This can primarily be done on the basis of length of time the box was rented or on the basis of the renter of the box being known to bank employees. Any questionable eliminations must be run out.

This is being suggested in light of the possibility that subject may have rented such a box and then while fleeing may have made entry for the purpose of withdrawing valuables.

STATE POLICE AGENCIES CONTINUING EFFORTS TO LOCATE SUBJECT IN CITY OF CAMPECHE AND ALL OUTLYING AREAS. POLICE FINGERPRINT FILES DATING BACK TO ONE NINE FIVE FIVE RECORD ALL FOREIGNERS WHO WERE IN TROUBLE WITH POLICE OR FINGERPRINTED FOR LACK OF PROPER IDENTIFICATION PAPERS AND SUBJECT'S PRINTS RUN THROUGH THESE FILES WITHOUT LOCATING RECORD.

Also attached is a photograph of Ray wearing dark glasses which was taken in November, 1967, while Ray was in Mexico.

Inasmuch as both of these photographs may be of assistance in locating subject, it is recommended that they be made available to the press by Crime Records together with the following brief statement:

The FBI today released two additional photographs of James Earl Ray who is being sought in connection with the murder of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. The photograph of Ray wearing dark glasses was taken in Mexico in November, 1967, while the photograph of Ray in a business suit was made in California during the last part of January or the early part of February, 1968.

RECOMMENDATION:

That authority be given Crime Records to release the attached two photographs and statement to the press.

Mrs. FRANCES STOKER JAMISON, 453 Paseo, Kansas City, Missouri, advised she has been legally separated from her husband, WILLIAM HOWARD JAMISON, for about three years. She stated he has been extremely religious since getting out of prison, and in her opinion is "sick", but would not harm anyone. She said JAMISON was in Kansas City, Kansas, at the time of KING's murder residing at 906 Ohio, Kansas City, Kansas, but left about a week later for California.

Mrs. JAMISON said she had a letter from her husband on 4/29/68 in which he indicated he was an Evangelist for Gospel Wings, 1948 Clinton, Los Angeles, California. She does not know of any threatening statements made by JAMISON regarding MARTIN LUTHER KING, but stated he might have made such statements while he was a member of the John Birch Society. She stated he has not been associated with this organization since getting out of prison.
