BUREAU FILES ON KING REFLECT THE FOLLOWING:

INFORMATION WAS RECEIVED BY YOUR OFFICE THAT ONE JAMES PAFFORD OF SPRING HILL, LOUISIANA, HAD ALLEGEDLY MADE A THREAT AGAINST KING ON JANUARY EIGHTEEN SIXTY FIVE. THE CHIEF OF POLICE REUBEN O'NEAL, OF THE SPRING HILL POLICE DEPARTMENT DID NOT GIVE ANY CREDENCE TO THE REPORT. PAFFORD WAS REPORTEDLY A GUN COLLECTOR OF GOOD REPUTATION RESIDING IN CULLEN, LOUISIANA.

ON JUNE TWENTY-TWO SIXTY FIVE, ONE CARROLL JORDAN, THREE ZERO SEVEN SIXTH STREET, MONROE, LOUISIANA, TURNED IN A WALLET TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT THAT HE FOUND IN WEST MONROE. The main file on King contains the following threats:

Jackson office, by teletype, 9/17/66, entitled "UNSUB; ALLEGED PLAN TO KILL REVEREND MARTIN LUTHER KING, GRENADA, MISSISSIPPI, RACIAL MATTERS," reported that the Reverend Emmett Barfield, Pastor, First Presbyterian Church, Grenada, Mississippi, who requested his identity be concealed, claimed an attorney in his parish told him two white residents of Grenada planned to assassinate King on 9/19/66, at Grenada. These men allegedly wanted to retain the attorney should they be charged.

Sam Holloway Bowers, Jr., aka Sam, Imperial Wizard, wkkkom, reportedly made a statement at a Klan meeting near Harrisville, Mississippi, on 11/15/64, that two men had requested his permission to shoot King. Bowers reportedly told the men not to take any chances and stated that any American citizen would consider it his patriotic duty to shoot King if given the opportunity.

the Dallas office that one Donald James Nissen, FBI Number 670320A, then an inmate of the County Jail, Sherman, Texas, reportedly knew of an offer of \$100,000 to kill King which had been made by the KKK.

Bureau files indicate that on 4/28/67, JN 265-R (PROB) advised that L. C. Blalock, owner of Curley's Place, Winona, Mississippi, had indicated that one Julio Romeo of Jacksonville, Florida, would pay the source \$100,000 cash to kill King. At the time this information was received, Jacksonville was unable to identify Romeo and Bureau files were negative on Blalock and Romeo. All offices conduct logical investigation to determine if above persons and incidents are implicated in King's death.

Although subject Ray has been identified as the assailant, you should conduct investigation to determine if any of the above might be implicated as a conspirator.

The entire film relative to the broadcast by PBL which appeared on TV in various parts of the country on April 7 and 4/9/68, has been viewed by the NYO. Since the broadcast is on Video tape and quite lengthy with only a very limited portion involving the two men pointed out as look-a-likes to "sketches" of the assassin of KING, the tapes were not obtained from PBL. They are available in further needed.

NYO is conducting no further investigation relative to the PBL Broadcast.

Subject RAY is considered Armed and Dangerous.

"General Manager - WNDT

On April 9, 1968, your station had a program on entitled PBL Broadcast concerning the few months prior to Dr. Martin Luther King's death.

At 7:04 the camera settled on a man for a few moments (the time was right after the speaker had introduced Dr. King and his wife and Dr. King stood up to talk. Dr. King said he had never before spoke to such an ethnic group of people). This man bears a striking resemblance to the sketch of the assassin which has been published in the papers.

I have never written a letter like this before so please don't jump to the conclusion that it is a "crank letter". I and my husband feel very strongly about this that the man shown at 7:04 during the PBL program. Please, please review this tape again and see for yourself."

NYO reviewed the overall film on questioned broadcast with PBL and is enclosing three excerpts from film to Atlanta, depicting person referred to in above letter so that similar investigation through appropriate officials of the Southern Christian Leadership Conference (SCLC) as previously requested in referenced airtel, can be conducted in order to identify this person for elimination purposes concerning subject JAMES EARL RAY.

Also enclosed for New Haven and Memphis are three photographs developed from questioned television tape.

It is further noted that the questioned film was taken on 3/14/68, at Paschal's Motel, on Hunter Street in Atlanta.

For information of Atlanta, enclosed excerpts from film were taken from a group discussion of people during which time MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., addressed the group, along with others.

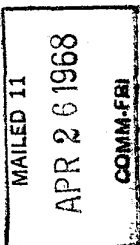

Do hope you get him soon. If you need me for any more information, you have my address.

SUTTON further advised that code number 20R-3 has not been used since 1/30/68, and would have been used prior to this in August of 1967, but due to the fact that no records are available, it would be impossible to determine who might have been assigned this code at that time or the color of the code used. SUTTON furnished samples of Thermo-seal tape used in his business for submission to the FBI Laboratory.

SUTTON was exhibited Wanted Flyer number 442-A for JAMES EARL RAY, at which time he advised that he could not identify this individual as being identical with anyone he has observed in the past.

On 4/23/68, ROBERT POOLE, manager, Clinton Laundry and Cleaners, Clinton, Oklahoma, advised SA WILLIAM R. FARRIS that his firm uses a code such as 20R-3. The letter in the code is changed weekly and the entire alphabet is utilized. By calculating on a calendar POOLE was able to determine that the symbol 20R-3 would have been in use from noon, 9/22/67 through noon on 9/29/67. Prior to this time the code would have been used in March, 1967. In March 1968, the code would have been used again but in March, 1968, POOLE's firm was not using a Thermo-seal marking machine. Prior to September, 1967, the firm was using a Thermo-seal marking machine which is no longer in operation but this machine produced a wider tape. This particular tape was a wider tape than the current machine being used and the tape used was gold in color. POOLE stated his firm does not retain records on home delivery transactions over 3 months. They do have available records on cash items at the counter. These records were searched for the period 1/1/67 through 4/1/68 without locating any having the symbol 20R-3. Symbols 20R-2 and 20R-4 were located and POOLE stated this indicates 20R-3 was a home delivery on which no records are available. Samples of the Thermo-seal laundry markings were obtained from POOLE for submission to the FBI Laboratory.

REQUEST OF THE FBI LABORATORY

The FBI Laboratory is requested to compare the enclosed samples of Thermo-seal laundry markings with the questioned

specimens previously submitted in this case to determine if the machine at Clinton, Oklahoma, or at Stillwater, Oklahoma, could have produced the questioned laundry markings.

On 4/24/68, WARREN TYSON, Manager, White Star Laundry and Dry Cleaners, 4535 Cole, Dallas, Texas, furnished the enclosed sample laundry marks from the three Thermo-Seal marking machines operated by his concern. He advised the "20" is a lot number, the "R" is the week, and the "3" is the customer invoice. He uses eight colors of Thermo-Seal tape each week and a light yellow color is therefore used 1/8 (approximately) of each week.

The enclosed samples are gold colored tape as opposed to the light yellow color he uses. Gold is used exclusively for one day specials. He stated he would put tape markers on sheets and pillow cases only when they are brought in for one day special service. He does not use any marker on normal flat work such as sheets and pillow cases, handling that by the bundle.

TYSON advised he makes records of the identity of customers only if they have a charge account. Almost all, if not all, of his one day service is done on a cash basis.

IT SAID THE PLOT ORIGINATED ON MARCH 29--SEVEN DAYS BEFORE THE SLAYING--AND THAT GALT WAS REPORTED TO HAVE BEEN IN MEMPHIS ON THE DAY OF THE SLAYING AND THE DAY PRECEDING.

THE FBI PORTRAYED GALT AS A POORLY EDUCATED LONER WITH A TASTE FOR COUNTRY AND WESTERN MUSIC, VODKA, BEER AND DANCING. IT SAID HE SPOKE WITH DICTION REFLECTING A "RURAL" BACKGROUND AND THAT HE CLAIMED TO HAVE WORKED AS A COOK ON MISSISSIPPI RIVER VESSELS AND AS A MERCHANT SEAMAN. HE HAD TAKEN LESSONS IN DANCING AND WAS A GRADUATE OF A BARTENDING SCHOOL.
