NO WAY IDENTIFY RAY FROM TWO RECENT PHOTOS. STEWART FURTHER STATED THE PHOTO OF RAY WITH EYES CLOSED WHICH IS SIMILIAR TO THE PHOTO IN WANTED FLYER WITH EYES DRAWN BY ARTIST IN NO WAY RESEMBLED PERSON HE SAW.

REVEREND STEWART MENTIONED THE SUPERVISOR WAS NORMAN GADDIS WHO PORTRAYS HIMSELF AS AN AMATEUR ARTIST. GADDIS FAILED TO POSITIVELY IDENTIFY RAY IN CONTACT WITH GADDIS ON MAY TWENTYNINE AND THIRTY FIRST SIXTYEIGHT. HE MENTIONED INDIVIDUAL NOT DRUNK HOWEVER HE COULD NOT FURNISH POSITIVE INFORMATION MAINTAINING HE ONLY NOTED THE EYES WHICH WERE DISTINCTIVE AS IN THE WANTED FLYER OF RAY BUT DIFFERED FROM THE EYES OF THE INDIVIDUAL HE HAD SEEN. GADDIS COULD NOT IDENTIFY THE TWO RECENT PHOTOS OF RAY SHOWN TO HIM ALONG WITH OTHER PHOTOS.

GADDIS DURING INTERVIEW STRESSED THE FACT HE IS AMATEUR ARTIST AND ALWAYS HAS HAD DIFFICULTY WITH REPR<sup>o</sup>DUCEING EYES. HE STATED HE PAID MORE ATTENTION TO THE PERSONS EYES AND DID NOT NOTICE OTHER FACIAL FEATURES EXCEPT THE PERSONS HAIRLINE WHICH

PAGE THREE

DID NOT RESEMBLE RAYS HOWEVER HIS VIEW WAS OBSTRUCTED BECAUSE OF DARKNESS.

REVEREND STEWART MENTIONED THAT LAWRENCE REH, A LOCAL NEWS PAPER REPORTER IS A MEMBER OF HIS CHURCH AND ALSO A SUPERVISOR AT TEEN CENTER HOWEVER REH WAS NOT PRESENT ON MAY TWENTYEIGHT SIXTYEIGHT BUT OBTAINED THE INFORMATION AND WROTE STORY THIS DATE WHICH WAS ALSO RELEASED TO AP BECAUSE HE THOUGHT IT NEWS WORTHY ITEM.

REVEREND STEWART AND GADDIS WERE THOROUGHLY INTERVIEWED AND NUMEROUS DISCREPANCIES NOTED.

Today Legal Attache Nate Ferris of Mexico City called relating to the lead furnished by Eduardo Jose Molina to the effect that James Ray was reportedly working at the Sadzil Ha Hotel, Isla of Mujeres, off the coast of Mexico.

Ferris advised that an American was a guest at the Sadzil Ha Hotel from 5/9/68 to 5/12/68 at which time he reportedly left Isla of Mujeres for Merida, Mexico. Efforts to locate this individual in Merida have been unsuccessful to date.

Ferris advised that investigation disclosed that this individual arrived in Mexico City, 5/1/68, using the name James H. Anderson or James Anderson. He stayed at the Maria Isabella Hotel, Mexico City, from 5/1/68 to 5/4/68 and at the Alfero Hotel, Mexico City, from 5/5/68 to 5/6/68 before leaving for Isla of Mujeres. In connection with his hotel registrations he listed his profession as teacher and businessman and gave a permanent address of 800 Pennsylvania Avenue, Savannah, Georgia. He also listed a Diners' Club Card, number 2207-1386-1DC.

According to Ferris this individual generally answers the physical description of Ray. Four witnesses have said that Anderson resembles Ray while several others have expressed the opinion he does not. According to witnesses Anderson has obviously dyed blond hair and has in his possession an automatic pistol. He also had a noticeable limp.

## ACTION:

The above was telephonically furnished to ASAC Thomas Westfall of the Savannah Office with instructions to conduct immediate investigation to determine whether Anderson is a legitimate existing person and if so, his current whereabouts.

Supervisor Roger Young of the New York Office was also furnished the above information and instructed to contact the Diners' Club headquarters in New York to obtain full details regarding the holder of Diners' Club Card number 2207-1386-1DC.

ASAC Thomas Westfall, Savannah, advised that inquiry has established that James H. Anderson is Vice President of the L & A Supermarket, 804 Pennsylvania Avenue, Savannah, Georgia. He has resided in Savannah for a number of years where he has operated the above supermarket with his father.

Anderson admitted that he had been in Mexico earlier this month and was on the Isla of Mujeres from 5/9 to 12/68. He is 33 years old, has bleached blond hair, is somewhat effeminate, and does limp from a permanent ankle injury sustained several years ago. Anderson denied currently possession a pistol or having possessed one while in Mexico.

Anderson further advised that he did use Diners' Club Card number 2207-1386-1DC while in Mexico.

The Agents who interviewed Anderson advised that he does not resemble James Ray.

Supervisor Roger Young of the New York Office advised that the records of the Diners' Club in New York City reflect that Diners' Club Card number 2207-1386-1DC was issued to James H. Anderson, Vice President of the L & A Supermarket, 800 Pennsylvania Avenue, Savannah, Georgia, on 10/24/67. At the time the card was issued to him he was 32 years of age and his father, L. E. Anderson, was identified as owner of the L & A Supermarket.

The credit bureau in Savannah was contacted in connection with his application for a Diners' Club Card and verified Anderson's position as Vice President of the L & A Supermarket. He had been known to the credit bureau since 1960 and a credit rating of excellent.

On 3/30/68 he reported he had lost his original card issued to him and was issued a duplicate card under the same number.

ACTION:

The above information was furnished to Legat Nate Ferris in Mexico City. It was pointed out to Ferris that the original allegation was that Ray was employed in the kitchen of the Sadzil Ha Hotel and the identification of Anderson as a legitimate person did not resolve the original allegation. He stated he was aware of this, had desired to determine Anderson's identity, even though a guest on possibility he might be identical to Ray, and that expedite inquiry was continuing to resolve the original allegation.

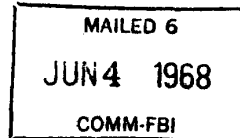

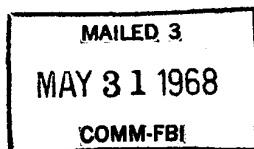

Atlanta summary teletype of 5/24/68, requested advice concerning THORNTON who is now residing in Atlanta.

The following was obtained from the now closed file in the Birmingham Office relating to THORNTON (BH 157-631; Atlanta 157-770; Los Angeles 157-691, 157-855; and BUFILE 157-1660), which also has to do with the American States Rights Party, an off-shoot of the National States Rights Party:

During 1963, THORNTON was residing in Garden Grove, California, and was assisting in the publication of the NSRP of California organ, "The Attack," P. O. Box 641, Santa Ana, California. On page 8, of the report of SA HARRY L. GRIFFIN, Los Angeles, 1/14/64, it appeared that THORNTON left for Birmingham, on 1/6/64. Birmingham file reflects he left Birmingham in November, 1964, to return to Garden Grove, California. Birmingham file relating to THORNTON was closed upon receipt of information from Los Angeles (157-691) that he had been inducted into the U. S. Army on 6/15/65, at Los Angeles, Serial No. 56386553, and assigned to duty at Ft. Polk, Louisiana. He is not known to have returned to Birmingham, and since NSRP headquarters had been moved from Birmingham, there would have been no reason for him to have done so.

From the above, it does <sup>not</sup> appear that any association of RAY with THORNTON could have occurred in Birmingham, since RAY was confined during the period of THORNTON's residence there.

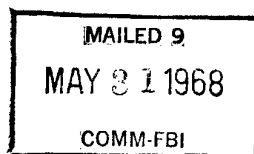

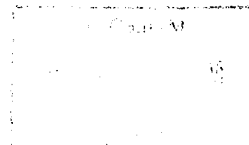
