On 5/31/68 EDGAR EUGENE BRADLEY, 12208 Emelita Street,  
North Hollywood, California, telephonically advised SA JAMES  
MC CAULEY as follows:

BRADLEY said he had heard from friends in Tulsa, Oklahoma, and from relatives at Rudy, Arkansas, that FBI Agents had been making inquiries as to his whereabouts on 5/17/68. Mr. BRADLEY said that, as he understood the situation, one REX BASINGER had alleged that BRADLEY had told BASINGER that BRADLEY was with ERIC GALT in Oklahoma on that date.

BRADLEY advised that he wished to volunteer that he had been a close childhood friend of REX BASINGER in Arkansas. However, he has not seen BASINGER since he was 15 or 16 years old and has lost track of him. He had heard that after World War II BASINGER had become a preacher. He said he had now heard that BASINGER had apparently had some mental problems, and the accusations against BRADLEY by GARRISON must have triggered a mental reaction.

BRADLEY said that, in fact, on 5/17/68 he was in North Hollywood, California, working on some accounts and making a bank deposit. He said he had talked with a number of people on that day, and his whereabouts can definitely be proved should it

On 6/1/68, at about 4:45 p.m., Detective CHASE, Intelligence Division, Metropolitan Police Department, Washington, D. C., telephonically advised SA ALLAN M. POWER that STEVE ISAACS, City Editor, "The Washington Post," reported a female reporter covered a meeting that date where RALPH ABERNATHY for the Poor People's Campaign was supposed to speak. For some reason, ABERNATHY was replaced by ANDY YOUNG. The female reporter mentioned to ISAACS that a "red neck" in the crowd closely resembled JAMES EARL RAY. This reporter noted the "red neck" left abruptly when it was learned ABERNATHY would not speak. ISAACS indicated another reporter covering this meeting also thought the "red neck" resembled RAY.

At 5:03 p.m. on 6/1/68, Mr. STEPHEN ISAACS, City Editor, "The Washington Post", advised SA ROBERT W. DAWSON that reporter CAROL HONSA (Mrs. CARL BERNSTEIN) covered a

On 6/1/68, at about 4:45 p.m., Detective CHASE, Intelligence Division, Metropolitan Police Department, Washington, D.C., telephonically advised SA ALAN W. HONER that STEVE ISAACS, City Editor, "The Washington Post," reported a female reporter covered a meeting that date where RALPH ABERNATHY for the Poor People's Campaign was supposed to speak. For some reason, ABERNATHY was replaced by ANDY YOUNG. The female reporter mentioned to ISAACS that a "red neck" in the crowd closely resembled JAMES EARL RAY. This reporter noted the "red neck" left abruptly when it was learned ABERNATHY would not speak. ISAACS indicated another reporter covering this meeting also thought the "red neck" resembled RAY.

At 5:03 p.m. on 6/1/68, Mr. STEPHEN ISAACS, City Editor, "The Washington Post," advised SA ROBERT W. JACOBSON that reporter CAROL HONSA (Mrs. CARL BERNSTEIN) covered a

conference of the Capital Trust Club at the Shoreham Hotel this date, and that at about 10:30 a.m. she saw a white man, who was wearing no socks, that she believed to look like an old photograph of JAMES EARL RAY and like the artist's sketch which appeared in the "Commercial Appeal," a Memphis, Tennessee, newspaper. She said that LARRY STILL, who was formerly a reporter for "The Evening Star," a Washington, D. C., newspaper, had also seen this individual.

On 6/1/68, CAROL HONSA, City Editor, "The Washington Post," whose married name is Mrs. CARL BERNSTEIN, advised that she was assigned to cover the Capital Press Club, Washington, D. C., conference at the Shoreham Hotel concerning the urban crisis. She said that she arrived at the Palladium Room of that hotel at about 10:45 a.m., at which time a conference concerning religion and the ghetto was just ending. She observed a young white man sitting in the rear of the room studying the program of the conference. This individual did not appear to be listening to the proceedings, and he was not observed to talk to anyone. HONSA stated that because of his dress he appeared out of place; and she was suspicious of him. She said that most persons were dressed in business clothing, but this individual wore a sport shirt, open at the neck, possibly beige or dirty white, a long sleeve rust colored cardigan sweater, dark trousers, possibly gray, and black shoes with no socks. She said that she had never seen this individual attending any meeting of this type on previous occasions. HONSA stated that this individual appeared to be waiting for the next sermon of the conference, which concerned civil rights organizations and the ghetto; Rev. RALPH ABERNATHY, President of the Southern Christain Leadership Conference, was scheduled to speak.

HONSA stated that after a coffee break, about 11000 a.m., speakers for the conference were introduced; and at this time the above mentioned individual was standing at the rear of the

room near a steel service door. He appeared to be confused, and shortly after the speakers were announced, he left the room by the steel service door. She said that she did not know why he was standing, as there were plenty of seats with only about 70 - 75 people present at the meeting. About 10 minutes later he re-entered the room but left again almost immediately.

HONSA stated that because of this man's appearance and actions, she was suspicious of him; and when he left immediately after it was learned that Rev. RALPH ABERNATHY would not be a speaker, she suspected he might be there to cause some harm to ABERNATHY. She said that she spoke to LAWRENCE STILL, President of the Capital Trust Club, about this individual; and at the time she talked to STILL, AL SWEENEY was present.

HONSA stated that she had never seen this individual before or since he left the meeting, and that she could furnish no information to identify him. She suggested that he might be known to STILL or SWEENEY.

HONSA commented that her husband considers her an "alarmist".

HONSA advised that ~~as she~~ returned to the Washington Post offices around 4:00 p.m., she was thinking about this individual and about the possibility of ABERNATHY being assassinated as KING was; and at this time she thought about this individual possibly looking like JAMES EARL RAY. Upon arriving at the newspaper offices, she had the photographs of RAY obtained from the newspaper morgue and reviewed them. She stated that the individual she had seen somewhat resembled the 1966 Missouri State Penitentiary photograph of RAY and the "Commercial Appeals" artist's sketch.

HONSA described the individual she had seen as a white male, approximately 30 - 35 years of age, 6 feet tall, slender build, 160 - 180 pounds, thin face, light brown cropped hair with side burns to the middle of the ears, fair complexion which was slightly pink as though sun burned or wind burned. She said the individual reminded her of a "red neck".

At approximately 7:00 p.m. on 6/1/68, SA DAWSON was unable to find any individual in the lobby of the Shoreham Hotel fitting the description as furnished by HONSA.

On 6/2/68, Mr. LAWRENCE STILL, 5704 New Hampshire Avenue, N. E., advised SA DAWSON that he did not see the individual that HONSA had spoken to him about. He said that he may have seen the individual, but did not recall him. STILL stated that he did not have any recollection of seeing anyone at the meeting mentioned by HONSA that looked like RAY. STILL stated that he would immediately report any such thing to authorities. STILL advised that ALFRED L. SWEENEY, who is Chairman of the conference, Telephone 593-5023, could possibly furnish additional information.

On 6/2/68, Mr. SWEENEY, who resides at 1105 Lamberton Court, Silver Spring, Md., advised that he had seen the individual pointed out by CAROL HONSA, and that he had not been disturbed by this person present at the above mentioned conference. He said that his first thoughts were that the person was a worker at the hotel, but he had no information in this connection. He said that he had no way of identifying the individual. Mr. SWEENEY stated that he has seen photographs of JAMES EARL RAY and he does not consider the individual mentioned by HONSA to at all resemble RAY. SWEENEY further stated that because of his interest in civil rights and the urban crisis, he would be the first to notify authorities in the event he saw an individual he believed to resemble RAY.

In view of no identifying information being obtained by HONSA, and since other individuals do not believe the individual resembled JAMES EARL RAY, WFO is taking no further action in this matter.

Sergeant ANDREW GRIMES, Fairfax, California Police Department, advised that BRUCE IRWIN GOVERN, age 23, and THOMAS RAYMOND ELLIS, age 18, were arrested on May 19, 1968, in a stolen Volkswagen. Sergeant GRIMES advised after the arrest, GOVERN was searched. GRIMES stated a hand-printed document consisting of four pages was found among GOVERN's personal effects and when it was read, noted it referred to Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING. GRIMES said the letter was rambling and did not make much sense but did contain telephone numbers which might possibly relate to this case.

Sergeant GRIMES furnished this four-page document which actually consists of two sheets of paper with hand-printing on both sides. This letter will comprise the next four pages of this airtel.

BRUCE IRWIN GOVERN was interviewed at the Marin County Jail on May 20, 1968. GOVERN stated that the letter set out above was given to him by an inmate while he was confined either at the San Francisco County Jail or the San Francisco City Jail. He stated the letter was given to him about three weeks ago by a young inmate known to him only as TOM. He said he had not known TOM before, did not know why he was then in jail, and knew nothing about his background. GOVERN stated he was still in the San Francisco Jail when TOM was released on bail and that he has not seen or heard from TOM since. GOVERN stated following his release from jail he obtained certain telephone numbers listed in the letter by calling the Information Operator.

The files of the San Francisco Office indicate that GOVERN is the subject of San Francisco file 25-67044. This file indicates that GOVERN's Selective Service Number is 33-46-45-23 and that he was declared delinquent by his draft board for failure to report for induction on September 8, 1965. GOVERN was arrested by Agents of the San Francisco Office on February 23, 1968, was given a physical examination on February 28, 1968, and on that date was disqualified at the Induction Center for medical reasons, one of these reasons being that he was a user of heroin.

On May 29, 1968, GOVERN was reinterviewed at the Marin County Jail. GOVERN advised he was in the San Francisco Jail from about April 15, 1968, to April 24, 1968. He insisted that the letter referred to was given to him by a person who he knew as TOM. GOVERN stated he was confined to a cell with TOM for about seven days but did not speak to him until his last two days in jail. He advised that both he and TOM were released from City Jail on the same day. GOVERN stated he did not know JAMES EARL RAY and had never seen him. He stated he had seen pictures of RAY in the newspapers.

He advised that on the letter his hand-printing appeared on Page 1 when he wrote the telephone number 404-688-7263 regarding the Ebenezer Baptist Church and on Page 3 when he wrote the telephone numbers 527-6611, 526-8811, and 516-2141. He advised that the telephone number 404-688-7263 was the telephone number of the Ebenezer Baptist Church in Atlanta, Georgia, and he obtained this number by calling Atlanta Information.

He advised he has no knowledge as to the identity of the subscriber to telephone number 221-6201 which appears on the first page of the letter. He advised that the name ROBERT LAWRENCE appearing on Page 1 is unknown to him. GOVERN stated that the rifle used to kill MARTIN LUTHER KING was the same rifle that killed President JOHN F. KENNEDY. When asked to elaborate on this

remark he stated, "You guys know that and there is no sense in me telling you anything about that."

The telephone number 415-324-1130 is a San Francisco telephone number. Inquiry at this number reflects that LARRY YOUNG resides there. YOUNG advised that he would contact the San Francisco Office this date.

ROBERT MOORE, San Francisco Police Department, Star 1648, San Francisco City Jail, on May 31, 1968, advised that BRUCE IRWIN GOVERN was arrested and confined to the San Francisco City Jail on April 16, 1968, and was bailed out on April 19, 1968. MOORE stated that a review of the records reflected that the only "TOM" that was discharged on April 19, 1968, from the City Jail was THOMAS LYNCH who was confined on April 17, 1968, and was released on April 19, 1968. He advised LYNCH was confined to cell block "L" whereas GOVERN was in Dormitory 3.

THOMAS PATRICK LYNCH, 116 Frederick Street, Apartment 29, San Francisco, California, on May 31, 1968, stated he does not know anyone by the name of BRUCE IRWIN GOVERN. He observed photographs of GOVERN and stated that he did not recognize this individual as being identical with anyone that he knows. He stated he was arrested on a narcotics charge and that he was kept separate from the rest of the prisoners in the jail. LYNCH observed photographs of JAMES EARL RAY and stated he did not know RAY and that he had never seen him. LYNCH advised that he had not given GOVERN the four-page letter which GOVERN said he had obtained from "TOM."

LYNCH stated he had been shocked at the death and the manner of the death of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING and that he had not written this note and that he would not have anything to do with any such scheme as this seems to be.

LARRY YOUNG, 974 Weeks, Palo Alto, California, on June 3, 1968, advised he was confined at the San Francisco City Jail from about April 6, 1968, to April 13, 1968. He advised that a white man by the name of LAWRENCE who was in the "tank" with him gave him a letter which was already sealed and asked him to mail it when he got out. YOUNG stated this letter was addressed to MARTIN LUTHER KING, SR. YOUNG stated he does not know the contents of the letter. YOUNG stated he did not know GOVERN.

This is the case involving the murder of Martin Luther King, Jr.

At the request of the Bureau, the Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP) has been conducting an examination of Canadian passports to determine if one has been issued to James Earl Ray. A passport has been located that was issued 4-24-68, to one Ramon George Sneyd of Toronto, Canada. The RCMP has indicated the photograph of Sneyd in the Canadian passport records bears a close resemblance to subject Ray and believes Sneyd and Ray are probably identical.

Sneyd's application for passport was filed on his behalf by the Kennedy Travel Bureau, Toronto, Canada, for the stated purpose of traveling to London, 5-6-68, via British Overseas Airways Corporation (BOAC), returning to Canada, 5-21-68. RCMP investigation has disclosed that a person using the name Sneyd did travel on BOAC to London from Toronto on 5-6-68, and a person using the name Sneyd returned to Toronto from London on 5-21-68.

Bureau of Vital Statistics records established that a person named Ramon George Sneyd was born in Toronto on \_\_\_\_\_ the date and place of birth shown on the passport application. This man is a member of the Toronto Police Department and he advised RCMP he has lived in Toronto all of his life, did not file application for a passport, did not make a trip to London, and he does not know how his birth data could have come into possession of any other person.

Further investigation by the RCMP has disclosed that the person who obtained a passport in the name of Sneyd was in Toronto as early as 4-16-68.

Memorandum to Mr. DeLoach  
RE: MURKIN

The RCMP is conducting intensive interviews at the Kennedy Travel Bureau and will promptly provide us with the results. Photographic copies of documents from the travel agency and the passport files, including a photograph of the suspect, are being flown to the Bureau for review and appropriate Laboratory examination.

Extensive investigation is continuing in Canada to trace and identify the person who obtained the passport. Investigation is also proceeding in England to identify the person who traveled under the name Sneyd and to account for his movements in England.

The application for passport listed Paul Bridgman, Toronto, Canada, as a friend of the applicant. The RCMP has not been able to locate Bridgman to date. FBI investigation has established that one Paul Osborn Bridgeman was received at Missouri State Penitentiary, Jefferson City, Missouri, on 4-23-65, and was discharged 1-16-68. While at the Missouri State Penitentiary, Bridgeman worked in the kitchen where he could have had contact with Ray. Bridgeman was arrested by the Kansas City, Missouri, Police Department on 2-8-68, for disturbing the peace. This charge was dismissed on 2-12-68, and his present whereabouts is unknown. We are conducting extensive investigation to locate Bridgeman.

ACTION:

We are continuing to vigorously press all aspects of this investigation.

Investigation regarding Sneyd is being handled discreetly as any publicity connecting this name with Ray could cause him to immediately abandon this identity if Ray actually is the person who has been using the name Sneyd.
