A letter dated April 10, 1968, has been received from William R. Badgett, Jr., Pilot Mountain, North Carolina, in which he suggests one Rex Thomas Gravitte as a possible suspect in the killing of Martin Luther King, Jr. According to Badgett, Gravitte resided in either St. Louis or Louisville. The remainder of Badgett's letter is a rambling discourse relating in part to "the worldwide hotpill racket" and other matters totally unrelated to the instant case.

Bureau files do not contain any information regarding Rex Thomas Gravitte or Gavitte. *MO KY* B. APPROX 1933-38

Bureau files do disclose that one William Badgett of Pilot Mountain, North Carolina, directed a letter to the Justice Department dated February 5, 1940, on the letterhead of Badgett and Badgett Attorneys; this related to possible information he had concerning the Matson kidnapping case. A second letter was received dated February 17, 1940, from W. R. Badgett on this same letterhead, advising that the first letter had been written by his son William. He advised that his son was very abnormal and he wanted us to understand the conditions under which his letter had been written. He stated his son had experienced mental problems for several years. (7-1820-28922 and 29035)

On December 6, 1945, William Badgett of Pilot Mountain, North Carolina, telephoned the Bureau and reported that the movie star Linda Darnell who had eloped to Las Vegas, Nevada, two years previously had not done so voluntarily. (62-60004)

ACTION

1. The correspondent appears to be identical to the individual mentioned in Bureau files and in view of his reported mental condition no further action will be taken regarding this information. His letter will not be acknowledged.

2. In view of Badgett's comment that Gravitte might assassinate the President, a copy of his letter is being furnished the United States Secret Service.

Dear Sir:

On Tuesday April 23-1968 between 8:30 AM & 9: AM I called the F.B.I. office here in Cleveland to give them some information of what I saw. On Monday April 22 about 11:20 AM I saw a car parked here in a shopping center with a man sitting on the passengers side. He was evidently waiting for his buddy. The car was a very dirty dark green, two door 1966 Cadillac with a black vinyl top bearing Missouri license plates. I was starting to look for pencil and paper in the compartment of my car but just then the light turned green for me to proceed. I did get the following P 56 33, ^{with 4 more numbers on it.} I'm positive of the P 56

and almost sure of the 33 but sometimes the 3's look like 5's. The man I saw sitting in the Car I'm sure is the man wanted for the murder of Dr King. His right arm was on the door and with his hand he was nervously tapping the top of the Car. I went slowly and saw him, ~~from~~ the right side of his face (profile) He had a long nose. And as I got directly across from him I was still looking at him and he looked squarely at me and he slouched down in the Car. But I saw his nose & face and a strand of black sorta wavy hair fell on his right forehead near the temple. I went on parked my Car and got my pencil & paper and went back. This took me about 3 to 4 minutes as I had a red light & 2 stop signs to get back there. When I got ~~there~~ the Car was gone. Odd as it may seem it completely went

& told her about it. She told me
to call the F B I here in Cleveland

The agent there took my information

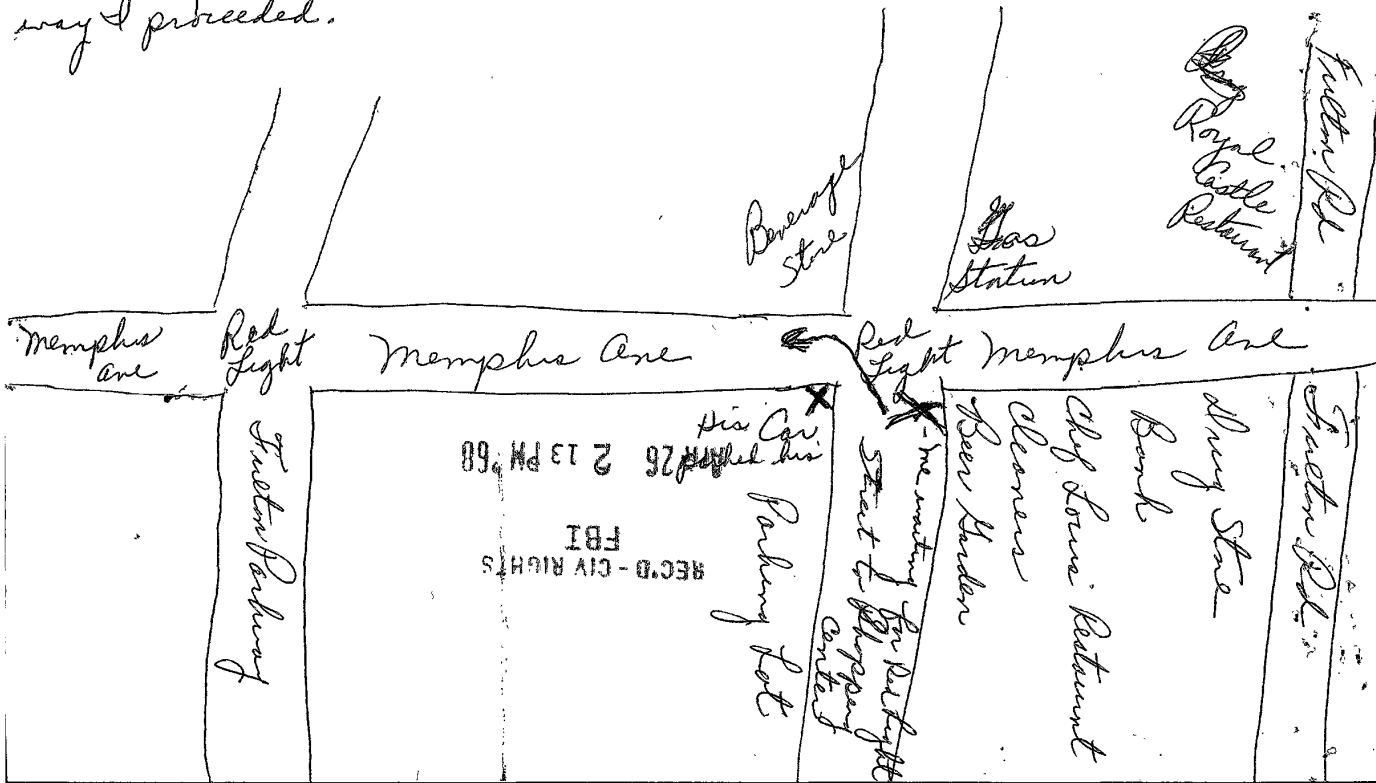

MARY CHORTOS was personally contacted on 4/26/68
 and receipt of her letter at the Bureau was acknowledged. ^{CHIEF}

On 4/23/68 CHORTOS advised that she had observed a white male resembling subject RAY the previous day sitting in a 1966 blue Cadillac bearing Missouri license plates which was parked in the Fulton Shopping Center at Fulton and Memphis Roads. She stated that the license plate bore numbers PS 6 and that she could not remember the other numbers. She stated that this individual was sitting on the passenger side of the car and as the complainant looked at him he slouched in the seat. At the time of the telephone call, she stated that she was quite excited and could not remember what apartment she lived in; whether it was 231 or 213. She stated she had no other information to furnish and did not indicate that she desired to see an Agent.

On both 4/24 and 25/68, the parking lot at the Fulton Shopping Center was checked between the hours of 11:00 a.m. and 12 noon, the time that she had indicated she had seen the automobile. Fulton-Memphis Shopping Center is a large shopping area and the traffic is very considerable

Mrs. CHORTOS was interviewed on 4/26/68, at which time she stated that after she had thought about this matter and visualized the car she realized from her visualization that the car had not been blue at all but was green and further that the license plate number was PS 633 or PS 655 followed by an additional four digits. According to CHORTOS, this made the plate two letters and seven digits. She stated that there was a Missouri plate and that the color was white on green.

Mrs. CHORTOS stated that her only glimpse of the subject was when she drove by the car and observed a portion of his profile from eyes down and for a moment full face when he looked in her direction. She did not see all of his face but she stated she did see his nose and that part of his face. She recalled that there was a long strand of hair hanging down by his eye. She could furnish no other description except to state that she thought he was quite handsome and could not guess his age as she "can't tell ages." She stated that her attention was drawn to this matter because of the fact that there was a Missouri license plate on the car and the next day she observed the picture of subject RAY in the Life magazine and because he slouched down in the seat. As Mrs. CHORTOS stated, she could not understand why he would slouch down in the seat when she looked at him.

Mrs. CHORTOS stated that she had written to the Bureau rather than call the Cleveland Office of the FBI because she realized that the Agents were so busy. She stated she had never met an FBI Agent before and really wanted to talk to one. She said she was very disappointed when an Agent did not come out to her house right after she had called and in fact she "cried a little."

The Agents explained to Mrs. CHORTOS that they were most appreciative of her information and had not realized that she expected to be personally contacted and that the Agents had acted in accordance with the value of the information, in immediately checking out the area indicated by her. Mrs. CHORTOS indicated that she was very pleased to have been of some assistance and was quite thrilled to have met some representatives of the FBI and indicated that ~~she~~ ^{if} she had anything ^{to} furnish, she would immediately call the Cleveland Office of the FBI.

Mrs. CHORTOS resides with a lady companion, both of whom are about 50 years of age. Mrs. CHORTOS has very heavy masculine features and was wearing a man's black sweatshirt and black pants when contacted by the Agents. It is the impression of the Agents that Mrs. CHORTOS was undoubtedly sincere in calling the Bureau, but may be experiencing some emotional problems. In view of the vague and highly questionable accuracy of the information furnished by her, Cleveland is hereby resending the lead set out to Kansas City by re IO airtel to check the Bureau of Motor Vehicles for Cadillacs bearing PS 6 plates.
