This case involves the murder of Martin Luther King, Jr.

It has previously been determined that James Earl Ray, using the name Ramon George Sneyd, obtained a Canadian passport stating that he was to fly from Toronto to London by British Overseas Airways Corporation (BOAC) on 5/6/68 returning to Toronto 5/21/68. A person using the name Sneyd did fly to London 5/6/68 but there was no record of any return trip to Toronto.

Scotland Yard has now determined that on 5/7/68 the person using the name Ramon George Sneyd turned in the return portion of the BOAC ticket and received a ticket to Lisbon, Portugal, via British European Airlines and also received a voucher in the amount of \$14.60 representing the difference in value between the return ticket and the ticket to Lisbon. This voucher can be either cashed or used to obtain further transportation. *W*

Scotland Yard has determined that the man using the name Sneyd did depart from London on British European Airlines Flight 074 en route to Lisbon on 5/7/68 and an airline employee is 99 per cent certain that this individual is identical with the photograph of the subject.

It is noted that there is no direct travel possible from London to Rhodesia. Anyone planning to travel from London to Rhodesia would normally go through Lisbon.

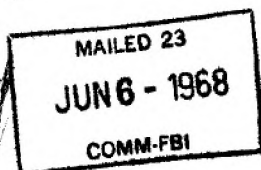

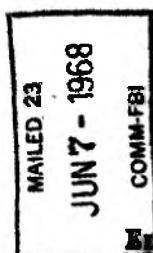
