New York teletype to Baltimore, Dallas, El Paso, Oklahoma City, Philadelphia, Phoenix, Richmond and WFO, dated 4/30/68, contained the following:

Re OC tel to the Director, dated 4/26/68.

Mrs. [REDACTED] (protect identity), 309 Elmwood Drive, Edmond, Oklahoma, was re-interviewed and IO #4182 displayed to her. Mrs. [REDACTED] said the individual she saw on American Airlines Flight 338 from Dallas, Texas, to Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, on 4/6/68, very strongly resembled RAY and she believed him to be identical with RAY. She stated she first noticed this individual in Love Field Terminal, American Airlines waiting area a few moments prior to boarding this flight. Mrs. [REDACTED] could not locate her ticket stub but believed she occupied Seat 14-C, an aisle seat on left side of plane in tourist section and that the above individual occupied the aisle seat one row up on the right. Mrs. [REDACTED] said this individual did not get off the plane when it landed at Friendship Airport, Baltimore, Maryland, and did not converse with anyone on plane and carried no luggage. She informed he deplaned at Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, and she lost sight of him when her husband met her at the airport.

SAN STEWART, 112th MI Group, Ft. Bliss, Texas, advised on 5/1/68, that Sgt. WILLIE WEBB, JR. was separated from the U. S. Army on 4/6/68, and left as a forwarding address, #1 Tillerson, Newport News, Virginia.

The following information obtained on 5/1/68, from GUS BILL (protect identity), Unit Manager, Mountain States Telephone and Telegraph Co., was not included in the FTS telephone call but is being set forth here as confirming information of possible value:

E-5 WILLIE WEBB, JR., ASN US 525 725 79, residing Apt. #3, 3910 Taft, El Paso, Texas, had service from January, 1968, to 3/29/68. He was attached to the 581st Transportation Support Group. Upon discontinuing his telephone service, he left as a forwarding address in care of Mr. WILLIE WEBB, SR., father, #1 Tillerson Drive, Newport News, Virginia.

On 4/25/68 MR. JOHN J. O'DONNELL, 47 North 13th Street, Philadelphia, Pa., who is employed as a musician at the Cafe LaFitte, 1304 Drury Street, Philadelphia, Pa., appeared at the FBI Office at Philadelphia, where he related the following information:

On the evening of 4/6/68 he had encountered on the street near his home an individual who used the name of BILLY (LNU). O'DONNELL advised BILLY (LNU) was very cold and as a result, O'DONNELL took him to his home where he stayed for the evening and left the following morning.

According to O'DONNELL, BILLY (LNU) resembled the pictures of JAMES EARL RAY which appear in both the Time Magazine issue of 4/26/68, and the U.S. News and World Report issue of 4/29/68 and the pictures appearing on Identification

O'DONNELL advised that BILLY (LNU) told him that he was in Philadelphia to visit some friends with whom he had been in the service, but that when he went into a movie, his wallet was stolen and he did not know how to get in touch with these individuals.

O'DONNELL advised this individual said he had come from the State of Alabama and spoke with a Southern accent. He advised he appeared to be slightly illiterate and a bigot. He advised this BILLY (LNU) made reference to the killing of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING and said he believed the individual who did the killing would get a lot of money.

O'DONNELL stated this individual wore a dark blue sportshirt, with long sleeves; dark blue trousers; white sox; and black shoes, without any outer clothing in spite of the cold weather.

O'DONNELL advised that BILLY (LNU) had slightly stooped shoulders, pock marks on the back of his neck and shoulders, but he did not recall any scar on his forehead.

O'DONNELL furnished a gin bottle which he indicated BILLY (LNU) had handled on four or five occasions. He stated that he and BILLY (LNU) were the only ones who had handled this gin bottle and he stated he felt that his and BILLY's fingerprints could be obtained from this bottle to determine definitely if this individual were identical to RAY.

He advised he knew of no additional pertinent information relative to BILLY (LNU) which would be helpful in locating him.

The Identification Division is requested to compare the latent fingerprints developed from the enclosed empty bottle of Gilbey's Gin with the known fingerprints of RAY and advise the Philadelphia Office.

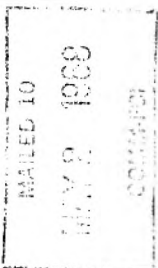

On 5/1/68, STEWART NORTHRUP, Manager, Bush Hotel, 621 South Jackson Street, Seattle, advised that THOMAS E. CRAMER was registered at the Bush Hotel from 3/2/68, until 4/27/68. He furnished a home address of 1320 West Oakdale, Chicago, Illinois. He roomed with one LOUIS FEE, home address 2227 West 22nd, Chicago, Illinois. Although CRAMER moved out of the hotel on 4/27/68, FEE still resides there.

NORTHRUP stated he believed CRAMER to be employed at the White Front Department Store in Seattle, Washington.

On May 1, 1968, inquiry at the White Front Department Store, Aurora Avenue North, Seattle, failed to reflect any employee by the name of CRAMER or CREAMER.

On 5/1/68, MICHAEL MURRAY, Manager, White Front Department Store, Burien, Washington, advised that THOMAS CRAMER is employed there in the Sporting Goods Department. CRAMER was off on 5/1/68 but due to return to work on 5/2/68. MURRAY did not have a home address for CRAMER.

MURRAY referred to employment records for CRAMER and stated that he has been employed with White Front since 3/11/68, and is a most satisfactory employee. He stated that he works five days a week from 12:00 PM to 9:00 PM.

During April his days off were Wednesday and Thursday, although MURRAY could not be sure that CRAMER took his days off since employees sometimes work on their day off or trade the day off with other employees for personal reasons.

THOMAS CRAMER was interviewed at the White Front Department Store, Burien, Washington, on 5/2/68. He stated he has been in Seattle continuously since early March, 1968 with the exception of a few short trips to the nearby rural areas for fishing. CRAMER advised that while employed at the Stuart Warner Corporation, 1826 West Diversy Street, Chicago, Illinois, in 1966, he had occasion to fire a Negro girl under his supervision. Shortly thereafter a series of what he described as retaliatory measures took place, among them a personal assault on CRAMER accompanied by the theft of his automobile and threats to his family. When his automobile was recovered, it was found to have sugar in the gas tank and other damage which appeared to have been deliberately caused.

CRAMER stated that shortly after the above incidents, two detectives from the Damon Avenue Station of the Chicago Police Department approached him at his home and furnished him with information re HELENA KAUFMAN, such as that set forth in re Chicago tel. He advised the detectives at that time that he believed this to be another retaliatory measure by members of the "Deacons For Defense", a Negro organization whom CRAMER believes is responsible for the attacks on his person and property in retaliation for his firing of the Negro girl, above. He felt at that time that this matter had been settled to the satisfaction of the Chicago Police. CRAMER stated that his supervisor at that time was one NITCH TSCHAIKOWSKY (PH) whom he claimed would verify the above information. He stated that TSCHAIKOWSKY would also be in a position to furnish information regarding a bomb threat which was received at Stuart Warner Corporation around the same time as the above incidents and which CRAMER believes probably was connected with the Deacons for Defense.

CRAMER advised he was born [redacted] at Lima, Ohio, and currently resides at 6762 - 34th Avenue, White Center, Seattle, Washington. He operates a 1962 Oldsmobile. He claims to have been arrested on two occasions in Chicago as a result of fights.

On May 2, 1968, LOUIS FEE, the Bush Hotel, Seattle,

advised that he met CRAMER in Denver, Colorado, in early March, 1968. They came to Seattle together and lived, until recently, together at the Bush Hotel. FEE stated that, to the best of his knowledge, CRAMER has been in Seattle continuously since they arrived. He stated that he also worked at the White Front Department Store with CRAMER and knows that CRAMER was also continuously employed at that store since March, 1968. FEE specifically recalled telling CRAMER during the early part of April, 1968, of the assassination of MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., and pointed out that FEE was the first one to mention this to CRAMER. He recalled that this was either during the afternoon or early evening on the day KING was shot.

In view of the above, UAC, no further investigation is being conducted regarding CRAMER at Seattle.

visit lasted until the day after Thanksgiving, 1967, at which time DOWDA, driving his wife's Volkswagen, bearing Georgia license plates, departed with his wife en route to Monterey, California.

Mr. GRAHAM stated that approximately one and a half days later, DOWDA and his wife returned to the GRAHAMs' residence claiming he had lost his wallet in Monterey and was without funds. GRAHAM advised that he gave DOWDA sufficient funds to drive back to Atlanta, Georgia.

GRAHAM, after consulting a 1967 calendar, recalled that DOWDA arrived at his residence on 11/22/67, and stayed through a portion of the day 11/24/67. He left en route to Monterey on that date and returned to Los Angeles from Monterey approximately 11/25/67.

DOWDA should be reinterviewed about his activities during the period of time when he left Los Angeles, California; allegedly going to Monterey, California.

GRAHAM advised that he would consult with his wife on the evening of 5/2/68, and would be available for reinterview on 5/3/68.

Los Angeles will reinterview GRAHAM 5/3/68, and will advise results.

SUSPECT HAROLD EDWARD NICHOLS, aka Hal Nichols.

For information of offices not previously having information concerning NICHOLS, he is considered possible suspect and co-conspirator because of an alleged offer to an informant to furnish airline tickets and untraceable weapon if the informant would travel to unspecified place to kill certain designated Negro leaders including MARTIN LUTHER KING.

The reliability and credibility of the informant is unknown but is considered subject to doubt because of discrepancies of his stories, and because of information received from other sources.

NICHOLS has been extremely active in affairs of the American Independent Party in California, prompting GEORGE WALLACE for president.

AGENTS IN INTERVIEWS SHOULD EXERCISE DISCRETION AND CAUTION TO PREVENT ANY FALSE ALLEGATIONS THAT THE FBI IS CONDUCTING INVESTIGATION CONCERNING ACTIVITIES OF THE AIP.

HAROLD EDWARD NICHOLS, commonly known as HAL NICHOLS, was interviewed at his apartment, #33 Los Palmas Apartments, 15375 Tropic Court, San Leandro, California. After proper identification, he was advised that investigation was being conducted by the Federal Bureau of Investigation concerning a violation of Federal Law in connection with the murder of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING. Further, that an allegation had been received that Mr. NICHOLS might have information pertinent to this matter on the basis of remarks NICHOLS is reported to have made concerning such matters in the presence of others.

Mr. NICHOLS advised that he has no information concerning the murder, and except for his personal opinion as to who might be responsible, has no specific information concerning the murder. He said he had absolutely no objection to discussion of the matter.

Mr. NICHOLS advised that he is extremely active in the political field at the present time and in the recent past. He is a member of an eight man board in charge of promoting candidates for the American Independent Party (AIP) in California, and particularly in behalf of the candidacy of former Governor GEORGE WALLACE of Alabama for President. He stated that most persons not familiar with the AIP program and objectives, seem to assume that those favoring AIP are what is sometimes termed "negro-baiters." He denied that this is true, and said that from the view point of promoting the AIP, the murder of Dr. KING under such circumstances was a set back to the AIP who might have favored their principles.

He said that no one knowledgeable in affairs of the AIP would have caused or participated in a situation or action such as this in that it would be certain to make a "Martyr" of Dr. KING, which would hurt the AIP.

However, since persons generally seem to associate AIP members with "negro-baiters," he is frequently "kidded" along such lines by certain persons with whom he regularly comes into contact.
