supervision of Fred J. Wilkinson. Therefore,
he took me with him to interview
some inmates also involved. I think
what he had in mind was a case
of mistaken identity.

Maybe James Ray was not in the
case. It is easy to forget names. However,
I thought you could check without
too much effort who Mr. Garland
visited at that time (around December 18,
1965) and also check with Judge
Bordley what conspiracy case it
was Mr. Garland checked or continued.
I believe somewhere in the pleading
the ^{name} James Ray will appear. If I
am ~~wrong~~ please forgive me. If I
am ~~right~~ maybe it will give a clue

regarding the most recent case in which James Ray was involved.

I trust you will keep this information confidential. Since I do not wish any of Reuben Garland's criminal chents killing me, I have mentioned it to no one but you.

Previously I turned in a telegram which I found threatening the life of the President. I sent it directly to the President. Secret Service men Earl Moore said I should have gone directly to them with it. If in this instance I'm going against protocol I am sorry. My intentions are to be helpful.

TO NICK'S PLACE WHERE SHE STARTED WORK AT THREE P.M. AND WORKED NIGHTS. WHILE GOING TO THE BATHROOM, SHE OBSERVED A RIFLE WITH A TELESCOPIC SIGHT, IN A CASE IN NICK'S OFFICE. LATER, THE TWO MEN TOOK THE RIFLE AND A LONG BOX, WHICH TOOK THREE MEN TO CARRY OUT, AND PUT THEM IN A SIXTYFOUR MARRON DODGE WITH A FAKE "CONTINENTAL KIT" ON THE BACK.

ON APRIL FOUR , LAST, WHILE ON DUTY, SHE OVERHEARD NICK RECEIVE A TELEPHONE CALL ON HIS PHONE WHICH IS CLOSE TO THE KITCHEN. AFTER THIS CALL, NICK SAID, "MARTIN LUTHER KING IS DEAD." THIS WAS BEFORE THE NEWS CAME OVER THE RADIO ABOUT THE MURDER.

NICK HAD MEETINGS EVERY NIGHT IN HIS OFFICE, AND SHE WAS TOLD BY THE OTHER EMPLOYEES THAT NICK IS THE HEAD OF THE KLU KLUX KLAN IN THAT AREA. A WHITE MALE, KNOWN TO HER ONLY AS BIG WILL ADAMS' SON, WAS IN ON THE ACTIVITY AT THE RESTAURANT. FROSTENE, (PHONETIC) A LARGE, FAT NEGRO GIRL, WHO WORKS FOR NICK, AND TWO WHITE WAITRESSES WHO WERE ASSOCIATED WITH THE TWO MEN WHO TOOK THE GUN, KNEW OF THE ACTIVITIES AT NICK'S.

FROM WHAT SHE OVERHEARD SHE FEELS THAT NICK HAD SOME PART IN THE ASSASSINATION OF MARTIN LUTHER KING, BUT HSE HAS NO DEFINITE PROOF OF ANYTHING. SHE BECAME SO FREGHTENED SHE TOLD NICK SHE HAD

A VERY SICK RELATIVE IN ABILENE, TEXAS. SHE LEFT ON APRIL NINE, LAST, AND CAME TO ABILENE, TEXAS, WHERE SHE MET THOMAS MC GEE. SHE HAS BEEN GOING WITH MC GEE FOR FOUR YEARS AND HE CAME TO ABILENE SHORTLY BEFORE CHRISTMAS TO LOOK FOR WORK. SHE COULD NOT IDENTIFY THE PHOTO OF JAMES EARL RAY AS EVER BEING AT JOHN'S RESTAURANT OR EVER SEEING HIM.

ON APRIL TWENTYTWO, LAST, MISS INFORMANT TEXAS APPROX 1933 THOMAS MC GEE FURNISHED THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

HE WORKED AT JOHN'S RESTAURANT ABOUT A YEAR AGO FOR A MONTH AS A CARHOP. HE WAS TOLD THE RESTAURANT WAS A MEETING PLACE FOR THE KU KLUX KLAN AND DEVILISH NICK, THE PROPRIETOR OF THE RESTAURANT, WAS THE HEAD OF THE KKK IN THAT AREA. HE ALSO DETERMINED THAT THE WOMEN EMPLOYEES WORKED AS PROSTITUTES FOR NICK DURING OFF HOURS AND THE TWO WHITE WOMEN WHO WORK AS WAITRESSES, ONE BRUNETTE AND ONE BLONDE, LIVE IN THE MOST EXPENSIVE HOTEL IN LAUREL, NAME UNKNOWN.

NICK BEAT UP CERTAIN EMPLOYEES WHILE HE WAS THERE, AND HE, MC GEE, DECIDED TO LEAVE. WHEN HE LEARNED THAT MYRTIS RUTH HENDRICKS WAS WORKING FOR NICK, WHO WAS MAKING A PROSTITUTE OUT OF HER, HE HAD HER COME TO ABILENE.

HE ADMITTED THAT HE IS ON PROBATION OUT OF GULFPORT, MISS., FOR MOONSHINING AND HAS PREVIOUSLY FURNISHED INFORMATION TO THE FBI THROUGH A ONE-LEGGED MAN WHO RUNS A BARBER SHOP NEXT DOOR TO KITCHEN'S GROCERY IN SEMINARY, MISS.. THIS MAN COULD VOUCH FOR HIS RELIABILITY.

HE FEELS THAT SHOULD DEVILISH NICK KNOW THAT HE AND MYRTIS HAVE TALKED TO THE FBI, HE WOULD HAVE THEM LOCATED AND KILLED, AND WOULD TAKE SOME ACTION AGAINST THEIR FRIENDS AND RELATIVES IN LAUREL, MISSISSIPPI. HE THEREFORE REQUESTED, AS DID HENDRICKS, THAT THEIR IDENTITIES BE PROTECTED AND KEPT VERY CONFIDENTIAL. HE INTIMATED THAT IF INVESTIGATION BY THE FBI REFLECTS THAT THE INFORMATION ON DEVILISH NICK IS OF ANY VALUE, HE WOULD BE WILLING TO RETURN TO LAUREL AND OBTAIN INFORMATION FOR THE FBI ON A PAID BASIS.

HE ADVISED THAT HE AND HENDRICKS WILL MAINTAIN CONTACT WITH THE FBI.

Penitentiary (USP) records regarding CLARENCE JAMES CLARK, USP# 76195-L, reveals CLARK was committed to that institution 12/11/58 to serve four years on charge of white slavery at Lake Charles, Louisiana. CLARK was transferred to Federal Correctional Institution, Texarcana, Texas, 7/22/59, and on 7/17/61, was sent to the Federal Medical Center, Springfield, Missouri for the surgical correction of a hernia. CLARK refused surgery and was mandatorily released 10/6/61 to return to Muskogee, Oklahoma to engage in oil and construction work.

Records under date of 2/61, indicate CLARK's mother, EDITH PETTY TIPTON, and stepfather, J. L. TIPTON were residing at Anadarko, Oklahoma. Records show CLARK's ex-wife, HELEN BEARMAN CLARK or HELEN THURMAN CLARK residing with her parents at Dublin, Texas.
