HIS SURPRISE, ALLEN REPLIED SOMETHING TO THE EFFECT, "THAT WAS NO TROUBLE, BUT I AM A HELL OF A GOOD SHOT."

MC GRATH FORMED THE OPINION THAT ALLEN COULD BE IDENTICAL WITH ERIC STARVO GALT AND GOT IN CONTACT WITH SECRET SERVICE AGENT LARRY NEWMAN WHEN HE WAS ABLE TO LOCATE HIM AFTER WORK. HE SAID THAT KATHY SHEETS, A WAITRESS. WAS PRESENT AND HEARD THE ABOVE CONVERSATION.

MC GRATH ADVISED THAT THERE IS CONSIDERABLE KIDDING BY THE EMPLOYES
OF THE BLUE DOLPHIN AND HAL NICHOLS AND HIS EMPLOYEES SINCE ALL OF THE
LATTER APPEARED TO BE SUPPORTERS OF GEORGE WALLACE AND ARE GENERALLY
BELIEVED TO BE ANTI-NEGRO. HE DESCRIBED ALLEN AS APPEARING TWO SIX
YEARS OF AGE BUT BELIEVED HIM TO BA THIRTY TO THIRTYTWO YEARS, WMA,
FIVE FEET TEN INCHES TALL, ONE SEVEN ZERO POUNDS, LIGHT BROWN HAIR,
COMBED BACK BUT BELIEVED TO BE PARTED AND DEFINITELY NOT SHORT OR
CREW CUT.

HE EXAMINED ARTIST CONCEPTION DRAWINGS MADE FROM RECOLLECTION OF MEMPHIS AND BIRMINGHAM WITNESSES AS FURNISHED BY THE BUREAU. HE SAID ALLEN DID NOT RESEMBLE EITHER DRAWING BUT OF THE TWO SAID THAT THE ONE FROM MEMPHIS MORA CHOSELY RESEMBLES ALLEN. HE NOTED ALLEN'S HAIR IS NOT CUP IN THE MANNER DEPICTED IN THE DRAWINGS. MC GRATH ADVISED THAT ALLEN WAS AT THAT TIME IN THE DINING ROOM OF THE BLUE DOLPHIN HAVING DINNER WITH A FRIEND, NAME UNKNOWN. INTERVIEWING AGENTS WERE ABLE TO CLOSELY OBSERVE ALLEN AND DESCRIBED HIM AS WMA, ABOUT END OF PAGE THREE.

REID MOVED INTO AN APARTMENT HERE ON OCTOBER TEN LAST. ALLEN HAD PREVIOUSNY WORKED AS A SALESMAN FOR MONTGOMERY WARD COMPANY, OAKLAND, CALIFTRNIA, AND AT TIME OF RENTAL WAS CONNECTED WITH GOLDEN WEST ASSOCIATES, THREE FOUR FIVE ESTUDILLO, SAN LEANDRO. REID WORKED FOR DIAMOND FENCE COMPANY WHICH IS OPERATED BY HAL NICHOLS.

ALLEN HAD PREVIOUS ADDRESS OF THREE THREE SIX CORBETT STREET,

SAN FRANCISCO, TELEPHONE SIX TWO SIX DASH TWO EIGHT SEVEN NINE. HE

HAS A RELATIVE, FERN PRAFLANKIS, TELEPHONE LY THREE DASH FOUR TWO THREE

ZERO, CITY NOT STATED. HE DRIVES A LATE MODEL CREAM OVER RED PONTIAC,

A SPORTS MODEL. ALLEN REPORTEDLY TOOK ANOTHER JOB WITH AN UNKNOWN COM
PANY AND MOVED TO MOS ANGELES, LEAVING HERE BETWEEN APRIL ONE AND TEN,

LAST. SHE HAS NOT SEEN HIM SINCE. REID STILL LIVES HERE. MRS. KIMBALL SAID THAT NEITHER ARTIST DRAWING OF ERIC STARVO GALT RESEMBLES ALLEN. SHE DESCRIBED ALLEN AS WMA, THREE SIX YEARS OF AGE, SIX FEET TALL, ONE SEVEN ZERO TO ONE EIGHT FIVE POUNDS, THIN BUILD, LIGHT BROWN HAIR.

MRS. KIMBALL ALSO ADVISED THAT MR. REID HAD REQUESTED THAT HIS
"BOSS" IVARS STRAZDINS, WHO IS CONNECTED WITH THE DIAMOND FENCE
COMPANY, BE ALLOWED TO MOVE INTO REID'S APARTMENT AND HAS COMMENCED
TO DO SO.

KATHY SHEETS. ONE SIX FOUR FIVE ONE HUNDRED SIXTYFIFTH AVENUE, SAN LEANDRO. CALIFORNIA. A WAITRESS AT THE BLUE DOLPHIN. ADVISED THAT SHE IS ACQUAINTED WITH HAL NICHOLS AND SEVERAL OTHER PERSONS WHO COME @ THE RESTAURANT WITH HIM. THEY HAVE BEEN COMING THERE TWO OR THREE TIME A WEEK FOR THE PAST FEW MONTHS. IT IS COMMON KNOWLEDGE TO EMPLOYEES OF THE RESTAURANT THAT ALL OF THESE PERSONS ARE EXTREMELY ARDENT SUPPOR ERS OF GEORGE WALLACE FOR PRESIDENT AND IT IS ASSUMED BY EMPLOYEES THAT ALL OF THEM HAVE STRONG ANTI-NEGRO SENTIMENTS SINCE IT IS THE GENERAL CONSENSUS OF EMPLOYEES OF THE RESTAURANT THAT GEORGE WALLACE IS ANTI-NEGRO. SHE KNOWS AS ASSOCIATES OF NICHOLS ONE CHUCK SULLIVAN. DALE ALLEN. AND JAMES REID AND THERE ARE OTHERS WHOSE NAMES SHE COULD & RECALL. SHE SAID THAT OVER THE MONTHS THE EMPLOYEES OF THE BAR HAVE BE KIDDING AND JOKING WITH NICHOLS AND HIS FRIENDS CONCERNING NEGROES. NICHOLS AND HIS ASSOCIATES GENERALLY DENY ANTI-NEGRO SENTIMENTS BUT ITS OBVIOUS THAT THIS IS JUSTIFICATION FOR THEIR POSITION IN SUPPORT OF WAR LACE AND PROBABLY NOT THEIR TRUE SENTIMENTS.

SHE SAID THAT FOLLOWING THE ASSASSINATION OF DR. MARTIN

LUTHER KING THE BARTENDERS AND NICHOLS' GROUP WERE MAKING JOKES WHICH

SHE DESCRIBED AS "BAD" JOKES IN THAT THEY WERE CRUDE RATHER THAN FUNNY

CONCERNING KING'S DEATH. SHE NOTED LITTLE SYMPATHY FOR DR. KING FROM

THE NICHOLS GROUP. SHE WAS OFF WORK ON THE DAY OF THE KILLING, APRIL

FOUR, LAST, AND DOES NOT RECALL ANY OF THE NICHOLS GROUP VISITING THE

RESTAURANT UNTIL THE FOLLOWING SUNDAY.

SHE SPECIFICALLY RECALLS A CONVERSATION AT APPROXIMATELY SEVEN P. M,
APRIL FIFTEEN, LAST. CHUCK SULLIVAN AND DALE ALLEN ENTERED THE BAR.
SHE HEARD BOB BENNETT, ONE OF THE BARTENDERS WHO HAD APPARENTLY BEEN
LOOKING AT A PHOTOGRAPH OF THE ALLEGED KILLER IN THE NEWSPAPER SAY
TO DALE ALLEN, "THERE HE IS. LOOKS JUST LIKE THE PICTURE." DALE
REPLIED. "I DID NOT THINK ANYONE WOULD RECOGNIZE ME."

SHE DOES NOT RECALL LARRY MC GRATH PARTICIPATING IN THIS CONVERSATION BUT BELIEVES THAT HE WAS ON DUTY AT THE BAR AND COULD HAVE OVERHEARD IT. SHE BELIEVED THE CONVERSATION TO BE NOTHING MORE THAN THE USUAL KIDDING WHICH HAD BEEN GOING ON FOR MONTHS AND ATTACHED NO PARTICULAR SIGNIFICANCE TO IT. SHE SAID THERE WAS NO INDICATION FROM WHAT WAS SAID OR THE MANNER IN WHICH IT WAS SAID TO INDICATE THAT THE CONVERSATION WAS IN ANY WAY SERIOUS OR SIGNIFICANT.

SHE VIEWED TWO ARTIST DRAWINGS OF ERIC STARVO GALT AND SAID THAT NEITHER RESEMBLES ALLEN WITH THE EXCEPTION THAT THE MEMPHIS DRAWING SHOWED A CREASE IN THE NOSE BETWEEN THE EYES WHICH LOOKS SOMETHING LIKE ALLEN, BUT SAID IT IS DEFINITELY NOT A LIKENESS DRAWING.

CLARA HENRY, MANAGER, LOS PALMAS APARTMENTS, ONE FIVE THREE SEVEN FIVE TROPIC COURT. SAN LEANDRO. CALIFORNIA. ADVISED THAT HAL NICHOLS OCCUPIED APARTMENT THREE THREE FROM FEBRUARY TWO TWO. LAST. TO PRESENT. HE PREVIOUSLY LIVED IN THE NIMITZ MOTEL. SAN LEANDRO. CALIFORNIA. HE DROVE A LATE MODEL CADILLAC. SHE POINTED OUT THAT APARTMENT THREE THREE IS LOCATED IN A SECLUDED CORNER OF THE COMPLEX WITH A PARKING AREA TO THE REAR WHICH IS WELL CONCEALED FROM THE VIEW OF MOST OF THE TENANTS. NICHOLS COULD, THEREFORE, COME AND GO AS HE PLEASED AND PROBABLY NOT BE SEEN AND SHE COULD NOT STATE WHERE HE MAY HAVE BEEN ON MARCH TWO NINE OR THREE ZERO. LAST. OR APRIL FOUR. SUTTON QUIT AND MOVED TO THE PORTLAND OR SEATTLE AREA. ONLY ADDRESS SHE HAS FOR HER IS THAT OF HER FATHER, M. C. SUTTON, POST OFFICE BOX SIX FIVE. SAN ANDREAS. CALIFORNIA.

IN EFFORTS TO ESTABLISH THE RELIABILITY OF LARRY MC GRATH,

JOE MEDEIROS, BUSINESS AGENT, CULINARY AND BARTENDERS UNION, HAYWARD,

CALIFORNIA, ADVISED THAT LARRY MC GRATH WAS A MEMBER OF THIS UNION

SINCE ONE NINE SIX THREE. HE SAID MC GRATH HAS BEEN UNABLE TO HOLD

A STEADY JOB DURING THIS PERIOD HAVING HAD TEN TO TWELVE DIFFERENT JOBS

DURING THAT TIME. HE TERMED MC GRATH AS A PERSON WHO CONSISTENTLY
