NORRIS CARMERDELLE, Owner and Manager of the Canal Bank Inn has previously advised that BILLINGS resided in Apartment 6, 315 Laurossini St., Westwego, La., from May, to December, 1965, and this apartment was rented by ENIS HEAD. CARMERDELLE made no mention of the name BEN BLACKWELL, who is the individual with whom BILLINGS states he resided.

BILLINGS advised he was to take BARBER to Guy's International Bar to meet a man named (FNU) FURIES, or FERRIES (phonetic). It is felt that (FNU) FURIES or FERRIES is possibly identical with DAVID FERRIE, now deceased, who was a principal in DA JAMES GARRISON's probe of the assassination of President JOHN F. KENNEDY.

In view of this information and BILLINGS past history of mental illness, New Orleans is conducting no further investigation concerning CARLOS LEE BILLINGS.

Cummings said he had information about an individual who he believed might have been involved in the murder of Dr. Martin Luther King. He wanted to turn this information over to the FBI on this date because the individual was in Nashville and would be leaving the night of 5/19/68.

At this point the operator advised that Cummings three minutes was up and the call ended.

Security Clerk Danny Downum, Memphis Division, was immediately contacted and supplied with above information. He was instructed to have an Agent immediately contact Mr. Cummings and advise Bureau of results.

Each Special Agent in Charge and Legal Attache is instructed to promptly remind their established cooperative news sources, in a discreet and tactful manner, of the existence of substantial reward money for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the killer of Dr. Martin Luther King. This money now totals at least \$100,000. The FBI should not, however, be publicized as the source of this reminder.

While the Bureau's continuing policy is to encourage the public to furnish information to law enforcement authorities as a matter of good citizenship, without expectation of financial reward, it is fully recognized that monetary rewards are often necessary to motivate some individuals. The knowledge of the existence of the substantial rewards available in the Murkin case could possibly prove of value in the solution of this major investigation.




