On 10/15/76, RICHARD SPRAGUE, Special Counsel for the House and Senate investigation into the deaths of President JOHN F. KENNEDY and MARTIN LUTHER KING, telephonically advised SA WILLIAM LOGAN CURTIS that he had recently met with officials of the U. S. Department of Justice. He indicated to them that he might request the assistance of certain FBI Agents to help in his investigation. They asked if he had in mind Agents who had worked on the YABLONSKI murder investigation, to which he responded in the affirmative.

Mr. SPRAGUE asked SA CURTIS if he would be agreeable to assisting in this investigation if detail could be worked out between him and FBIHQ.

Mr. SPRAGUE was advised that SA CURTIS would be interested however, this decision could only be made by FBIHQ. It was further related that SA CURTIS would only consider this if there was a pay increase, moving and travel expenses for SA CURTIS and his family were paid, and upon completion of the investigation, SA CURTIS could return to the Sacramento Division.

SINCE THE DEPARTMENT TASK FORCE MUST SEE EVERY SERIAL IN OUR INVESTIGATION OF KING AT FBIHQ AND IN THE FIELD, IT IS ECONOMICALLY BENEFICIAL TO THE GOVERNMENT TO REPRODUCE AND MAIL THESE DOCUMENTS RATHER THAN HAVING TASK FORCE PERSONNEL TRAVEL TO ALL FIELD OFFICES. ABOVE MENTIONED OFFICES TO BE VISITED IN THE FUTURE BY THE TASK FORCE WILL BE FURNISHED TRAVEL INFORMATION AT A LATER DATE.

NOTE:

The Attorney General ordered review of our King investigation and appointed a special Task Force to conduct the review. Present review by OPR is a continuation of a partial review begun in December 1975 by Civil Rights Division of the Department. At that time all field offices submitted inventory of King related files.

Field office files to be reproduced in 42 field offices total approximately 460 volumes, although many volumes contain only a few serials.

The above procedure has been coordinated with Fred Folsom, OPR Task Force leader, and SA J.W. Awe, Records Management Division. Mr. Folsom requested field office files be made available as soon as possible and therefore a deadline of October 26, 1976 has been established.
