ASAC BROWN advised that the Bureau had telephonically apprised the Chicago Office of the above information the afternoon of 4/19/68, and Chicago was initiating an intensive effort to cover all leads in the RAY case. In this regard, subject RAY's brother, JERRY RAY, was at the time of this phone call, being interviewed in the Chicago Office by agents. According to ASAC BROWN, the information JERRY RAY was furnishing on this date was practically identical to the information he furnished when interviewed earlier, the substance of this being that he had only seen his brother three times in the past fifteen years and all of those occasions were when he visited JAMES RAY in prison.

SA AIREY advised ASAC BROWN that instant call would be confirmed by a written communication setting forth all leads in the Chicago Division.

He was ordered there by the Circuit Court, Jefferson City, Mo., because of escape attempts from the Missouri State Penitentiary. Agent AYERS advised that PETERSON furnished him a full page of RAY's handwriting samples and negative of photo taken during September, 1966, at the hospital.

PETERSON also advised confidentially and not to be released under court order that their diagnosis revealed that "RAY had no mental disease or defects under terms of the Statute."

AYERS advised that he would immediately drive to Kansas City with the handwriting samples and photographic negative.

He advised that he is supposed to pick up a lady, who works for the Kansas City Star, at her home at 4:30 AM at 214 West 74th Terrace, and that he was the route to this address and was stopped at 73rd and Wormhill and noticed a man and a woman in an automobile. Theman jumped out of the car and came over to his cab and requested to be taken to the New Yorker Hotel. He advised the man that he was on his way no pick up a lady to take downtown and the fellow at this time entered the cab. He advised that he drove the lady to the Kansas City Star and then drove the man to the New Yorker Hotel.

He advised that the man talked about different cities that he had visited and that he arrived in town yesterday morning. He stated this man told him he had been to Memphis, Los Angeles, and Kansas City.
