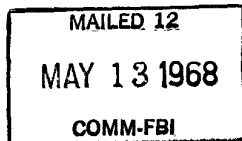

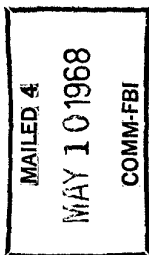

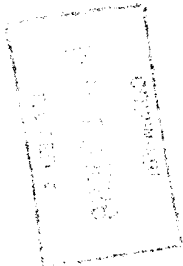

At 8:15, 5/11/68, an individual who identified himself as Clovis Zirnstein, 871 West 5th Avenue, Emporia, Kansas, telephone number DI-2-8587, telephonically contacted the Bureau and spoke to SA Orvis J. Auerswald, on duty in the Special Investigative Division. Mr. Zirnstein, who stated he is an engineer for the Santa Fe Railroad, spoke as though he may have been drinking.

Mr. Zirnstein advised that on Sunday, 4/28/68, while driving north on Highway 71, he picked up a hitchhiker near Carthage, Missouri, and he now feels this individual could be identical with James Earl Ray. He said the hitchhiker was well dressed, had brown hair, wore a hat, and carried a very heavy suitcase. He described him as 5'9" or 5'10", 175 or 180 pounds, and in good physical condition. He furnished his name to Mr. Zirnstein as Bill Magee and said he was 47 years of age, having been born in Fort Scott, Kansas, where his mother presently resides. He also mentioned that his brother, Charles Magee, "owned half the town" of Fort Scott, Kansas. *GER*

Mr. Zirnstein advised that the hitchhiker said he had been in Germany during World War II and stated he was a karate expert. He told Mr. Zirnstein that he was employed by the Midwest Construction Company, Holton, Kansas, as a laborer on highway jobs, and also said he was an electrician and carpenter. He said his father's name was also Charles Magee. *44-38861-310*

Mr. Zirnstein said the hitchhiker did not resemble the photographs he had seen of James Earl Ray; however, he feels he could have disguised himself. He also mentioned that the hitchhiker appeared to be about 47 years old as he claimed. He stated the hitchhiker rode with him to Fort Scott, Kansas, and insisted at being let out at a railroad crossing there, which he said was two blocks from his mother's home, although



Mr. Zirnshtein offered to drive him to her home. He advised that the hitchhiker mentioned once during the ride that Dr. Martin Luther King got what he deserved, but he said nothing to indicate he was in any way involved in the assassination. He told Mr. Zirnshtein he had not had much luck hitchhiking and said he had ridden with a truck driver from Springfield, Missouri, to Carthage, Missouri.

Bureau files contain no record of the caller and nothing which could be identified with Bill Magee or Charles Magee, based on the information he furnished.

ACTION:

At 9:40 p.m., 5/11/68, the information received from Mr. Zirnshtein was telephonically furnished to SAC Karl W. Dissly of the Kansas City Office. He advised that Clovis Zirnshtein will be promptly interviewed and thereafter investigation will be conducted to determine whether or not the individual mentioned by him is identical with Ray.

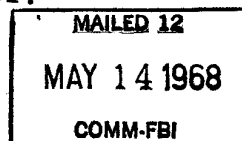

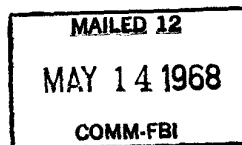

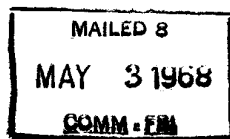
