previously from Columbus, Ohio visited he and his wife. After departing their residence, he returned East traveling through the state of Texas. It is Mr. SEAMAN's recollection that GUY MARINI telephoned he and his wife from Texas during the middle of December, 1967. The present whereabouts of GUY MARINI is unknown to Mr. SEAMAN.

On 5/7/68, PAMELA DOBERSTEIN, 4095 Hatton Drive, San Diego, California, advised that she and her parents reside at this address and have telephone number 279-1714.

According to PAMELA DOBERSTEIN, she has an uncle, a brother of her mother, named NORBERT VILLAFLO, who formerly resided at Orange Street, Vidor, Texas. Miss DOBERSTEIN recalls the family received a telephone call from NORBERT VILLAFLO during the middle of December, 1967.

The present whereabouts of NORBERT VILLAFLO are unknown to Miss DOBERSTEIN and her family since he has departed Vidor, Texas.

Photographs of RAY were displayed to PAMELA DOBERSTEIN and RUDOLPH SEAMAN and both advised the subject is unknown to them.

The following investigation was conducted by SA HERBERT H. BUTLER on 5/7/68:

On 5/7/68, SOLEDAD GONZALEZ, 183 Star Route, Valley Centre, California, advised her parents, MATTHEW and EVA CARRILLO, reside adjacent to her and that telephone number 745-1548 is assigned to their residence. She further stated that her brothers, [REDACTED] and RICHARD CARRILLO, ages 17 and 19, and her sister, MARIA, age 21, also reside at her parents' residence.

On 5/7/68, EVA CARRILLO advised she is unable to speak English and consequently was interviewed with the assistance of her daughter, SOLEDAD GONZALEZ. Mrs. CARRILLO stated that she generally is the only individual in the household during daylight hours and that she is unable to recall having received a telephone call from Texas in December, 1967. She stated, however, that it is possible that she did receive such telephone call and is unable to

recall it. She further advised that if the caller had spoke in English, she would have been unable to correspond and would have consequently quickly terminated the conversation and probably not recall it. Also, that if the caller had dialed a wrong number, she probably would not recall this.

All the members of the CARRILLO household consisted of JOSE, RICHARD, MARIA, and Mr. MATTHEW CARRILLO were interviewed and all advised that they have no recollection of receiving a telephone call from Texas in December, 1967. When questioned regarding friends, relatives, and associates possibly residing in the state of Texas, they all advised they have relatives residing in El Paso, but that since they are on an extremely low economic level, they do not believe they would have attempted to telephone them.

MARIA CARRILLO, upon interview, stated that during the latter part of December, 1967, including December 17, 1967, her brother, ANTONIO CARRILLO, a Catholic priest from Mexico, was visiting with her and her family and that the possibility exists that he received the telephone call. She stated he is currently residing at Casa Parroquial, Tenajapa, Chiapas, Mexico.

An additional copy of this airtel is being furnished the Bureau for transmittal to Legat, Mexico, so that Father, ANTONIO CARRILLO, presently residing at Casa Parroquial, Tenajapa, Chiapas, Mexico can be contacted to determine if he received a telephone call during the middle of December from the state of Texas while visiting his sister at Valley Centre, California.

A photograph of subject RAY should be displayed to Father CARRILLO to determine if subject RAY is known to him in view of the fact that subject RAY has a past history of travel to Mexico.

On May 9, 1968, the New York Office received information from the New York City Police Department (NYPD) regarding the activities of a group known as the "Black Liberation Army" (BLA). This group is alleged to be involved in the assassination of Martin Luther King, Jr. The NYPD has advised that the BLA is a multi-racial organization that operates in the New York City area. It is claimed that the BLA has a number of active members and is engaged in various activities, including the recruitment of new members and the planning of future actions. The NYPD has also advised that the BLA is in contact with other groups and individuals who are active in the civil rights movement.

The New York Office is currently conducting an investigation into the activities of the BLA. This investigation includes the review of all information received from the NYPD and other sources. The New York Office is also conducting interviews with individuals who are known to be active in the civil rights movement. The results of this investigation will be reported to the Bureau as soon as they are available.

JOANNE MASTERS ADVISED BUREAU AGENT ON CONFIDENTIAL BASIS, FIVE EIGHT SIXTYEIGHT, AS

FOLLOWS:

SHE, THOUGH NOT BELIEVED TO BE FULLY COOPERATIVE WITH LOCAL POLICE, INDICATED DUNAWAY CAME TO HER MORNING AFTER DI MAGGIO MURDER STATING TO HER HE WAS IN TROUBLE, A MAN WAS DEAD AND HE WAS INVOLVED. DUNAWAY GAVE NO OTHER DETAILS TO MASTERS AND ONLY STAYED APPROXIMATELY THREE MINUTES STATING HE WOULD GET IN TOUCH WITH HER LATER. MASTERS NOT SEEN DUNAWAY SINCE. HOWEVER, DUNAWAY HAS PHONED MASTERS TWO OR THREE TIMES PER WEEK WITH LAST CALL BEING FOUR TWENTYNINE SIXTYEIGHT. MASTERS CAUTIONED DUNAWAY EACH TIME TO NOT PHONE HER AS NOT WANT TO BE INVOLVED. ALSO, NOT TO STATE WHEREABOUTS OVER PHONE AS NOT WANT TO KNOW AND PHONE MIGHT BE "BUGGED". MASTERS STATED HAD NO IDEA OF DUNAWAY'S WHEREABOUTS AT ANY TIME AS PHONE CALLS WERE DIRECT DIALED. DURING LAST PHONE CALL DUNAWAY STATED WORDS TO EFFECT OF "DON'T WORRY, I'M ON MY WAY ON A BUS AND THEY WON'T GET ME NOW."
