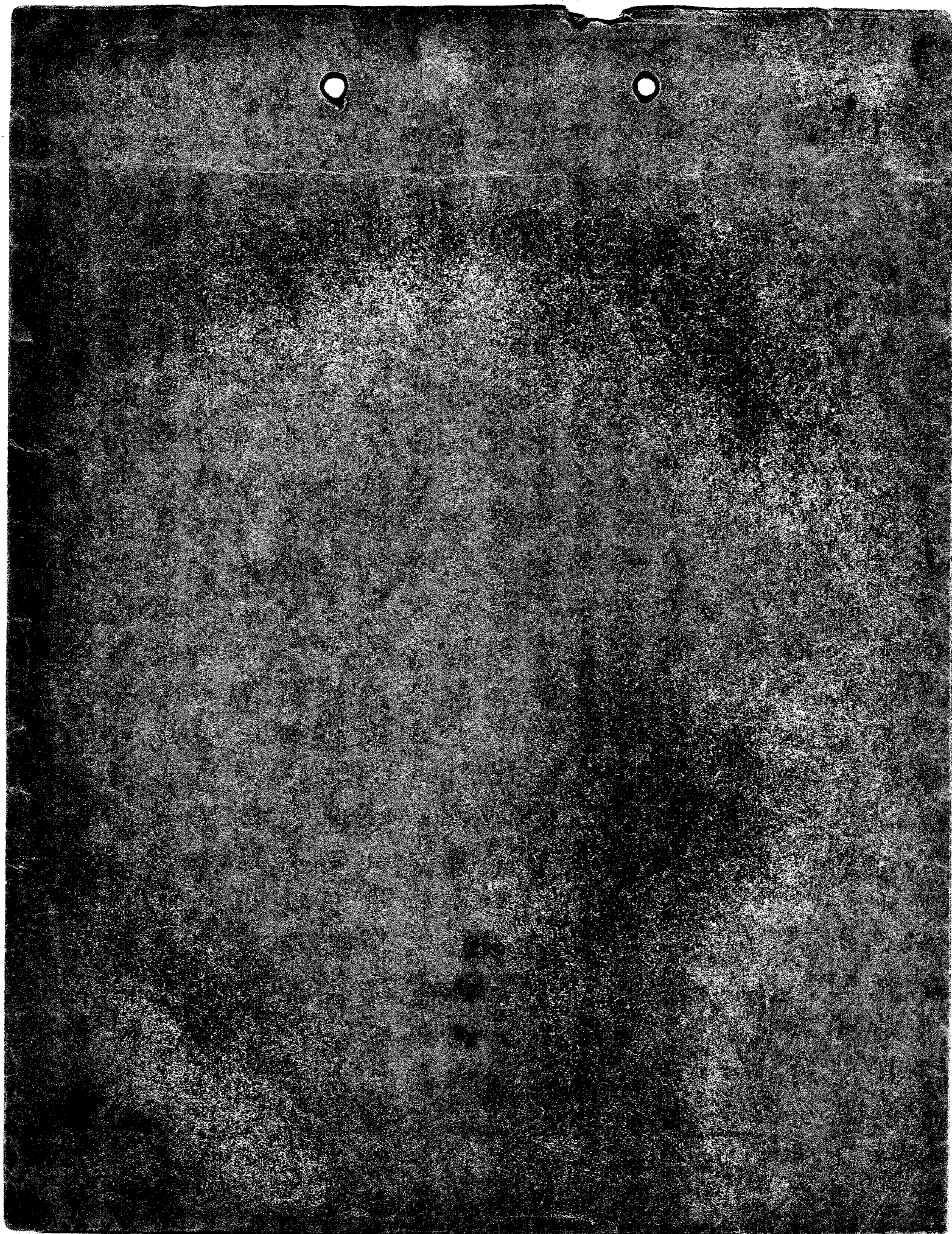

Bureau is in receipt of a letter from Barbara J. Henderson, Victoria, Australia, in which she offers information regarding captioned case. She indicates that she had forwarded information previously through the "Time" office in New York, however, no record of that information located in Bufiles. She provided copies of that information which she found in her residence reportedly left by a previous tenant. It pertained to bills for professional services, one of which indicated the patient had been referred by a Dr. Ray. There is nothing to indicate that the information she is offering has anything to do with the captioned case. She further indicates that she has a "problem," but is not specific regarding her problem, although she implies that Dr. King "may have become interested in my case."

Bufiles disclose Miss Henderson has written previously when she discussed mental telepathy on one occasion, and by letter dated 6/22/63, she stated she had experience in "Anti-Maffia work" and that six years previous to 1963 she was betrayed out of her job with the Australian Newspaper, "The Sun-Herald." That letter was acknowledged over Miss Gandy's signature. (64-175-303-133)
