Discrepancies in his version of an alleged meeting with an unknown white male at Pete's Bar Atlanta, Georgia, as compared with LEON POWELL's were discussed. CLAUDE stated that any discrepancies are a result of a long passage of time since the incident and his statement is accurate in his recollection. He clarified his relationship with RAY GODFREY stating that GODFREY was a friend whom he has known for many years but GODFREY was more closely associated and a better friend of LEON's. CLAUDE also commented that he later learned GODFREY made an initial contact with LEON approximately one week prior to the unknown white male's proposition to murder MARTIN LUTHER KING but he did not know anything about the meeting at Pete's Bar until the unknown white male seated himself and made the offer, nor did he have prior knowledge of what transpired between GODFREY and LEON.

Other than these changes, CLAUDE stands by his original statement, emphasizing that his statement may differ in some aspects with LEON's statement but the fact is, both he and LEON witnessed the offer of a substantial amount of money by an unknown white male to murder MARTIN LUTHER KING.

In addition, CLAUDE stated he and LEON talked about the alleged meeting with the unknown white male frequently after is occurrence but as time passed they talked about it less and less. He said that he and LEON worked together on the same job at the time of the alleged meeting and continued to do so until approximately three months ago. He knows of no one who could verify that they were in Atlanta, Georgia, at the time of the alleged meeting but stated that both, he and LEON, were residing in Decatur, Georgia, during this time. 

EP 44-920 the interior of Pete's Bar, including the booth where each participant of the allged meeting was seated and a sketch was made by Special Agent FRANZ W. NENZEL. CLAUDE was questioned specifically concerning his polygraph examination in response to the question "Do you know who asked you and LEON to kill MARTIN LUTHER KING?", and he denied having any prior knowledge of the unidentified person who offered he and LEON \$25,000 to murder MARTIN LUTHER KING. CLAUDE stated that he telephonically contacted his brother, LEON POWELL, at telephone number 404-289-1545, Decatur, Georgia (telephone number is for DAVID POWELL, CLAUDE's nephew) after initial interview by FBI Agents at Midland, Texas. CLAUDE stated that he and LEON discussed the interview. In addition, CLAUDE stated he had discussed the alleged meeting with the unknown person at Pete's Bar with WILLIAM DEAN WOODCOCK, his partner in business and roommate at the Scottish Inn. WOODCOCK is the only fellow employee whom he told of the alleged meeting. CLAUDE stated that the unknown person who offered them the money to murder MARTIN LUTHER KING did not have any type of an accent. William Dean Woodcock, Claude's roommate and business partner, advised that Claude told him of the alleged meeting at Pete's Bar in Atlanta, Georgia, after initial interview by FBI Agents. Woodcock said that to the best of his knowledge, he is the only co-worker of Claude's who knows of the alleged meeting. He said Claude told him because of their business relationship and his interest in the reason the FBI was contacting Claude. He believed Claude would have no reason to lie concerning the alleged meeting.

NOTE: This case pertains to the assassination of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., on 4/4/68. James Earl Ray pled guilty to this murder and presently is in local confinement.

As set forth in previous memoranda, we are conducting an investigation at the request of the CRD to resolve a recent allegation (made in January, 1976) by Leon Owen Powell and his brother, Claude Powell, Jr., that prior to the assassination of King, they were offered payment to murder King. Their accounts of this alleged incident differ in many respects.

Leon states he and Claude were in a bar in Atlanta in November of 1967, and a Ray Godfrey asked them if they would be interested in making "big money" to kill King. A couple of days later, a Ralph (LNU) approached them in the bar and indicated he had "25" in his briefcase and had "50" more when King was buried. Leon had initially stated during interview that Ralph only said "I guess you know why I'm here" and never actually said money being offered to them was to kill King. Claude states meeting occurred in about March of 1968. His account differs substantially from Leon's, however, does say they were approached in a bar by an unknown subject who offered them \$50,000 to kill King.

Leon was given a Bureau polygraph examination which was "inconclusive." Claude was given a Bureau polygraph, which determined that Claude was "truthtelling."

Our investigation fully identified Ray Godfrey as Arnold Ray Godfrey. During initial interview, Godfrey denied any involvement, and agreed to submit to a polygraph. When he was subsequently contacted re taking the polygraph, Godfrey stated "I am innocent"; stated he did wish to take the polygraph and did not wish to talk to the FBI any further. He stated if the FBI needs any further information they should contact his attorney.

We have conducted extensive investigation in this matter. On 2/27/76, Departmental Attorney Murphy contacted Godfrey's attorney as set forth above, to attempt to arrange further interviews with Godfrey in order to resolve this allegation.

This advises AT of this contact by Murphy and also instructs El Paso to reinterview Claude to resolve further discrepancies. (Leon claimed Pete Davis, the bar owner, observed Ralph. Our investigation determined Pete Davis is deceased and was not connected with bar at time of this alleged incident.)




