Judge Casey had asked Bureau advice as to whether he should delay until after the Poor Peoples Campaign as publicity of his order could cause widespread disorder. Casey was advised that the Bureau could not counsel him on what action he should take but that if he felt publicizing his order could cause disturbances he should take the necessary steps to alert appropriate law enforcement agencies after the order is entered and before it is publicized.



With regard to the body of the unidentified man discovered by Mexican Police, Mr. Ferris, Legat, Mexico, telephonically advised at 2:40 p.m., 5-11-68, he is unable to make comparison of fingerprints taken by local police with prints of Ray on wanted flyer due to very poor impressions obtained by local police and deteriorated condition of body when prints taken. The body has been reburied and another set of prints cannot be secured; therefore, the fingerprints will be sent to Washington, D.C., in order that an effort can be made by the identification Division to identify or eliminate the prints with those in the fingerprint sacket of Ray.

Mr. Ferris telephonically advised at 6:50 p.m., 5-11-68, the fingerprints noted above were being sent on Eastern Airlines Flight #910, scheduled to arrive at Dulles Airport at 19:04 p.m., and would be in possession of the pilot, Captain George Cleveland. Also enclosed with these prints will be an envelope containing a blood specimen imbedded in sand which was furnished by Mexican Police.

Mr. Ferris informed the local newspapers on 5-11-68, contained an article about the possibility the unknown body may be Ray and stated Mexican Police authorities and furnished fingerprints of the body to the United States Embassy for forwarding to the FBI. Mr. Agreek was furnished this information.

Special Agent William Haynes, Washington Field Office; was instructed to have a Bureau Agent most the mentioned flight at Dalles Airport and deliver the prints to Room \$136, Identification Division Building. Mr. Latena of Montification Division was requested to arrange to have the fingerprints received from Legat, Mexico compared with prints of Ray and advise of the results.

Mr. Bonebrake of identification Division advised at 11:55 p.m., 5-11-68, it was not possible to make a determination whether the prints were or were not identical with those of Ray.

Mr. Ferris telephonically advised at 12:10 a.m., 5-12-68, the only other data available as to identification of the body in Mexico are photographs taken by local police and these photographs are not considered very good, especially in view of deteriorated condition of the body.

Mr. Ferris suggested the possibility be explored to have one of our expects come down to Mexico to act as a "consultant" in connection with obtaining a better set of prints, provided arrangements might be made to have the body exhumed again.

On 5-12-66, efforts are being initiated by Serology in the Laboratory to examine the blood samples to determine the possibility of any identification of the body.

On \$/19/68 Mexican authorities discovered a body buried on the beach at Acapules. Police described it as that of a white main, about thirty years old and believed to be an American. Felice also said the body was decomposing and had apparently been both beaten and shot with death occurring about three days before the body was found.

Mexican police fingerprinted the body and buried it. The local press speculated that the body is that of James Rarl Ray. The fingerprints taken by the police have been compared with Ray's fingerprints by the Identification Division but they are so lacking in detail that it is not pecalitie to determine whether or not they are identical. As FM lingerprint expert is an reate to Assystee to attempt to reach a positive finding as to whether this body is identical with Ray.

Circuit Judge John C. Casey, St. Louis, has advised the St. Louis Office he sentenced Ray to twenty years for armo in 1966. This is the sentence Ray was serving when he es State Pentiontiary in April, 1967.

A motion was filed to vacate the above judgment because of alleged improper introduction of histograd statement, fathers to affect a sandty hearing, perjured testimony on behalf of the State, faulty instructions to the just, and influre to furnish the advice and assistance tages of the proceedings. Judge Casey further advised that John D. Schneider, a court appealed alternay, filed a document with the court, \$/1/66, stating that no court action is possible at this time in view of Ray's cocape. This was published in the daily record of court activity, \$/8/66, but has not been picked up by the press.

Judge Chary believes that under recent Supreme Court decisions. Buy would have an excellent chance of reversing his conviction and vacating his sentence for armed robbery. Judge Chary also believes he can dismiss Ray's action quietly and without attracting publicity but he is considering the advisability of entering and publicating an order that unless Ray comes forward by 6/2/68 his action will be dismissed. If this were publicated the judge feels Ray might recognize the possibility of reversing the armed robbery conviction and give himself up in the belief he could beat the King marrier charge before a Southern jury.

Judge Casey prefers publishing that Ray's action will be dismissed if he does not appear by 4/3/66 but he is willing to go either way. He stated that he did not want to take any action that could projudice the Durenu's investigation and asked for the Durenu's advice as to how the matter should be handled.

The United States is not a party to the case pending before Judge Casey. It is a matter filed by or on beink! of Ray to overtarn what is strictly a State conviction. The Bureau should not be put in a position where it could be criticized for attempting to interfere with the due process of funtice before a State court. Judge Casey is being advised that the action he takes in this matter is entirely within his own discretion and that the FBI is not in a position to advise him or to make any recommendation.

The original motion and supporting argument filed before Judge Casey were purportedly prepared by Ray. They have been described as being done in a very able measure and on a par with the work of practicing atterneys.
