COMROY stated that he was downtown, driving in his own car when he observed this individual, who appeared to be, or at least resembled RAY. He stated he went around the dock, came back and copied a license number after he observed this man enter an old green vehicle which he believed to be a Chrysler product. This license was copied down by himself and he then telephoned the FSI in Washington giving them the details as he recalled same. In regards to distance, ONROY said that he was on the opposite side of the street when this man left the drugstore and he again observed him after driving around the block from a distance of 30 or so feet, but did not get a good view, since the man was in the car. CONROY was not absolutely sure that this individual was RAY, however, indicated he wished to aide the FBI in any conceivable way possible, therefore, had immediately or soon thereafter telephoned Washington. CONROL had no additional information to add to the above facts or glaborate on the information furnished Washington.

Further inquiry in the area indicates that PHILLIPS may be an employee of SAM FREEMAN who operated a Fish Camp in Shannon, Miss., and may have been a runner for SAM FREEMAN.

The information furnished to Chicago by PHILLIPS concerning illegal "booze" operations in and around the Tupelo, Miss., area is common knowledge to both law enforcement and private citizens in the area. This includes information that CARL MURPHY, JR. hired J. W. RILEY to kill JAMES "GRUBBY" GRUBBS.

It is the opinion of local authorities that CARL MURPHY, JR. would run anyone out of that section of the county who attempted in any way to infringe on his bootleg business.

DAVID LAMAR SCOTT, Tupelo, Miss., was a well known operator in the northern district of Miss. He has been convicted in both state and federal court for whiskey violations.

Attempts to locate CARL MURPHY, JR. for interview purposes in connection with alleged offer of \$2,500 to kill MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. has been negative.

MURPHY has never been known to associate with racial groups or to be involved in segregation in any way. He has always been known as a bootleg whiskey operator in the northern district.

On 5/7/68, First Class Cabin Stewardess CATHERINE HINES, aboard Frontier Airlines Flight 785 F, 4/27/68, on flight from Albuquerque to Phoenix, and Tourist Cabin Stewardess Miss J. JACKSON, aboard the same flight, advised SA BOYD D. ADSIT that they recall no one by the name of CARL RAY being aboard that flight and neither recognized any picture of JAMES EARL RAY as being that of any person aboard the flight.

On 5/4 and 5/5/68, all hotels in Denver and all motels in vicinity Stapleton International Airport were checked for reservation by CARL RAY with negative results.

In view of the differences between the descriptions given of CARL RAY by the various airlines employees and the description of JAMES EARL RAY, and in view of the information set forth in referenced FBI Laboratory reports, Denver does not contemplate setting forth leads to have other persons aboard Frontier Airlines Flight 785, Albuquerque to Phoenix, 4/27/68, interviewed concerning CARL RAY unless advised to the contrary by the office of origin.




