



On 4/15/68, at 10:45 AM, RAY MC GAUGHEY, Truck Driver for Safeway Truck Lines, South Bend, Indiana, who resides at 713-1 Imperial Road, Valparaiso, Indiana, telephonically advised the Albany FBI Office that he saw a man whom he thought resembled KING's assassin based on the drawing made of KING's killer which has appeared in various newspapers.

MC GAUGHEY stated that approximately one week ago between 10:00 and 10:30 AM, he saw a white male depart from a bank, name unknown, which is located at the intersection of Route 6 and Mcool Road, Valparaiso, Indiana. MC GAUGHEY described unsub as being between 5'11" and 61" tall, weighing between 190 and 195 lbs., and 25-27 years old. He had sandy hair and was wearing light trousers and a small checkered shirt. MC GAUGHEY could not tell what color the shirt was. He stated that the shirt sleeves were rolled above his wrists and that unsub was carrying a small brown envelope.

MC GAUGHEY further advised that unsub was alone and that he got into a white, late model Mustang. He stated that it had Indiana License with the first two numbers being 64. He stated that two of the other numbers were 22 and that another number was 5 but that he was not certain whether the 5 was the third number or the number after the digits 22. MC GAUGHEY stated that the Mustang was parked on the north side of the bank at the west end.





PRESS RELEASE April 17, 1968

Attorney General Ramsey Clark announced today that Eric Starvo Galt is being sought by the FBI as a fugitive on a Federal charge arising from the fatal shooting of The Reverend Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., in Memphis, Tennessee, on April 4, 1968.

Director J. Edgar Hoover stated that a Federal complaint was filed by the FBI in Birmingham, Alabama, today charging Galt with conspiring to violate the civil rights of Dr. King in violation of Title 18, Section 241, of the United States Code.

The FBI complaint charges that "On or about March 29, 1968, at Birmingham, Alabama, ...Eric Starvo Galt and an individual whom he alleged to be his brother, entered into a conspiracy which continued until on or about April 5, 1968, to injure, oppress, threaten, or intimidate Martin Luther King, Jr., ... in the free exercise or enjoyment of a right secured to him by the Constitution or laws of the United States; namely, the right to freely travel from state to state. In furtherance of this conspiracy, Eric Starvo Galt did, on or about March 30, 1968, purchase a rifle at Birmingham, Alabama..."

According to Mr. Hoover, a 30.06 rifle equipped with a telescopic sight was found near a rooming house on South Main Street in Memphis immediately after the fatal shooting of Dr. King

occurred. The rooming house overlooks the Lorraine Hotel and Motel where Dr. King was staying.

Mr. Hoover said that FBI Agents determined that the 30.06 rifle had been purchased from a gun dealer in Birmingham, Alabama, on March 30, 1968. The telescopic sight also was purchased from this dealer.

The FBI Director said that Galt, who has used the names of John Willard and Harvey Lowmyer in the past, is the owner of a 1966 white Mustang bearing Alabama license plates which was located abandoned in Atlanta, Georgia, on April 11, 1968. Investigation disclosed that Galt purchased this car from a private citizen in Birmingham on August 30, 1967. The Mustang's odometer showed that it had been driven more than 19,000 miles between late August, 1967, and early April, 1968.

According to Mr. Hoover, Galt's travels in the Mustang included trips to Los Angeles, California; New Orleans, Louisiana; Birmingham, Alabama; and Mexico, as well as to Memphis, Tennessee, and Atlanta, Georgia. Galt was reported to have been in Memphis on April 3 and 4, 1968, and to have departed from there for Atlanta.

Intensive investigation by the FBI has disclosed that Galt has claimed to have been employed as a cook on Mississippi River vessels and as a merchant seaman. He is said to be an avid

dancer and took dancing lessons in New Orleans in 1964 and 1965; in Birmingham during September and October, 1967; and in Long Beach, California, from December, 1967 to February, 1968.

Galt left Los Angeles on December 15, 1967, and drove his white Mustang to New Orleans, where he claimed he contacted either an engineering or a contracting firm. He left New Orleans on December 19th and arrived back in Los Angeles on December 21, 1967.

While in the Los Angeles area early this year, Galt took a course at a school of bartending and was graduated on March 2, 1968.

The fugitive is described as white male. He is approximately 5 feet 8 inches to 5 feet 11 inches tall and weighs between 160 and 175 pounds. He is said to be a neat dresser and has a medium build.

Galt has brown hair, which he wears in a "brush" cut. He reportedly has blue eyes; his nose is straight and narrow; his teeth are straight and clean; and he has given his date of birth as

The fugitive is said to have a nervous habit of occasionally pulling at an ear lobe with his hand. His left ear protrudes farther from his head than his right ear.

According to Mr. Hoover, persons who have met Galt describe him as a "loner" and state his language and diction have a "rural" quality and suggest that he probaby does not have a

high degree of education. He is said to drink alcoholic beverages and has a preference for vodka and beer. He is a fan of Western and country music.

Galt should be considered armed and dangerous. Any information concerning him should be furnished immediately to the nearest FBI Office.

Elusive Galt's Landlord Ties Suspect To Chicago

Birmingham, Aia. (UPI) — Efic Starvo Galt, object of the FBl'S most intensive manhunt, received a letter from Chicago a few weeks before the slaying of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., his landlord said yesterday.

In a copyrighted interview in the Birmingham News, rooming house manager Peter Nicholas Cherpes, said the sketch of the man wanted in King's slaying "looked exactly like" Galt.

"He was above the average roomer in dress, talk and appearance," Cherpes said. "He always wore sporty clothes and a tie. He was always pleasant and I never knew of him drinking."

Cherpes said Galt didn't

say much about his family affairs, only that he was divorced. He only talked about the weather, never about politics or racial troubles."

He said Galt stayed at his rooming house at 2608 Highland Avenue from Aug. 26 to Oct. 7 last year.

He said that during September, Galt received a prepaid package in the mail from Chicago. He said it weighed 20 to 25 pounds, was about 2 feet long and 1 foot wide.

The next day, Cherpes said, Galt told him it was the wrong merchandise and he planned to send it back.

"About half an hour later I

saw him carrying the box to his car," Cherpes said.

IN OCTOBER, Cherpes said, Galt told him he was leaving for Mobile, Ala., to seek a job. Galt said he expected a letter from Chicago and asked Cherpes to hold it for him.

In February or March, Cherpes said, the letter came from Chicago. He said the envelope was thin and green, with a Chicago postmark.

"I held the letter for a week, and returned it," Cherpes said. He said it appeared to him the letter contained a check.

When he received the letter, Cherpes said, he went to his five to look for Galt's registration card and found it. But when FBI agents came to him last week, Cherpes said, it was missing.

Cherpes earlier denied knowing Galt. He said this was because the FBI has asked him not to say anything about the man. But he said the FBI had no authority to stop him. His rooming house was bolted and he refused to admit anyone yesterday afternoon.

Cherpes said that when Galt arrived at the rooming house, he told him his last job was in the shipyards at Pascagoula, Miss. However, Ingalls Shipbuilding Company at Pascagoula said it had never hired a man by that name.

Galt told Cherpes he was taking a "long vacation" and expected to stay at the rooming house three or four months. But he only stayed six weeks, Cherpes said.

The interview with Cherpes came amid growing reports that Galt — as such — may never have existed. Authorities were looking into the possibility that someone may have carefully constructed the identity of Galt for a bref period in Birmingham.

Galt's name first surged into the headlines Thursday night when a white Mustang auto, registered to him and resembling one that reportedly sped from the King assassination scene, was found parked in an Atlanta apartment complex.

No warrant has been issued for Galt's arrest, but it was learned that the FBI in Miami had issued - and then for unexplained reasons withdrew - a "locate and notify" bulletin on Galt Thursday.

THE MUSTANG registered to Galt carried Alabama ligense number 1-38993. A check with Alabama authorities established Galt's address as a rooming house at 2608 Highland Avenue in Birmingham, but residents, while re-calling Galt, said they had not seen him since November.

In obtaining his driver's license in 1967, Galt listed his occupation as an unemployed merchant mariner.

The FBI replied with a blanket "no comment" to all questions concerning the King investigation, but persons at the Birmingham rooming, house said agents were asking "plenty of questions" about Galt last week.

The only official announcements in the King case have come from Attorney General Ramsey Clark, who was sent to Memphis by President Johnson to help with the investigation after the civil rights leader was killed by a sniper while standing on a hotel balcony a week ago.

Clark said authorities had a suspect and his "name," but would not disclose the name.

UPI REPORTERS checking with maritime officials in Moagents, in addition to questioning persons at the Birmingham rooming house, also had made a check of the docks long be-

fore the Mustang was found.
A spokesman at the Seafarers International Union in Mobile said agents had visited the union offices two days age and had gone through automated files, without suc-

cess, in trying to get a lead on Galt.

Officials at the Maritime Union of America in Mobile said agents had made a similar check there, and the Star Fishing Company, one of the largest firms of its kind in the area, said it also had been visited by agents.

AGENTS ALSO checked out Coast Guard files in Washington during the day without finding any trace of Galt.

This raised speculation, which again officials refused to confirm or deny, whether

omeone, as early as last September, set about to establish credentials for a fictitious Eric Starvo Galt.

Alabama officials said that at the time he applied for his Alabama license, at the age of 36, he claimed to have had a Louisiana license since 1962, but there is no record that he ever turned it in.

The name of Galt was further validated when license tags for the Mustang were ob tained under that name of Oct. 2, 1967, in Jefferson County, Alabama.

During ride and conversation, UNSUB gave name as XXXXX JOHN WILLARD, claiming recently to have been in San Francisco, Long Beach, Memphis, New Orleans, stating that Memphis was a "clean lown". UNSUB carrying a sleeping bag, and canvas hand bag, looked as if traveling for a long time. Freeland stated he was from California, and subject memtioned several places that he was familiar with.

On 4/17/68, RICHARD JAMES, former AUSA, Hammond, Indiana, now City Attorney, Hammond, Indiana, advised that EARL THOMPSON, a city employee in the Hammond City Assessor's Office, advised him an individual registered a 1963 Ford on 4/15/68, and that this individual stated he was a merchant seaman who had recently come to this area from the South. JAMES stated THOMPSON stated he had read in the newspaper that such an individual was being sought in connection with the murder of MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.

On 4/17/68, EARL THOMPSON, City Assessor's Office, Hammond, Indiana, advised on \$ 4/15/68, ane CHARLES E. RODGERS, 515 Sibley, Hammond, Indiana, obtained a tax clearance certificate from his office in order to register a 1963 Ford. He stated RODGERS possessed U.S. Merchant Marine identification card stated RODGERS advised he had just come recently from Florida and that he had resided at one time at 6041 Columbia. Hammond, Indiana, THOMPSON stated the seaman card had a photograph of RODGERS. He stated he was a white male, 6'1", date of birth, light brown hair. 160-170 lbs. THOMPSON advised he had read in the newspaper that the FBI was seeking a merchant seaman from the South in connection with the death of MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. and therefore he wanted to pass the information on. He was shown the two artist's conceptions of the individual possibly connected with instant matter. He stated he could not identify him as identical with the individual known as RODGERS. He only could say he was "a little like him in ways and taller, with light hair." Another employee, LEE WALSH, was also shown the artist(s conceptions and also stated there was "some resemblance", but could not identify him.

On 4/17/68, MARY BAILEY, Clerk, Records Office, Hammond, Ind., advised CHARLES EDWARD RODGERS, 6041 Columbia Avenue, Hammond, Ind., received a traffic summons on 7/5/67 for failure to stop for a railroad crossing and was fines \$1 plus costs, which were suspended. She stated he was described as a white male, 6'1", 147 lbs. brown hair, fair complexion, dob - and place of birth, Columbus, Ga. His occupation was listed as a cab driver.

On 4/17/68, LORRAINE SPUDIC, Asst. Cashier, License Bureau, calumet Avenue, Hammond, Indiana, advised that on 4/15/68, CHARLES E. RODGERS, $415\frac{1}{2}$ Sibley, Hammond, Indiana, registered a 1963 Ford Convert., VIN 3G65C189590, and was issued 1968 Indiana license 45W8257. She stated this registration corrected a 1967 registration for the same vehicle in which RODGERS name was spelled ROGERS. She stated the vehich was purchased in 12/67 from Swets Motor Sales, 18024 Torrence, Lansing, Illinois, and was first registered on 1/5/68

On 4/17/68, CLARENCE MAINSHIP, Desk Clerk, Jefferson Hotel, $415\frac{1}{2}$ Sibley, Hammond, Indiana, advised CHARLES E. RODGERS, has been residing at that hotel since 4/1/68. He has a room for which he pays \$13 per week. A former address was listed as 4528 Holly Place, Columbus, Ga. He stated there was an indication he was a merchant seaman awaiting papers to work on the Great Lakes.

No further action is recommended.

Cab Drivers Place Galt In Atlanta After King Slaying

Atlanta (UPI)-An Atlanta axicab driver identified for the FBI yesterday a sketch of the elusive Eric Starvo Galt and said the mystery figure in the search for Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.'s assassin rode in his cab the day after the slaying.

A second taxicab driver working for the same company said he, too, gave the man a ride the Friday after King was shot by a sniper in Memphis, Tenn., April 4.

BOTH DRIVERS said the trips were in Atlanta's "Hippie" neighborhood around Peachtree and 14th Street. The area is about 7 miles from the public housing project where a white Ford Musang, registered to Galt, was

located by FBI agents Mst Thursday.

Both taxi drivers work for the Atlanta Million CoOperative Cab Company. Their names were withheld at the request of the taxicab firm.

The FBI has pored through the records of Atlanta Million Cab and other taxicab firms in the city in an attempt to trace Galt from the tine he apparently abandoned the white Mustang found in the

Capitol Homes housing project.

Apparently working on a new lead, however, FBI agents returned to the offices of Atlanta Million Cabs yesterday and asked specifically if any drivers had made pickups in the "hippie" neighborhood on the Friday after King was slain.

Two drivers who had made such pickups were questioned and identified a sketch of the man the FBI evidently thinks is Galt.

The first driver told the FBI he picked up the man at the intersection of Peachtree and 14th streets. He drove his fare only two blocks-a fact that made him remember the trip—and then the man ide-

manded to be let out imme-

The driver said he had gone two blocks south on Peachtree to 12th Street, and there the man got out, paid his fare and walked quickly down 12th Street west.

THE SECOND taxicab drivgr told the FBI he recognized the man in the sketch as the same man who rode in his cab to the address of a modern two-story apartment building.

The second driver did not recall if the man entered the apartments or walked off in another direction. The location is at the intersection of 13th) Street and Crescent Avenue, one block west of the 14th and Peachtree streets intersection where the first driver said he picked up the same man.

Ed Collins, president and general manager of the taxicab firm, said the FBI would not tell him or the drivers what the new leads in the investigation might mean. He aid the FBI told him it was making similar checks with other Atlanta taxicab firms.

How Did Eric Galt Vanish?

BIRMINGHAM (AP) — Dead-end clues to a man who vanished without a trace apparently confronted FBI agents today in their investigation of the sniper slaying of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.

False leads multiplied in the hunt for Eric Starvo Galt, a mysterious quiet-talking man whose last known address was a Birmingham rooming house. His former landlord said yesterday he had identified drawings shown by FBI agents as resembling Galt.

"It's him," said Peter Cherpes, 72, who runs a 2-story Southside boarding house where Galt lived for six weeks last fall.

Galt's abandoned white Mustang was impounded last Thursday by the FBI in Atlanta. It fit the description of a car seen leaving the scene after King was killed April 4 by a sniper firing from a rooming house in Memphis.

Memphis witnesses described the suspected assassin, who registered as John Willard 'at a rooming house opposite King's motel, as about 6 feet and sandy-haired and "a clean, neat man."

No trace of Willard apparently has been found.

An FBI alert for Galt, in a white Mustang, was issued in Florida last Thursday, but was canceled. However, the FBI has continued a search for Galt's whereabouts or clues to his past.

Galt received a package rom Chicago, and a letter arrived for him from Chicago after he left the rooming house and was returned to the sender, the landlord said.
