Enclosed are two copies of a letter from James Earl Ray referred to the Bureau by the U. S. Marshal.

Reference is made to your letter dated 7/22/69, under cover of which you furnished a property list pertaining to the subject which list had been signed by Legal Attache John Minnich as being the data and material which he had received from Scotland Yard. This list also contains your signature acknowledging receipt of the material from Legat Minnich and the signature of the Chief Jailer of the Shelby County Sheriff's Department who received the material from your.

This property list does not set forth any document as described by Ray; however, it does contain an item described as "A Quantity of Correspondence" which may have included the item in question. In addition, it could be that Ray is making reference to the list itself as described above.

You should contact appropriate state authorities who have custody of the evidence in this case to determine if they possess the item described by Ray and if so, suggest that they may desire to reply to Ray's inquiry.

You should then contact Ray and acknowledge his letter and suggest that he may desire to contact the appropriate state official furnishing the official's name and address.

If the specific item is not identified in the material possessed by state authorities, contact Ray and acknowledge his letter and obtain any additional details which may resolve this

**If the item requested by Ray is the list of property submitted under cover of urlet 7/22/68, and a copy of this list has not been previously furnished to Memphis State Authorities, you should furnish it to them now and advise them of Ray's inquiry and suggest they may desire to handle the inquiry.**

**Advise results of above within five days of receipt of this airtel.**

NOTE:

U. S. Marshal's Office has forwarded a letter written by James Earl Ray, subject in the Martin Luther King, Jr., murder case, in which Ray requests that he be furnished a "duplicate receipt" of property taken from him by the British when he was arrested in London. Ray states he was given the receipt by Superintendent Butler of Scotland Yard and when Ray was put on the plane for the United States this receipt was given to the U. S. Marshals.

Bureau Agents transported Ray from British authorities to Tennessee State authorities, not U. S. Marshals. A review of the Bureau file in this case did not disclose any item precisely as described by Ray but does contain a copy of the list described in this airtel (attached). Bureau Agents at the S.O.G. who assisted in the transporting of Ray from England and who turned him over to Tennessee State authorities do not recall any item precisely as described by Ray.

In light of this, the SAC, Memphis is being instructed to handle this matter as set forth in this airtel.

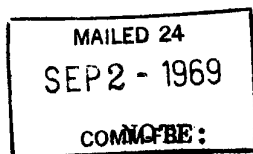

**GENERAL INVESTIGATIVE DIVISION**

This is the case involving the murder of Martin Luther King, Jr.

William Bradford Huie contacted our Birmingham Office and offered to make available manuscript of his book on the King murder for review.

Huie is the author of three articles which appeared in "Look" magazine relative to the Martin Luther King, Jr., murder case. Huie's articles were based on his interviews with James Earl Ray and inquiries Huie conducted. We reviewed all of these articles and ran out all information not previously developed in our investigation and the results were furnished to the Department and Tennessee State authorities with Department approval. None of the information in Huie's articles materially affected our investigation. In his last article in "Look" magazine on the King murder case which appeared in the 4/15/69, issue of "Look," Huie concludes that Ray alone was the murderer of King and he had resolved all of his questions as a result of his investigation. There was nothing unfavorable to the FBI in the articles.

This may be an effort on Huie's part to later claim FBI approval of his book. It is, therefore, recommended that we not accept his offer.

Approved Birmingham and Memphis will be instructed in line with the above.

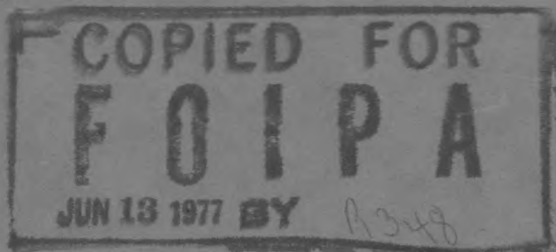
