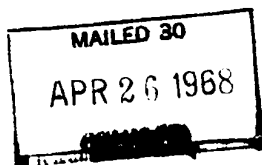

PHOTOGRAPH OF GALT FURNISHED BY MORALES WHICH WAS TAKEN IN PUERTO VALLARTA ON NOVEMBER THREE, ONE NINE SIX SEVEN, HAS BEEN FORWARDED BUREAU WITH PILOT OF EASTERN AIRLINES FLIGHT NINE ZERO FOUR, APRIL TWO THREE INSTANT, AS BUREAU HAS BEEN TELEPHONICALLY ADVISED. ORIGINAL PHOTO WAS POLAROID OF GALT AND MORALES BUT BEFORE GIVING UP PICTURE, SHE INSISTED ON HER PHOTOGRAPH BEING CUT OUT.

MEX - TWO FOUR HAS EXTENSIVELY INTERVIEWED IRMA MORALES, WHO CLAIMS NOT TO HAVE SEEN GALT SINCE NOVEMBER NINE LAST AND NOT TO HAVE HEARD FROM HIM SINCE THAT TIME.

MORALES CLAIMED THAT ON SUNDAY, OCTOBER TWO NINE LAST, GALT WAS DRINKING AT SAME TABLE WITH HER ABOUT NINE PM AND FOUR NEGROES AND SEVERAL WHITE PEOPLE WERE SEATED AT ANOTHER TABLE. GALT KEPT "GOADING" THE NEGROES, ONE OF WHOM WAS DESCRIBED AS

VERY TALL AND ANOTHER AS VERY SHORT AND FAT. GALT THEN LEFT TO GO TO HIS CAR AND WHEN HE RETURNED HE ASKED MORALES TO FEEL HIS POCKET. SHE DID AND NOTED HE HAD A PISTOL IN HIS POCKET, THE HANDLE OF WHICH SHE SAW. GALT STATED HE WANTED TO KILL THE NEGROES. HE CONTINUED TO BE INSULTING AND WHEN NEGROES LEFT, HE STATED HE WANTED TO "GO AFTER THEM." MORALES, HOWEVER, TOLD HIM THAT IT WAS ABOUT TEN O'CLOCK WHEN THE POLICE WOULD COME TO CHECK THE PLACE AND HE STATED HE WANTED NOTHING TO DO WITH THE POLICE, THEREBY TERMINATING THE INCIDENT.

MORALES SAID THAT MOST OF TIME GALT WAS IN PUERTO VALLARTA HE WORE DARK GLASSES.

MEX - THREE THREE IMMEDIATELY SENT TO SAN LUIS POTOSI REGARDING LEAD IN BUCAB NUMBER ONE THREE EIGHT RECEIVED APRIL TWO THREE INSTANT AND BUREAU WILL BE ADVISED OF DEVELOPMENTS.

MEX - TWO FOUR IN SAN MIGUEL DE ALLENDE HAS BEEN UNABLE AS OF AFTERNOON APRIL TWO THREE INSTANT TO LOCATE CAR DESCRIBED IN BUCAB NUMBER ONE THREE FIVE OF APRIL TWO TWO LAST. INVESTIGATION CONTINUING.

INTENSIVE INVESTIGATION CONTINUES IN FOCAL PARTS OF MEXICO AND BUREAU WILL BE KEPT ADVISED OF DEVELOPMENTS.

On 4/15/68, JIMMIE D. GARNER, Roominghouse Manager of the roominghouse located at 113 14th Street, N. E., Atlanta, Georgia, made available an unopened envelope with certain hand-written and handprinted notations thereon.

GARNER advised that when ERIC S. GALT obtained a room at this address, he had GALT write his name on the envelope. It is noted that the handprinted name ERIC S. GALT appears on the envelope and, according to GARNER, this handprinting was prepared by GALT himself. Other handwritten notations on the face of the envelope were, according to GARNER, prepared by himself. It is noted that this is the only written record available to confirm GALT's presence at this address.

EXAMINATION REQUESTED:

The FBI Laboratory (Document Section) is requested to compare the handprinting "ERIC S. GALT" with any known

The following information was received by the NYO from HENRY MAC FARLANE, Director of Security, J.C. Penney Corporation and former Special Agent. MAC FARLANE received the information from GEORGE STONE, Corporate Director of J. C. Penney, Inc., who received it from ROBERT F. BENNETT, Washington Representative, Public Relations, J.C. Penney. BENNETT is the son of Senator WALLACE BENNETT of Utah and Senator BENNETT furnished this information to ROBERT F. BENNETT:

ROBERT F. BENNETT stated that on the day before MARTIN LUTHER KING's assassination, his father was attending a testimonial dinner for top industrialists in Chicago, Illinois. At this dinner an executive, not further identified, stated that a man who used to work for him, was the personal chauffeur for KING and this man contacted him for his advice. He stated that KING required
