It was concluded that JAMES EARL RAY, K171, K211 and k257 prepared the questioned Rayms signature on Q407: the questioned handwriting on Q408 and the questioned handwriting and hand printing on Q406. Although significant similarities we noted in the endorsements on ()398 through ()405, except the

endorsement on Q403, when compared with the known writings of RAY, the presence of unexplained variations, insufficient comparable material and distortion in some of the questioned endorsements precluded a definite determination as to whether RAY prepared the endorsements on Q398 through Q405.

The endorsement on 0403 is too distorted for comparison purposes. Although some similarities were noted in the date on line 24 on 0407 beside the Rayms signature when compared with the comparable writing of RAY, the limited and overwritten nature of this date precluded a definite determination as to whether RAY prepared this date.
