



Re: Bureau teletype to All SACs, 5/21/68, requesting all offices covering state capitols check all drivers license applications for months of April and May, 1968, concerning all male caucasians over 30 years of age and under 55 years and conduct appropriate investigation to determine if identical with subject.

For the information of the Bureau, Newark has completed a review of drivers license applications for the month of April, 1968, which have resulted in approximately 3,000 leads. It is noted that the State of New Jersey does not differentiate between Negro and caucasian.

A conservative estimate is that an additional 3,000 leads will result for the month of May, thus making a grand total of over 6,000 individuals who would have to be personally contacted in order that they might be eliminated as being identical with subject.

UACB, Newark will discontinue this avenue of investigation.
