Inspector Ross Pikey, Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP), Ottawa, Canada, (telephone Area Code 613, 992-3008) telephoned my office this morning, 6-11-68, and spoke to SA Bland. Inspector Pikey said that he wanted the FBI in Washington to know that the RCMP was not furnishing any information to the press in Canada regarding the James Earl Ray case other than information confirming the issuance of a Canadian passport to Ray in the name of Ramon George Sneyd.

This case involves the murder of Martin Luther

Inspector Pikev said that he was in close touch with our liaison representative, SA Moss Innes. He said that the RCMP has taken the position that the Ray case is an FBI matter and that any information concerning Ray should not come from the RCMP but only from the FBI. He said that the RCMP did not want or intend to jeopardize the subsequent prosecution of Ray in any way.

Inspector Pikey said that he was most proud of the excellent relationship between the FBI and the RCMP and was most complimentary of the Director and the FBI.



# New Leads On King Assassinat

## By Paul Scott

THE FEDERAL Bureau of Investigation's massive probe of the assassina-tion of Dr. Martin Luther King is taking a possibly sensational turn.
With James Earl

Ray, the suspected assessin, apparently either outside the U.S. or now dead, FBI agents have inesed their surveil-American Communists known to have been closely associ-ated with King, in-



cluding one who wrote speeches for him in the past.

This new development was triggered by evidence gathered by the more than 1,000 agents who have worked on the mysterious King shooting and by several "tips" and letters sent to

One of the most interesting of them tips came from an aler TV viewer and concerns the now famous "Mountain Top" speech King made on April 3, the night before his sizy ing, shewing a premonition of his impending death.

Tals ghost writer for King prepared many of his most famous speeches, according to testimony given by FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover during a closed door meeting of a House Appending death.

THE SPEECH was truly made in Memphis on April 3 as reported," the letter pointed out, "then how can one account for King stating his age as 36 (Instead of 39) and why does he speak of demonstrating in Alabama twice during the speech?"

After checking out the time and lo-

cation of King's final speech, several of the FBI agents assigned to the case decided to begin seeking answers to a number of their own questions, in-3 cluding:

The answers to these questions are considered highly important to the investigation, since, if another person was concerned in the preparation of that speech, the writer might be able to shed new light on it - especially

Also, if King had received help with the speech, the passages dealing with the cruit rights leader's premonition of death would probably have been fully discussed. King's sequest to the De-troit police department for protection when he visited that city a few weeks before his death indicated he feared for his life then.

INFORMATION gathered by the FBI on King prior to his assessination, showed that a secret member of the unist party's executive committee, was one of King's closest advisers and speech writers.

Because of Ray's mysterious trips io Mexicu and Canada shortly b the assassination, the entire U.S. intelligence operation, ranging from the Central Intelligence Agency to the Defense Intelligence Agency, has been pressed into the hunt for King's killer.

One CIA report indicates that Ray, who is linked to the murder weapon by fingerprints and ballistic data, may have visited Cuba during his Mexican trip, according to information furnished by a Mexican airline official.

The FBI assumpton is that, if there was a conspiracy to kill King, those involved made arrangements to spirit their hired killer out of the U.S. to Cuba via either Mexico or Canada.

Probably the greatest irony of the probe of King's assassination is that FM Director J. Edgar Hoover, one of the civil rights leader's severest critics when he was alive, is doing every-

thing in his power to solve the case.
On the other hand, King's closest
aides in the Southern Christian Leadership Conference are showing little or no interest in whether the killer is found.

WHEN REV. Raiph Abernathy, s successor as president of the SCLC, presented a series of demands te Attorney General Ramsey Clark for the "Poor People's" campaign none of these called for more intensive effort to solve King's assassination.

According to people who attended the meeting, nothing was said about King's death or the FBI investigation, although a number of the poor in "Resurrection City" had urged Abernathy to press for a more vigorous

Specifically, the comparison requested was between a photograph of "Eric S. Galt" purportedly taken in early 1968 in connection with his attendance at a bartender school in California and prison photographs of James Earl Ray taken in 1960 and 1966. The requested comparisons have been made and we have determined definitely that the Eric S. Galt photograph is actually a photograph of the same person depicted in the James Earl Ray prison photographs. Results of this comparison have been telephonically furnished General Investigative Division.

Assistant Director Rosen advises he has furnished the results of the examination to Mr. Pollak in the Department and Mr. Pollak has requested the Laboratory's assistance in preparing an affidavit. A Mr. Maurice A. Roberts subsequently contacted me and requested assistance in the technical wording incident to the preparation of the affidavit. We are complying with this Department request and will execute the affidavit after it has been prepared and the wording has been determined to be technically accurate.





Then it was learned Friday that long before the Mustang was found FBI agents had checked with both the Maritime Union and Seafarers International Union in Mobile, asking about an Evic Galt.

In obtaining his driver's license, the man named Galt had given his occupation as an unemployed seaman.

Agents also checked with one of the largest fishing concerns in the Alabama gulf area and in Coast Guard files in Washington before the Mustang was found, it was learned.

The name of Eric Galt might never have come to public attention if newsmen in Atlanta had not caught a glimpse of the license number as the Mustang was being towed away Thursday by the FBI.

#### Cited in FBI Bulletin

The license, Alabama 1-38993, is the same number as that cited in an FBI bulletin issued Thursday in Miami, an alert that sought help in finding Galt. The bulletin said he was last seen driving a white Mustang with that number.

As far as is publicly known, the only direct link between the auto impounded in Atlanta and the Memphis slaying is the make and color.

Witnesses who reported seeing a white Mustang drive away from the Memphis murder scene did not get a license number.

Dr. King was assassinated shortly after 6 p.m. Memphis time April 4, or shortly after 7 p.m. Atlanta time

The Mustang registered to Galt was first reported seen in Atlanta on the morning of April 5, although witnesses differ in this respect. One said she saw it as early as 7 a.m. Two others insist that they saw it being parked at 8:30 or 9.

#### 400 Miles Apart

The distance from Memphis to Atlanta is about 400 miles. Taking into account the one-hour loss because of the time zone change, a driver, depending on his speed, could have left Memphis after the slaying and arrived in

Atlanta as early as 3 a.m. the next day.

The automobile was found in the parking lot of the Capitol Homes Development, a garden-type project designed for low income families, about five blocks-from, the State Capitol, past which Dr.

King's funeral procession passed Tuesday, four days after the Mustang was first sighted in Atlanta.

The Rev. Ike Powell notified police about the car Thursday, after receiving a call from a member

of his Inner City Methodist Church. He said he had hesitated at first because "it's such a big world and there are so many white Mustangs."

When city detectives arrived, said Mr. Powell, they "didn't appear too excited."

But he said FBI agents arrived later and soon "were all over the place."

Johnny Nielsen, a 13year-old boy, said he noticed a large amount of cigaret or cigar ash on the front seat, a great deal of red mud on the front floorboard and used 1967 license tags on a ledge inside the back window.

Two Mexican "Turista" decals of recent issuance were on the back and side windows he said, indicating perhaps that the owner had visited Mexico recently.

This, of course, led to speculation that if the car owner had any connection with the assassination he might have scouted a Mexican hiding place earlier—or a jumping off place to South America.

Envoy Donies Request

Earlier reports indicated the search for the assassin had spread to Mexico, although the U.S. ambassador there and Mexican Federal Police have denied that a request was made of Mexican officials to join the hunt.

Police in Atlanta said they have not been asked to participate in the FBI investigation here, whatever its mysterious

nature.

When the Miami teletypewriter message asking for help in finding Galt first appeared, it was reported as a "pickup order." Later a Miami source said: "This meant they (FBI agents) wanted him spotted, not picked up."

Still later, after the Mustang was impounded, the message was withdrawn with the puzzling explanation that it had been released by mistake.

The FBi would make absolutely no comment about these unusual procedures, although the message had concluded:

- "If located notify Agent Charles Bell FBI Miami."

The message described the man sought as a white male, 36 years old, about 5 feet 11 inches and 175 pounds with blue eyes and brown hair. This roughly matches the description circulated by federal authorities the night. Dr. King was slain.




of his Inner City Methodist Church. He said he had hesitated at first because "it's such a big world and there are so many white Mustangs."

When city detectives arrived, said Mr. Powell, they "didn't appear too excited."

But he said FBI agents arrived later and soon "were all over the place."

Johnny Nielsen, a 13year-old boy, said he noticed a large amount of cigaret or cigar ash on the front seat, a great deal of red mud on the front floorboard and used 1967 license tags on a ledge inside the back window.

Two Mexican "Turista" decals of recent issuance were on the back and side windows he said, indicating perhaps that the owner had visited Mexico recently.

Legat, Minnich called from London at 3:15 p.m. this afternoon. Assistant Attorney General Vinson had a press conference this morning at 10:15 a.m. During the conference he praised police cooperation between the FBI, the RCMP and Scotland Yard. He attempted to straighten out the record claiming that he had not interrogated subject Ray but that he had briefly seen him. The papers had previously reported that Vinson had interrogated Ray. Vinson became flustered when he was questioned by the reporters regarding the movements of Ray in several countries. Being unable to answer the questions, he eventually replied "No comment." In answer to questioning, Vinson stated that two sets of extradition papers were being sent to the British Home Office.

Vinson told Minnich that he had been discussing this case with the Attorney General. Extradition papers are to be placed on a 7:00 p.m. plane from Washington to London. The AG apparently told Vinson there was a delay in forwarding these papers inasmuch as the FBI had had difficulty in locating a witness by the name of Stephens. (Stephens has not been located as yet, however, this is not delaying the filing of the extradition papers.) Vinson told Minnich that the Department would possibly call upon the FBI to place the extradition papers on the evening plane. I told Minnich that we had not received such a request.

Vinson has booked reservations on a flight to depart London on Thursday, 6/13/68, at 2:00 p.m. Vinson has continued his efforts to inspect security measures at Wandsworth Prison. The British Home Secretary's office has informed U. S. Ambassador Bruce that Vinson will not be allowed this privilege. Ambassador Bruce was flatly told that it would be an insult to the British Government for Vinson to inspect security measures at Wandsworth. Vinson has asked the AG to contact Undersecretary of State Katzenbach so that a request can be made through diplomatic channels. Minnich doubts that Vinson will be allowed to inspect Wandsworth's security measuresofts pite pressure brought on by the American Government.

Our Paris Legat, Norman Philcox, has completed his investigation in Lisbon, Portugal. Sources in Portugal have sent letters to all banks inquiring if Ray had funds deposited therein or had rented a safe deposit box.

The results of this check will not be in for several days. Legat Philcox has no further leads remaining. I told Minnich to order Philcox back to Paris so that he could immediately prepare a letterhead memorandum regarding the results of his investigation. This memorandum will first be reviewed by SA Martindale and then will be sent to FBI Headquarters. Philcox will leave Portugal tomorrow morning, 6/12/68, at 10:45 a.m.

SA Martindale has spent most of his time at Scotland Yard assisting the representatives of our London Office. Investigation thus far by Scotland Yard has shown that subject Ray cannot be placed anywhere in London until the date of May 28, 1968, when he checked into the New Earl's Court' Hotel. On June 5, 1968, subject Ray checked into the Pax Hotel and remained there until he checked out to travel to Brussels, Belgium. One source has advised that subject Ray told him he planned to go to Rhodesia.

Subject Ray thus far has not indicated any willingness to reveal anything. Chief Superintendent Butler has advised Minnich that Ray, en route from the London Airport to Scotland Yard, was advised by Butler that there was reason to believe the subject's name was James Earl Ray. The subject allegedly turned white and did not deny this allegation, however, on the other hand, he did not admit anything.

Minnich has now put in an official request, through Embassy channels, to interview Ray. The Home Office will make the final decision. Ray must give his permission before such an interview can take place. This request was specifically mentioned to Vinson, who replied, "By all means."

Minnich still believes that there will be a minimum of three and a half weeks to a maximum of six weeks before extradition can take place. Even after the order of extradition is given, there will be a 15-day waiting period in which subject can make an appeal if he so desires. In the event he does desire to appeal, there will of course be further delay in extradition.

I specifically asked Minnich what his recommendations were concerning the men from FBI Headquarters who are currently in London. He stated that he was keeping these men busy and that frankly, he felt it would be cheaper in the long run to let them remain in London rather than returning to Washington and then having to go back upon subject's extradition. Minnich raised the point that there of course was the possibility that subject Ray at any time might indicate he was perfectly willing to be returned to the United States and that he would sign any papers certifying this fact. If this happens, our representatives must be in a position to move fast. Consequently, Minnich feels that our representatives should remain in London.

We should, however, make a check after the next hearing to be held on June 19, 1968, to see if there still appears to be a maximum of four to six weeks before the subject will be extradited. In this event, consideration might be given to having our Agents return rather than remain in London for an extended period of time.

By teletype dated June 6, 1968, the Philadelphia, New York, and Newark Offices were advised that ROBERT LAWRENCE RUSSELL had furnished those offices with inaccurate and unreliable information.

San Francisco does not contemplate a reinterview of RUSSELL at this time unless directed to do so by the Bureau, Memphis, or Kansas City.

New Orleans is being furnished copies of this communication; however, no lead is being set out for New Orleans to conduct specific investigation. It is noted that New Orleans conducted an 88 investigation regarding ROBERT LAWRENCE RUSSELL during 1967 at which time he was using the names JAMES ALEXANDER and ROBERT LAWRENCE.

REPORT IN PREPARATION.

### FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION

Date June 7, 1968

ROBERT LAWRENCE RUSSELL, FBI Number 892 144A was interviewed in the San Francisco County Jail, Hall of Justice Building, San Francisco, California, on June 4, 1968.

RUSSELL advised that his true name was ROBERT LAWRENCE RUSSELL although he was confined to the San Francisco County Jail under the name ROBERT LAWRENCE. RUSSELL stated he was born on , in Atlantic City, New Jersey. He stated he is being held on a charge of grand theft and his trial date is July 10, 1968.

RUSSELL related he was arrested in New York City, New York, about September 23, 1967, and has been in custody ever since except for a week in November, 1967. He advised that in November, 1967, he was released because he was cooperating with the New York City Police Department and/or the New York County District Attorney's Office. He advised he was returned to California and since returning to California has been confined first in the San Francisco City Jail and then the San Francisco County Jail, located on the sixth and seventh floors respectively of the Hall of Justice Building.

He advised that his wife is VALERIE RUSSELL, 12 East 31st Street, New York City, New York. He advised she was a legal secretary who formerly worked for Judge MURPHY, not otherwise identified. He related his wife is pregnant and expecting a baby in the next two weeks.

RUSSELL advised that he had written a letter which he gave to BRUCE GOVERN while they were both confined in San Francisco City Jail. He advised that this letter was entirely a figment of his imagination and had no basis in fact except that he said he knew a man by the name of GALT in New Orleans, Louisiana, in 1967.

RUSSELL stated after examining the photographs of JAMES EARL RAY that he saw RAY who was using the name JIMMY GALT in the Roosevelt Hotel bar in New Orleans, Louisiana, in April, 1967, late in the month, or May, 1967.

RUSSELL related he was using the name JAMES ALEXANDER at this time. He related that eventually he was arrested in the City of New Orleans and was booked under the name, JAMES ALEXANDER.

He advised that he did not consider the photograph of JAMES EARL RAY wherein RAY is wearing sunglasses to be a good likeness. He related that the photograph showing RAY in a business suit with a white shirt and wearing a tie was a good likeness of the man he knew as JIMMY GALT. He described JIMMY GALT as a white male American, 180 to 190 pounds, 5'10", and having black hair. He advised he never paid any attention to GALT's eyes. He stated he could not recall any scars on his forehead or hands. He was unable to describe the nose and made no remarks concerning the chin. He advised that GALT wore a watch and a diamond pinky ring. He also wore sunglasses with a black frame. He advised that he met RAY in the bar at the Roosevelt Hotel in New Orleans.

RUSSELL advised that he had won some money gambling and was in New Orleans to enjoy:himself and to see if he could make any other scores. He stated he was aware that the State of California wanted him at that time.

He advised that he had frequented the Hotel Roosevelt bar for several days and noticed RAY, or GALT as he was called, in the bar and eventually met him. He advised that GALT had a great deal of money. He stated it was his belief that he could have had as much as \$25,000 and this was based upon the fact that he saw GALT take money out of his pocket and that he had several \$50 and/or \$100 bills in his possession. He advised after seeing GALT with this roll that he decided he wanted to get to know him and to get to know where his residence was located so that he could get the money from him. He advised he intended to burglarize GALT's residence if necessary.

He advised that after talking with GALT at the bar in the Roosevelt Hotel that he eventually told GALT that he was wanted by the police. He advised that he saw GALT several times during a two or three week period. He advised that eventually GALT indicated that he also had done time but had been out for five or six years.

He described GALT as being very quiet, did not like Negro people, and seemed to enjoy gambling.

He related GALT never took him to his residence. He advised it was his belief that GALT lived either with his brother or his uncle in New Orleans, Louisiana. He stated this was based upon the fact that they went riding in an automobile one afternoon and that they drove by a house which was located three or four blocks from the French market and also near a big church, and GALT indicated he lived there.

He advised that the automobile they were riding in belonged to GALT's girl friend.

He advised that this house was located about ten or twelve blocks from Canal Street and five or six blocks from a big church, stating that the street had big houses on it and that at least two families lived in the building.

He advised it was his recollection that he was introduced to GALT by a barmaid in the Roosevelt Hotel. RUSSELL stated that he frequented the bar every night and was so well known there that he could even leave a tab. He advised that he cannot recall the barmaid's name or her description. He stated it was his recollection that the bartender was a white male American, about 55 years of age, with gray hair, wearing glasses, who was short and stocky. He stated this bartender had a helper behind the bar who was either of Mexican or Spanish extraction.

RUSSELL stated GALT was frequently in the company of women and he believed that the girl he was with most of the time was named EVELYN (Last Name Unknown) who came from some place in the South, possibly Montgomery, Alabama. RUSSELL stated that it was his belief or recollection that EVELYN was a friend of a girl who had worked at JACK RUBY's place in Dallas, Texas. He advised that also in RAY's company was another woman by the name of IRENE and that he believes she might have been from Los Angeles, California, and had some connection with a bar either as an owner or a prospective purchaser.

RUSSELL related that although he met GALT in the bar at the Roosevelt Hotel, that he also saw him in a restaurant or bar across the street from the Royal Orleans Hotel and near Napoleon's Bar. He remarked that the Royal Orleans Hotel had a bar called the Touche Bar which opened after 4:00 p.m. He advised that located on a corner immediately adjacent to the Royal Orleans Hotel was Napoleon's Bar and that further down in the block was a small bar which had a large back room entirely devoted to gambling. He advised that he was in this small bar with the back room for gambling with GALT on at least one occasion and that GALT placed bets in this room with a girl named "PAT."

He stated that a city building was located across the street from the Royal Orleans Hotel and that very close to this city building was a bar called Sinatraville. He advised that the bartender or owner of this establishment would know GALT and would know RUSSELL as JIMMY ALEXANDER.

He stated that if the owner of the Sinatraville were contacted, that he should be asked about the little blonde girl that came from Mississippi or Alabama, the one who quit her job. He stated that the owner should be asked if he has seen ALEXANDER or JIMMY recently.

He advised that there was a restaurant located over the Absinthe House and that he was in this restaurant on one occasion with JIMMY GALT.

RUSSELL related that after he had been in New Orleans a short time he was arrested and was held in jail for a few days, and after he got out went back to the bar, Sinatraville, inquired about the girl and was told that RAY had gone to a place in Mexico. RUSSELL could not remember the exact dates for the above.

He related that also during the time that he was in New Orleans, a girl he was out with one night got picked up by the police. He stated that he immediately got in contact with the syndicate through a bartender at the Touche Bar in the Roosevelt Hotel and that this girl was then released almost immediately.

He advised that during the time he was in New Orleans that MATT MONROE (phonetic), a singer, was appearing in the Roosevelt Hotel. RUSSELL related that he got to know MATT MONROE and KENNY (Last Name Unknown), MATT MONROE's pianist. He related that on one occasion they went to a bar on Bourbon Street and that JIMMY GALT came in and joined them. He related MATT MONROE resided at the hotel during his engagement.

RUSSELL advised that during the time he was in New Orleans, the Japanese International Floating Fair was in town. He advised that he became very well known aboard this ship and in fact was able to have the Mayor of New Orleans declare one of the officials connected with the Japanese International Floating Fair an honorary citizen of the City of New Orleans.

He advised, "Maybe RAY killed him. I believe that RAY was hired. Both men were killed by the same people." He related that by both men he meant President JOHN F. KENNEDY and Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING.
