

JN 157-9586

JN 23-R (PROB) advised on 11/16/64 that at a state-wide meeting of the WKKKKOM near Harrisville, Miss. on 11/16/64 SAM BOWERS was asked by an unknown Klansman why MARTIN LUTHER KING was not killed when he came to Miss. during the Summer of 1964. BOWERS allegedly replied that two men came to him who claimed they were good with a rifle and wanted his approval to take care of KING. BOWERS stated at this particular meeting that he gave these two men strict orders not to take any chances whatsoever and added that these two men never returned and he heard no more concerning this matter.

On 11/16/64 JN 55-R (PROB) advised that during the same state meeting as set forth above, some individuals reported that MARTIN LUTHER KING had expected to come to Mc Comb, Miss. on Monday, 11/16/64 and that all business places in Mc Comb would be tested by integrationists on that date. Someone remarked that something should be done about this and SAM BOWERS stated that when MARTIN LUTHER KING last toured the State of Miss., two men were assigned with high-powered rifles to take care of KING, but plans went amiss when KING took a route other than the one he was supposed to. BOWERS stated that these two men are working on this matter. He did not identify the two men.

On 4/30/68 JN 23-R (PROB) ^(closed) was located and interviewed. He could add nothing further to the information he furnished on 11/16/64.

On 5/1/68 JN 55-R (PROB) reported that he had nothing additional concerning the above incident.

JN 55-R (PROB) was contacted during the evening of 4/4/68 immediately after the assassination of KING and he had no information of value at that time.

Other incidents summarized in referenced airtel are being investigated, where possible, to determine if any persons concerned ^{are} ~~or~~ implicated in anyway with KING's death.

On 5/1/68, Mr. and Mrs. RICHTER were interviewed at which time they stated that their phone number was 588-2227 and has been that for at least the past year. Mr. and Mrs. RICHTER stated that the call in question on 12/16/67, at 8:42 p.m. was made by their son-in-law, DON SAMEC, 337 Northeast Ridgerton Road, Portland, Oregon.

Mr. and Mrs. RICHTER stated that SAMEC was on his way to San Antonio to marry their daughter, PAT, and had been in an accident somewhere in Texas, but could not recall the name of the town. SAMEC had called to notify them of this accident and that there would be no delay in

Mrs. DONOVAN WOODSIDE (protect identity), 309
Elmwood Drive, Edmond, Oklahoma, was re-interviewed and
IO #4182 displayed to her. Mrs. WOODSIDE said the individual
she saw on American Airlines Flight 338 from Dallas, Texas,
to Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, on 4/6/68, very strongly
resembled RAY and she believed him to be identical with RAY.
She stated she first noticed this individual in Love Field
Terminal, American Airlines waiting area a few moments
prior to boarding this flight. Mrs. WOODSIDE could not
locate her ticket stub but believed she occupied Seat 14-C,
an aisle seat on left side of plane in tourist section and
that the above individual occupied the aisle seat one row
up on the right. Mrs. WOODSIDE said this individual did
not get off the plane when it landed at Friendship Airport,
Baltimore, Maryland, and did not converse with anyone on
the plane and carried no luggage. She informed that he
departed at Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, and she lost sight of
him when her husband met her at the airport. A report

This is the case involving the murder of Martin Luther King, Jr.

PURPOSE:

To recommend that the reports in this case be disseminated to the Department and that Birmingham be instructed to disseminate one copy of each of the reports to the U. S. Attorney, Birmingham.

BACKGROUND:

SEE NOTE ON REVERSE SIDE

Based upon evidence left at the scene of the crime and investigation conducted, we established that a person using the name of Eric Starvo Galt was responsible for the murder of Martin Luther King, Jr. With Department approval and authorization of the U. S. Attorney, Birmingham, we obtained a warrant of arrest for Galt in Birmingham, Alabama, on 4/17/68.

We have subsequently determined that James Earl Ray's fingerprints match the latent fingerprints developed on the evidence, and we are conducting an investigation to locate and apprehend James Earl Ray.

The Atlanta, Birmingham, Los Angeles, and Memphis Offices have submitted reports on this case. At the outset of this investigation Attorney General Ramsey Clark requested a copy of any reports and thereafter Assistant Attorney General in charge of the Civil Rights Division, Stephen J. Pollak, requested a copy of any report. The U. S. Attorney in Birmingham, has requested that we submit our investigative reports to them as soon as possible. To date the reports have not been disseminated. The evidence as submitted by Memphis has been returned to the Memphis Police Department accompanied by a report reflecting the results of our Laboratory examination.

BE INTERVIEWED TODAY. APPEARED COOPERATIVE. SAID RECENTLY JERRY ARRIVED NINE THIRTY AM APRIL THIRTY. THEY TALKED WITH CAROL PERRER OF HARASMENT BY REPORTERS. JERRY SAID IF IT CONTINUED HE WOULD QUIT JOB. JERRY LEFT FOR CHICAGO ELEVEN AM MAY FIRST. JOHN HAD NO REASON TO BELIEVE JERRY OR CAROL CONTACTED OR HEARD FROM SUBJECT SINCE ESCAPE. She was very excited in her speech and at times incoherent. She said she had been in the Pan American Airways Office at the Civil Air Terminal, Hamilton Airport, just a short time before her call and had observed an employee of PAA whom she felt was identical with James Earl Ray. She said she called this to the attention of other PAA personnel and they "let him get away." She said they told her he was a Mr. Sperling, one of their employees. She stated this individual was a white male, age 35, 5'10", 135-140 pounds, dark hair, dark eyes. She then became rambling in her conversation and talked about a Sergeant Rose at Kimberly Air Force Base and said "they" are trying to get her committed. When asked who "they" were, she said local police and members of the Klan. She said a local police officer was with her as she was making her call. When she was asked to put this officer on the phone, she said he declined.

The above information was telephonically furnished to Night Supervisor Karl Buckman, New York Office, and he was instructed to check with the Security Officer for PAA on 5-4-68, to determine if they do in fact have an employee by the name of Sperling at their Bermuda Office and further if there had been any incident wherein a woman may have tried to identify this individual as James Earl Ray on the night of 5-3-68. SA Buckman was advised that if they do have an employee by the name of Sperling, the New York Office should determine how long he has been employed with PAA. He was instructed to sutel results of inquiries on 5-4-68. It should be noted that Security Agent for PAA is John Willis, former Special Agent.
