"ONE: THE U. S. GOVERNMENT WILL NOT ISSUE A PASSPORT FOR TRAVEL TO RHODESIA.

"TWO: WOULD THEIR BE ANY WAY TO ENTER RHODESIA LEGALLY (FROM THE RHODESIAN GOVERNMENT POINT OF VIEW).

"I WOULD APPRECIATE ANY INFORMATION YOU COULD GIVE ME ON THE ABOVE SUBJECT OR ANY OTHER INFORMATION ON RHODESIA.

ACORD WAS IN RHODESIA WHEN THE LETTER WAS RECEIVED AT HIS OFFICE AND HIS SECRETARY REPLIED TO THIS LETTER WITH A FORM LETTER ENCLOSING LITERATURE ON RHODESIA.

ACORD ALSO SAID HE MAY HAVE MET GALT IN NOVEMBER, SIXTY-SEVEN IN HOLLYWOOD, CALIFORNIA AS HE RECALLS AN INDIVIDUAL ASKING HIM QUESTIONS ABOUT EMIGRATING TO RHODESIA. ACORD WAS SHOWN ALL PHOTOGRAPHS OF JAMES EARL RAY AND ACORD SAID THEY WERE NOT OF THE INDIVIDUAL HE RECALLS WHO QUESTIONED HIM.

THE WRITER OF ABOVE LETTER WAS IN ERROR REGARDING PASSPORTS AS RHODESIA IS NOT AND HAS NEVER BEEN ON THE LIST OF COUNTRIES TO WHICH TRAVEL BY AMERICANS HAS BEEN RESTRICTED BY THE STATE DEPARTMENT. A U. S. PASSPORT ISSUED IN SIXTYEIGHT IS VALID FOR THREE YEARS FOR ALL COUNTRIES EXCEPT CUBA, MAINLAND CHINA, NORTH KOREA AND NORTH VIETNAM.

KEN H. TOWSEY, INFORMATION OFFICER, RHODESIAN GOVERNMENT, WDC (PROTECT IDENTITY) ADVISED HE HAS COPY OF LETTER FURNISHED BY ACORD. TOWSEY WILL REVIEW FILES HIS OFFICE AND ADVISE IF FURTHER INFORMATION CONCERNING GALT LOCATED. TOWSEY OFFERED ON BEHALF OF HIS GOVERNMENT ALL ASSISTANCE POSSIBLE; HOWEVER,

DESIRES A FORMAL REQUEST IN ANY FORM. The following investigation was conducted by SA ROBERT A. DAVIDSON:

AT EULESS, TEXAS

On 5/6/68, MR. ROBERT BOGASH, District Claims Supervisor, Allied Van Lines, Pipe Line and Highway 157, advised that telephone No. 817-283-1541 is the number for this Allied Van Lines office, which is the check point and dispatching office for a five-state area which includes New Mexico, Oklahoma, Arkansas, Louisiana, and Texas. He advised there are no records kept of incoming calls and he would therefore have no way of knowing the details of a call made to the above number on 12/16/67.

He further stated that drivers for Allied Van Lines are required to check in once a day at the nearest check point, and that the drivers pay for these calls at the time they are made, and that it is generally customary to place the call person to person in order for them to speak to a specific dispatcher. In view of the above, BOGASH concluded that the call made on 12/16/67 from either Van Horn, Valentine or Sierra Blanco, Texas was probably a routine check-in by one of their drivers.

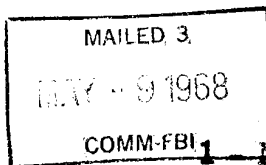
