SHE RENTED A TWO-ROOM APARTMENT AT SIX ZERO SIX CHURCH STREET. COLUMBIA. MISSISSIPPI. TO A YOUNG MAN WHO GAVE HIS NAME AS EARL WILLIAM RAY.
