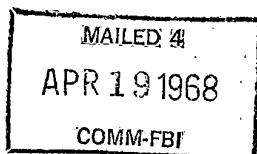

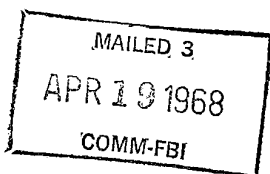

TENNIS stated approximately one and a half years ago, a friend, GLEN E. GELVIN, also known as "REX", San Angelo, told TENNIS that JAMES ALLEN SMITH had been by to see him in San Angelo, and had mentioned something about a price being put on KING's head

SMITH was last arrested on or about 2/29/68, at Fort Worth, Texas, on warrant out of Houston, Texas. SMITH was taken by authorities to Houston where he made bond on 3/4/68, and his whereabouts since that time are unknown.

SMITH is not considered by TENNIS to be the killer type, but could assist in a conspiracy.

SMITH has a long criminal record and is deeply involved in pending court cases requiring large sum of money for attorney fees. SMITH's present attorney is FRED FICK, 202 Burk Burnett Building, Fourth and Main, Fort Worth.

TENNIS contacted FICK by telephone during the past week. FICK would not talk on the telephone to TENNIS, but required TENNIS to appear in person and identify himself to FICK. TENNIS did so on 4/13/68. FICK claimed not to know the present whereabouts of SMITH, but had a voluminous file on SMITH's pending court cases.

TENNIS notes that SMITH is experienced in radio mechanics and formerly worked as a radio announcer in San Angelo. SMITH knows how to pilot a plane, is a good fast driver, dresses neatly, and speaks with a southern drawl. SMITH has traveled throughout the South in the past when dealing in stolen cars. He does not have any seaman type experience.

GLEN R. (REX) GELVIN, 917 Glenna Street, San Angelo, Texas, advised on 4/15/68, that JAMES ALLEN SMITH last visited him in San Angelo approximately five months ago. He stated he has no information regarding the current whereabouts of SMITH. GELVIN noted that SMITH is an egotistical type liar, and had told him a story over a year ago regarding his (SMITH's) stolen car dealings with the "Southern Christian Conference" and MARTIN LUTHER KING in Atlanta, Georgia.

SMITH related that he had sold stolen cars to the Conference, who subsequently reneged in paying him until he exhibited his gun when he went personally to KING's office to collect money owed him by the Conference. SMITH related that an unnamed associate of SMITH's stolen car activities, had told SMITH he could make \$500 for shooting KING. GELVIN added SMITH would not comment any further concerning this KING matter. GELVIN stated he did not pay much attention to the above SMITH story, as he has known SMITH a long time, and does not place much credence in anything he has to say.

TENNIS notes SMITH had polio in his left leg when he was three years old, and same is now two inches shorter, resulting in SMITH's walking with a noticeable limp.

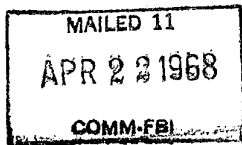
