Donald Woods, the salesman for the Aeromarine Supply Company, Birmingham, Alabama, who sold the rifle recovered at the scene of King's assassination to Ray, has been contacted by Ray's attorney, Arthur Hanes.

Hanes advised Woods that Ray was a "little fuzzy" on the details of the purchase of the gun and for that reason Hanes would like to interview Woods to obtain more specific information.

Woods contacted our Birmingham Office today to inquire as to / whether he should consent to an interview with Hanes.

Birmingham furnished no advice to Woods concerning the matter but advised him that the request would be brought to the attention of the appropriate State and Federal authorities concerned with Ray's prosecution.

SAC Gamble has advised the Memphis Office of Hanes' request and instructed Memphis to bring the matter immediately to the attention of Phil M. Canale, Jr., State Attorney General, Shelby County, Tennessee, who is handling the State prosecution. Since Federal process charging Ray with violation of the Civil Rights Statute (Section 241, Title 18, U. S. Code) is outstanding in Birmingham, SAC Gamble is also bringing Hanes' request to the attention of the U. S. Attorney in Birmingham.

Any instructions to Woods relating to the interview requested by Hanes will be issued by State Attorney General Phil M. Canale, Jr., and/or the U.S. Attorney at Birmingham and the Birmingham Office will furnish absolutely no advice to Woods on the matter.



Beverley Harcourt Prophet reported to the Consulate General on August 1, 1968, and voluntarily submitted the two U.S. Passports in his possession. One of which was retained by this office for transmittal to PPT/LAD (see enclosure one).

Mr. Prophet is an interior decorator. He showed the reporting officer:

 by the Superior Gourt of Alumeda County in Oakland, Galifornia, in the name of Beverley Marcourt Prophat.
- 2. State of Ploulds driver's license No. I seed in the name of Beverley Harcourt Prophet.
- Birth Certificate, Province of Ontario, Prophet, Beverley Harcourt, born in "Orillia, Simcoe Co.", registered Sept. 15, 1936, under number , card issued May 20, 1964.

- 4. Social Security Card number to Beverley Harcourt Prophet.

Mr. Prophet plans to stay in South Africa for anywhere up to five more months. His address in the United States is, and will be, c/s Mr. Joseph Kordsmeier, 1895 Venice Gardens, Miami (north), Florida.

Mr. Prophet has used the names "John", "John B.H." and perhaps "John W." Prophet for business purposes in the United States as he found the name Beverley to be embarrassing and a drawback in his business contacts. He estimates he has been known professionally as 'John Prophet' for about twenty years. He has never used this name on a government form, state or national, to the best of his knowledge. He showed the reporting officer a large number of class and credit cards in this name however. He said he was so well known in the area he never had to show a birth certificate etc. to get credit or membership

cards. One example was noted by the reporting officer, should further investigation become necessary: "Coral Ridge National, 2626 East Oakland Park Blvd., P. O. Box 11004, Fort Lauderdale, Florida, 33306, Customer Ident. 074 7505, John Prophet INTERIORS".

Enclosure number two is a report on the passport still in Mr. Prophet's possession. Enclosure number three is a report on the passport returned to PPT/LAD. Visas and other pertinent information are included on these reports.

Mr. Prophet was extremely cooperative and expressed his regrets at the problems he caused the passport office. The Regional Security Officer's interest in the matter was not mentioned to Mr. Prophet nor was the interest of the CID. Of possible interest, however, Mr. Prophet was quite aware that he was being investigated by the CID and also that he looked somewhat like "James Earl Ray". He said the CID were polite to him at all times and he in no way wished to complain about their activities although he was disturbed by them quite a bit.

Consulate General Durban herewith returns United States Passport number issued to Beverley Harcourt Prophet on June 8, 1966, by the Consulate General of the United States of America in Toronto, Caneda. Mr. Prophet remains in possession of U.S. Passport number issued to Beverley Harcourt Prophet on June 1, 1966. The encloses passport has not been cancelled by the Consulate General as we assume that PPT/LAD will take whatever final action is accessary.

Mr. Prophet apologized for not returning the passport as requested by the Tennage Conflon. He noted it had expired and therefore felt is was unnecessary.

Beverley Marcourt Prophet used the name "John" on other than official government documents for business purposes only. His driver's license - Florida and London - were in his correct name as is his Social Security card. Because people kept mixing Beverley up and thinking he was a she, Mr. Prophet, in his area of business operations, took to using "John". He has not, however, officially changed his name or officially registered his AKA.

A full report on his travels and use of the name "John" is being sent to the Regional Security Officer, American Embassy, Pretoria. It may be noted, however, that Mr. Prophet created no suspicions on the part of the reporting officer.

He states that while in Los Angeles during April, 1968, he became involved with the Southern Christian Conference League (SCCL) and after working in the Watts area he was sent by the SCCL to Washington, D.C. as a "Tennessee Ranger" or "Tent City Ranger". As such, he was to help erect Resurrection City in Washington, D.C., and then to police same. In late April or early May, 1968, BELL with other Rangers traveled to Atlanta then to Memphis to act as bodyguards for KING. On April 24, 1968, BELL and "JOHNNY" LNU were relieved as guards and proceeded to a nearby bar to eat breakfast. They saw KING come onto the balcony of his hotel and saw him fall. BELL heard no shot. BELL looked at his watch and noted the time to be 10:30 AM. BELL and "JOHNNY" had started back to the hotel when a man came out of a building next door to the hotel and knocked BELL down and slugged "JOHNNY". BELL said this man was JAMES EARL RAY. BELL carried no identification and at the beginning of interview stated he had no Selective Service registration card. Later he volunteered the fact he was registered with Selective Service System, LB#43, 1916 "G" Street, Washington, D.C. BELL said he had been in Belleview Hospital, New York City, in 1967, after trying to commit suicide. He also stated he had escaped from Brentwood Reform School on Long Island, New York, where he had been sent as a runaway juvenile. BELL further stated he had been at St. Elizabeth's Hospital, Washington, D.C. from late February, 1968, until March 28, 1968, when he went AWOL. During the "Poor People's March" BELL said he had been arrested by WMPD, Washington, D.C., and was in jail for a time there. ROBERT E. MURRAY, Shield Number 110, Las Vegas PD, on 7/31/68 advised SCOTT OWEN BELL is his cousin. MURRAY said BELL had appeared at the Las Vegas PD 7/26/68 and asked for MURRAY, MURRAY said BELL is known to lie and a year or so ago had written MURRAY's mother and an uncle, STERLING BELL, saying that he, SCOTT BELL, was in Belleview Hospital in New York City. LV 157-133 had been in a mental hospital or in jail. On Saturday, 7/28/68, BELL passed out and MURRAY took him to the Southern Nevada Memorial Hospital in Las Vegas for treatment of an enlarged intestine. At this time MURRAY and STERLING BELL spoke with a doctor re the possibility of having BELL committed. The doctor said there was insufficient evidence indicating that BELL should be committed.
