HERRALD SAID DURING NINETEEN FIFTY-FIVE THROUGH NINETEEN FIFTY-SEVEN, HAWKINS WAS A SERGEANT FIRST CLASS IN THE REGULAR ARMY STATIONED AT HEADQUARTERS COMPANY, SEVENTY EIGHT ELEVENTH ARMY SERVICE UNIT IN FRANKFURT, GERMANY, AND WAS IN THE ADJUTANT GENERAL'S CORP.
