ADVISED AFTER VIEWING PHOTOGRAPH OF RAY THAT HE WAS NOT IDENTICAL WITH PERSON TO WHOM SHE RENTED APARTMENT. SCHWARZAUER STATED THAT IN OCTOBER, SIXTYSEVEN, SHE RENTED A TWO-ROOM APARTMENT AT SIX ZERO SIX CHURCH STREET, COLUMBIA, MISSISSIPPI, TO A YOUNG MAN WHO GAVE HIS NAME AS EARL WILLIAM RAY. THIS INDIVIDUAL ADVISED HER THAT HE WAS GETTING MARRIED AND WOULD BRING HIS WIFE TO LIVE IN THE APARTMENT WITH HIM. EARL WILLIAM RAY WAS A YOUNG MAN. SCHWARZAUER RELATED RAY ONLY OCCUPIED THE APARTMENT FOR ONE NIGHT AND THEN LEFT. SHE STATED RAY WAS UNKNOWN TO HER AND THAT SHE HAS NOT SEEN HIM SINCE OCTOBER, SIXTY SEVEN, WHEN HE RENTED THE APARTMENT. SCHWARZAUER STATED THAT UPON SEEING PHOTOGRAPH OF JAMES EARL RAY ON <sup>Television</sup> ~~T.V.~~ IN PRESENCE OF HER SISTER AND HER MAID, GUSSIE MINGO, SHE JOKINGLY REMARKED THAT THIS MUST BE THE INDIVIDUAL TO WHOM SHE RENTED HER APARTMENT. SCHWARZAUER STATED THAT THE INDIVIDUAL WHO RENTED HER APARTMENT BEARS NO RESEMBLANCE TO JAMES EARL RAY AND IS NOT SAME PERSON. SHE STATED THAT SINCE APARTMENT WAS VACATED BY EARL WILLIAM RAY, SHE HAS HAD IT COMPLETELY REDECORATED THROUGHOUT.

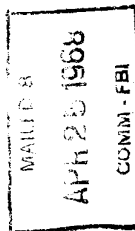

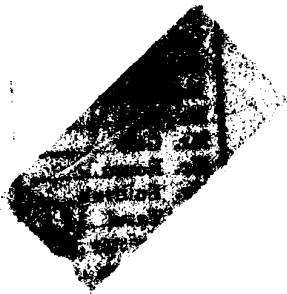
