Don't Give Up Easily

A few weeks or so ago they were saying that "They'll never catch Dr. King's killer." One columnist wrote: "The truth is that the FBI has not located a single trace of Ray since he supposedly abandoned his white automobile in Atlanta April 5, the day after the Negro clergyman was slain in a Memphis, Tenn., motel."

Understandably, the FBI does not tell all that it knows. It is entirely possible that the FBI did not know exactly where the murder suspect was at the moment the columnist was making his observations. But it evidently wasn't far behind.

The FBI doesn't usually give up so early in a problem of this kind, or any kind. Because of the many implications involved in the slaying of a man of Dr. King's prominence, especially in the civil rights field, it is inconceivable that the FBI ever thought at any time of giving up the search.

So it was not exactly surprising that James Earl Ray, the principal suspect in the Dr. King slaying, was captured Saturday in London principally through the work of the FBI and the Royal Canadian Mounted Police. The Canadian police found the suspect's passport record in a batch of more than 200,000 applications which they searched and the FBI and Scotland Yard did the rest from that point on.

The investigation must not stop with the arrest of the prime suspect. Efforts must be made to learn whether Ray was only a cog in a conspiracy, whether he was a paid killer. For a man who was unemployed, he spent considerable amounts of money.

The FBI did not give up in its search for Ray, a man of many aliases, and while it is not making its intentions known, it is not likely to abandon the search for conspiratorial or other evidence that might be associated with Dr. King's assassination.

On 6/17/68 PAUL ELLISON SANDERS, 109 Radcliff Rd., Lenoir, N.C., Telephone 754-4930, advised he does not accept any collect telephone calls from his brother, ROBERT FRANKLIN SANDERS, and the last time he talked with his brother, ROBERT, was about 2 or perhaps 3 weeks ago when ROBERT called him at approximately 4 or 5 A.M. desiring to know if PAUL had heard from ROBERT's wife and family. This was the last contact he has had with ROBERT and stated he definitely did not receive any long distance telephone calls during the week of 6/9-16/68 from ROBERT or anyone else from the State of Wisconsin. He stated he worked several nights until around 11 P.M. and on Friday night, 6/14/68, visited his father, IVEY SANDERS of Lenoir. PAUL SANDERS pointed out it was possible his wife may have received a call from his brother, ROBERT FRANKLIN SANDERS from Wisconsin.

Subsequently on 6/17/68 PAUL SANDERS advised that he had discussed this matter with his wife and she stated she did not receive any long distance telephone calls during the week of 6/9-16/68. She stated ROBERT SANDERS had called PAUL's home on Sunday evening either 6/2/68 or 6/9/68 from an unknown location and this was the last contact she had had with ROBERT SANDERS. She definitely received no calls from Wisconsin to her knowledge during the week of 6/9-16/68.

On 6/17/68 SAMUEL JERRY SANDERS was recontacted and advised he had discussed this matter with his wife and youngest brother, JACOB DOUGLAS SANDERS and they both advised him they had not received any telephone calls from ROBERT FRANKLIN SANDERS or anyone else from the State of Wisconsin during the week of 6/9-16/68.

Investigation in Lenoir indicated that all members of IVEY SANDERS for the information of the Bureau and all offices. PAUL and JERRY SANDERS were interviewed at length and at no time displayed any animosity toward minority groups of the Federal Government and indicated a high regard for the FBI. They both advised their father, IVEY SANDERS, had tried to help their oldest brother, ROBERT FRANKLIN SANDERS, for a number of years but finally gave up. They stated there were 13 members of the immediate family and on numerous occasions had sent ROBERT money to pay fines or lawyer's fees when actually the money was needed to buy food and clothing for other members of the family. Both brothers also indicated they and other members of the family had helped ROBERT on numerous occasions but for the past several years have refused to assist any financial aid and no longer accept any collect telephone calls from him. They both stated they had unlisted telephone numbers for this reason in order to prevent any unnecessary calls from ROBERT or any of his associates to their homes. They stated that ROBERT had traveled extensively over the U. S. and the family never knew where he was or when he would next appear in Caldwell Co., N. C., PAUL indicated that he could not place any confidence in any information that ROBERT gave him and he might tell you he was going to Calif. when actually he would be going to the next county.

ROBERT SANDERS' brothers indicated that they knew EARL HALL as a used car dealer only and have no personal association with him. RUBY ANDERSON is unknown to them but

they have a first cousin by the name of RUBY CRUMP who has been married several times and whose whereabouts are unknown.

They advised they did not lie as to ROBERT's whereabouts and if he were responsible for the theft of a car or passing bad checks or any other crime, he should be caught and punished.

Investigation in Lenoir indicated that all members of IVEY SANDERS' family are law-abiding citizens with the exception of ROBERT FRANKLIN and they are a working class people with good reputations. There is no indication that SANDERS are engaged in any klan activities. EARL HALL operated a used car business in Lenoir for a number of years but sold out but just recently re-established this business. He has the reputation of being a shrewd car dealer not known to engage in any illegal activities.

GEORGE ROBERT LETSINGER

On June 11, 1968, Mr. JOSEPH FORROR, Assistant Postmaster, Main Post Office, San Diego, California, advised as follows:

Found on the incoming mail belt was a piece of paper not in an envelope written in green ink which was addressed to "Post Office Post Master". This note reads as follows:

"If the F.B.I. wants Ray,s buddy go to 124 Broadway Metropole Hotel Room 117. He may be under the name Geore Letsinger or George Anderson. He knows about Kennedy and also King,s death,s. He may have part in Kings death. I know he was in Tenn. before and after King was killed. I know Letsinger is wonted in Seattle. Also in Big Stone Gap, Virginia, by the F.B.I."

On June 12, 1968, information was received from the Seattle Division, Federal Bureau of Investigation, that one GEORGE ROBERT LETSINGER, FBI Number 584 742 F, born [redacted] at Macomb, Missouri, was arrested at Jacksonville, Florida, on April 11, 1968, charged with grand larceny having stolen \$550 to \$600 from a restaurant in Seattle, Washington, for which he was employed.

LETSINGER was returned to Seattle, Washington, and on the basis of the charge against him, received a three-year deferred sentence, six months in the county jail and ordered to make restitution.

LETSINGER appealed this sentence and was placed on bond, however, departed the State of Washington and a bench warrant was subsequently issued by the Superior Court, Seattle, Washington.

Information was also furnished that authorities at Seattle, Washington, desired his apprehension and would extradite LETSINGER to Seattle, Washington. Based on this information, the San Diego Police Department arrested GEORGE ROBERT LETSINGER at Room 117, Metropole Hotel, 124 Broadway, San Diego, California, on June 12, 1968. At time of arrest, LETSINGER admitted his identity and the fact that he knew he was wanted by the State of Washington.

GEORGE ROBERT LETSINGER was interviewed by Agents of the Federal Bureau of Investigation at San Diego, California, on June 13, 1968, at which time he advised as follows:

LETSINGER advised that in 1963 he went to England and visited the Russian Embassy, Grovesner Square, London, England, for the purpose of renouncing his United States citizenship.

He was arrested while in England by New Scotland Yard, based upon a check which he had deposited in a bank prior to his departure to England and later determined it was a fraudulent check.

LETSINGER was asked why he desired to renounce his citizenship, to which he replied the country is no longer a country for the white people and is eventually being taken over by the "niggers."

LETSINGER exhibited a strong anti-Negro sentiment and stated that at one time he had been a member of a clan-type organization at Big Stone Gap, Virginia.

LETSINGER was questioned as to his association with JAMES EARL RAY and whether he had any knowledge concerning the assassinations of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, Senator ROBERT F. KENNEDY and President JOHN F. KENNEDY. LETSINGER merely replied "I do not wish to talk about these subjects."

LETSINGER did say, however, that if Senator TED KENNEDY and Vice President HUBERT H. HUMPHREY continue to seek the Presidency of the United States, they will be assassinated. LETSINGER did not desire to elaborate regarding this information.

GEORGE ROBERT LETSINGER

LETSINGER admitted previous mental history, having been confined during 1961 for a short period of time at St. John's Hospital, Springfield, Missouri.

Handprinting was obtained from LETSINGER and was compared with the note received by the U. S. Post Office, San Diego, California, and because of a close resemblance of these, LETSINGER was asked if he, in fact, had written the note himself.

He categorically denied having written this note.

EDGAR DOWNING, Del Mar Hotel, 257 East Ocean Boulevard, Long Beach, California was contacted by SA JOSEPH R. CONLON on 6/18/68.

His letter to the Bureau was acknowledged and gratitude expressed for his cooperation.

DOWNING advised that about four days after killing in instant matter, he was sitting in lobby of Del Mar Hotel when a white male about 30 years, 5'10", 160 pounds, slender build and brown hair, appeared, and DOWNING overheard inquiry of clerk by this individual concerning whether a certain young lady was registered there. Clerk, TRUE HAROLD, advised this individual that the girl in question had checked out after which HAROLD gave this individual his luggage which had been stored at the hotel and he registered as a guest. DOWNING said he felt this indicated that the individual had been a guest in the hotel previously.

DOWNING indicated that later, he saw one of several photographs of JAMES EARL RAY, which he felt somewhat resembled the individual who appeared in the lobby of the Del Mar Hotel. He reported this incident to the Long Beach Resident Agency and understood that subsequently, agents had made inquiry at the hotel.
