On 5/2/68 DUANE SAXON, Manager, Produce Division, Allied Supermarkets, Inc., advised SA J. A. GRIMES there are no records available which would specifically identify the receipt of a phone call to this company on 12/15/67 from the Pecos, Texas, area. He advised that truck drivers hauling produce for the company will generally call the produce division one or two days before arriving and he would assume that the call from the Pecos area was from a truck driver. He advised that a check of his records revealed the company received a load of tomatoes from the Nogales, Arizona, area on 12/18/67. The records indicate the load ~~was~~ a split load, where part of the load was delivered to Dallas, Texas. From these circumstances, Mr. SAXON feels certain the telephone call would have been a check call from the trucker advising the company of the expected date of arrival of the load of tomatoes in Oklahoma City.

It was determined that telephone number 405-762-3996  
is listed to EARL FISHER, present address 425 D South Palm,  
Ponca City, Oklahoma.

Mr. and Mrs. EARL FISHER, 425 D South Palm, on 5/2/68  
advised they have had that number for over a year, and that the  
photographs and description of Subject are totally unfamiliar to  
them. They are a retired farmer and wife, and at first advised  
they could recall no telephone call from Southwest Texas received  
in December, 1967. After discussion, they recalled that in  
December, 1967, their daughter MELBA and her husband JIM WHEELER  
were staying with them in Ponca City and that JIM had been driving  
a construction job dump truck in Southwest Texas near El Paso  
for JACK MC CUNE, who owns two such trucks used on contract work.  
WHEELER had returned to Ponca City, and had been called shortly  
before Christmas, 1967, by MC CUNE from somewhere in Southwest  
Texas to tell him his pay check was being mailed to him, and  
possibly to be asked by MC CUNE to return to work for him.  
MC CUNE, who had previously been working around Ponca City, also  
had a check coming to him in care of the FISHER's address, he  
thought, which he wanted forwarded.

Mr. and Mrs. FISHER advised MELBA and JIM are presently  
residing at P. O. Box 207, Lockwood, Missouri, but that JIM  
WHEELER is now driving an over-the-road truck for Tri-State  
Trucking Company, Joplin, Missouri, and the last they heard a  
few days ago, he was in Portland, Oregon, en route from there  
to New Jersey.

They are unable to recall the exact location in  
Southwest Texas where MC CUNE was, and possibly still is, located,  
as JIM WHEELER stayed there with MC CUNE only a few days after  
helping him move his trucks there, since MC CUNE and his wife  
both drank heavily and WHEELER figured MC CUNE would be unable to  
hold a contract very long. Mr. and Mrs. FISHER advised MC CUNE  
is about 50 years of age, bald headed, was originally from  
Fairfax, Oklahoma, and has a married sister, name unknown, living  
in Ponca City.

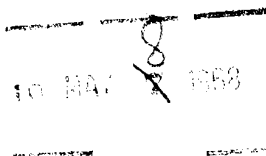
Neither the MOONs nor the McANALLYs had any information concerning James Earl Ray.

The following investigation was conducted at Williamsburg, Va., by SA H. CURTISS BURRELL:

On 5/3/68 Mrs. WYOLENE POINTER, Superintendent's Office, Eastern State Hospital, Williamsburg, Va., furnished their file on FRANK HENRY NILES, patient # 43520. A review of this file revealed the following information:

NILES was committed at Eastern State Hospital on 1/17/68 under a regular commitment by Special Justice DANIEL GRINNAN, City of Richmond, Richmond, Va.

He was diagnosed as being a psychoneurotic reactive - depressive reactive.

He was allowed one pass, which was issued for the period of 4/24-26/68, when he listed his destination as being 6150 Wilson Boulevard, Arlington, Va. He has missed no scheduled roll calls at Eastern State Hospital.

Very little background information has been acquired by Eastern State Hospital. On several occasions they have sent personal background questionnaires to Mrs. CECILIA HOPE LEWIS at 5099 Tinelawn Avenue, Chattanooga, Tennessee. They have received no replies from Mrs. LEWIS.

Their files revealed that NILES was confined at the St. Joseph Hospital, 205 West 29th St., Lorain, Ohio, from 6/28/67 to 8/11/67.

NILES is described as a white male, born [redacted] 131 pounds, 5'9" tall, blue eyes, gray hair, with mustache.

The admitting doctor was W. H. BATTE.

His attending physician is Dr. MARTIN PALMAZ.

Interview of Dr. PALMAZ revealed that NILES is an alcoholic currently assigned to the Alcoholic Vocational Rehabilitation Section of the Eastern State Hospital. It is noted that this area is not secured at all times. Dr. PALMAZ advised that NILES is a definite racist but has had no violence exhibited toward any of his fellow Negro inmates. Dr. PALMAZ described his feelings as being merely a general prejudice. He is described as being very polite but in definite need of a great deal of activity to keep his mind occupied. Dr. PALMAZ advised that he has a very deep-seated hostility toward life in general and that things need to go his way at all times. Dr. PALMAZ considers him to have definite suicidal tendencies. Dr. PALMAZ advised he has never heard NILES make any comments regarding any of the racial or Nazi leaders in the United States.

Dr. PALMAZ noted that NILES wrote a letter to the Social Security Administration recently in regard to his Social Security account, number [redacted] which he felt was delinquent.

It was noted that since March 30, 1968, NILES has been allowed to work at the Howard Johnson's Restaurant, off the Eastern State Hospital's grounds, in Williamsburg, Va. Since that time and to date, he has worked five and six days a week, ~~48~~ hours per week, and is paid \$58.

On 5/3/68 JAMES HAMILTON, Manager, Howard Johnson's Restaurant, Williamsburg, Va., was interviewed and advised that NILES was employed at his restaurant from 3/30/68 to the present time. He noted that he was at all times on duty during the period 4/3-6/68. His days off during the instant period were April 2 and 9, 1968. HAMILTON advised that NILES is very well liked and gets along well with all the Negro help.

It was noted that NILES returned to the Eastern State Hospital after his work days during the instant period and at all times during his period of employment at the Howard Johnson's Restaurant. He has missed no roll calls at Eastern State Hospital.

No further investigation being conducted concerning NILES at Norfolk.

Records of the Denver Police Department, Bureau of Identification and Records, Denver, Colorado, reveal that Holt Chew, Denver Police Department Number 56534, was placed on probation April 24, 1967 after conviction for shooting James Thomas Jackson, a Negro on January 20, 1966.

On April 29, 1968 and April 30, 1968, Chew was interviewed by Special Agents of the FBI. He was asked if he recalled he made a telephone call to the office of Martin Luther King in Atlanta, Georgia on December 18, 1968. He reflected for a few moments and then said he was not about to lie about the situation, especially to the FBI. He said that he has no love for Martin Luther King and is glad he is dead. He stated King was not the non-violent civil rights leader he claimed to be. Wherever he went, violence followed and he was responsible for 37 deaths in the United States. He added that, as a personal matter, King was directly responsible for the destruction of the business career of one of his sons, Bill Chew of Saint Augustine, Florida. He estimated his son's financial loss at \$400,000.00.

Chew stated that his son was head of a hotel and motel association in Saint Augustine, Florida a few years ago when King and his followers came down to Florida and started efforts to integrate the industry. His son was also operating a motel in Saint Augustine at the time. Bill Chew was taken into Federal Court by these people for refusing to integrate his establishment and as the result of an unfavorable court decision, he ended up resigning his position with the association and selling his motel at a

severe loss. Chew said that there was considerable newspaper publicity over the matter at the time.

Chew placed King in the same category as Stokely Carmichael and H. Rap Brown and stated frankly that he hoped the same fate befalls the latter two. He made the statement that he is not against the Negro race; that he was born in Georgia, brought up with Negroes and hunted and fished with them. He made it clear that he is against some individual Negroes like Carmichael and Brown, who advocate violence and have no regard for property rights, but is not against all Negroes.

Having made these points, he returned to the original question and stated that he had no recollection of the telephone call and admitted that the reason could be that he could have been drinking at the time the call was made. He volunteered that at that time in his life he was a "bad drinker". He emphasized that he had no doubt that he made the call, if interviewing Agents said he did, but that he could not recall it. He stated that he was certain, whether or not he had been drinking, that he would not have made a threat over the telephone since he knows such a threat could lead to trouble for him. He said if he had had any **intention** of doing anything concerning King, he would not **have** used the telephone, he would have taken direct action.

Chew advised that he is certain that no one "put him up" to making the telephone call, and it was not an action involving anyone other than himself. He was shown photographs of James Earl Ray, the man being sought in connection with the assassination of Martin Luther King, but disclaimed any knowledge whatsoever of Ray.

He constantly referred to King, Carmichael and Brown using expletives in an effort to show his intense dislike for these men.

He stated that he was in Denver on April 4, 1968 and April 5, 1968 and left the city by Eastern Airlines for Augusta, Georgia on April 6, 1968 where he is promoting business interests in the food industry, whereby he hopes to set up his son Bill in business. He was unwilling to further identify his business interests. He stated his son Bill is

presently running the Paradise Motel in Sylvania, Georgia and drove up from there to meet him in Augusta the first part of the week of April 7, 1968. Both he and his son then drove to Sylvania and on to St. Augustine, Florida where they were met on April 12, 1968 by Mrs. Chow and a younger son, who had just returned from military service in Korea. He said his wife and younger son flew from Denver. Thereafter, he and his family vacationed in Florida until he, his wife and younger son returned to Denver on April 28, 1968 in a new car he purchased in Florida.

He specifically stated that he had nothing to do with King's death and said that he knew of no conspiracy relating to it. He stated that he saw King's funeral on television and the way it was conducted it looked to him like it had been planned for 20 years.

He volunteered to the interviewing Agents that he has every intention of protecting his apartment house property in Denver, Colorado with as much force as is necessary if anyone attempts to cause damage or loot it. He stated that he was angry at the leaders of this country for putting up with rioting, looting and the like. He thinks that the Attorney General is "very weak" and used more expletives to emphasize his point. He stated that he is "all for" law and order, but would like to see law enforcement empowered to act. He also stated that he was angry because the National Association For The Advancement of Colored People were able to close businesses throughout the country after King's death when very few businesses closed after President Kennedy's assassination; and he is convinced that threats were used to accomplish the closing of businesses in Denver, as he was so informed before he left on his trip.

It should be noted that a source who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised on January 21, 1966 that Chow is a highly irascible and unpredictable individual, an alcoholic and possibly a user of narcotics.

Mrs. Holt Chow on April 30, 1968 advised that her husband left Denver on April 6, 1968 for Augusta,

Georgia via Eastern Airlines and that she and a younger son traveled to Florida to meet him on April 12, 1968 via United, Eastern and Delta airlines.

Records of the Retail Credit Men's Association, Denver, Colorado revealed on April 30, 1968 that Holt Chew was born [redacted] at Bert City, Georgia. He attended school there and came to Denver in 1932. He served in the United States Army during World War II and has been owner and operator of Holt Chew Motor Company for many years. His wife's name is Elaine and he has four children. He has been on record with the credit bureau since February, 1937 and has maintained a satisfactory credit rating.

Referenced LHM indicates Chew to be owner and operator of Holt Chew Motor Company. Bureau files indicate Chew to be a former automobile dealer. It would appear that if Chew still operates Holt Chew Motor Company, that a review of toll call records made by him might be a considerable project. By return airtel advise if Chew still operates the above-named motor company and whether, in your estimation, a check of telephone toll calls made by Chew since 4/23/67, the date that suspect James Earl Ray escaped from prison, would involve the expenditure of considerable Agent time.

In connection with your request to check telephone toll call records, your attention is directed to Bureau airtel to Albany dated 12/5/66, captioned, "Obtaining Telephone Toll Records - Bureau Investigations" wherein it is stated you should specifically comment as to whether such records can be subpoenaed by a Federal Grand Jury when submitting a request for examination of such records. Your comments as to whether such records can be obtained by subpoena through a Federal Grand Jury should be contained in any future requests you submit in this case.

Chew, in interviews on 4/29-30/68, admitted he was glad Martin Luther King was dead. Chew holds King responsible for an alleged \$400,000 loss suffered by Chew's son, Bill Chew, as a result of efforts of King and his followers to integrate the motel industry in Florida. In December, 1965, Chew called King's office and warned an assistant that King should be careful as someone was going to assassinate him. Chew denies knowing suspect James Earl Ray and declared he knew of no conspiracy relating to it. Chew flew from Denver to Augusta, Georgia, on 4/6/68. Suspect James Earl Ray was last known to have been in Atlanta, Georgia, on 4/5/68. Denver has requested to check toll calls made by Chew to determine if he is possibly implicated in this case.

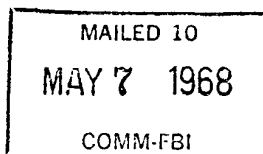

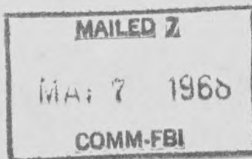

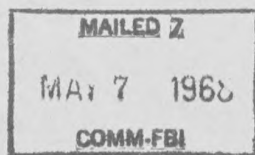
