



Bureau is in receipt of a letter from Barbara J. Henderson, Victoria, Australia, in which she offers information regarding captioned case. She indicates that she had forwarded information previously through the "Time" office in New York, however, no record of that information located in Bufiles. She provided copies of that information which she found in her residence reportedly left by a previous tenant. It pertained to bills for professional services, one of which indicated the patient had been referred by a Dr. Ray.
