ANOTHER CLOSE FRIEND (NAME URECALLED) OF ITALIAN DESCENT APPARENTLY "BIG MAN" IN SYNDICATE. THIS ITALIAN HAD APPARENTLY OPERATED WITH RAY IN PAST AND ENGAGED WITH RAY IN HANDLING STOLEN POST OFFICE MONEY ORDERS AND TRAVELERS CHECKS.

WILLIAM KENNETH KNIGHT, KNOWN BURGLAR INCARCERATED WITHIN TAMPA DIVISION, HAS BEEN FURNISHING VOLUME OF INFORMATION RE POST OFFICE BURGLARIES FOR PAST SEVERAL YEARS, INCLUDING IDENTITY OF MAJOR FENCES FOR STAMPS AND POSTAL MONEY ORDERS. THESE INTERVIEWS HAVE BEEN CONDUCTED BY SPECIAL AGENT OF FBI AND WAYNE R. RICHIE, POSTAL INSPECTOR, ORLANDO, FLA.

REFERENCED TAMPA TEL STATES THAT KNIGHT INTERVIEWED APRIL FIFTEEN LAST AND UNABLE TO FURNISH INFORMATION RE KNOWLEDGE OF RAY, HOWEVER, HE WAS APPARENTLY ONLY SHOWN COMPOSITE PICTURE.

TAMPA REQUESTED TO REINTERVIEW KNIGHT AND EXHIBIT REAL PHOTOS OF RAY TO DETERMINE WHETHER KNIGHT MIGHT KNOW HIM OR BE ABLE TO DIRECT INVESTIGATION TOWARD ESTABLISHING IDENTITY OF FENCES REFERRED TO BY CURTIS IN YESTERDAY'S INTERVIEW. TAMPA ALSO REQUESTED TO CONTACT POSTAL INSPECTOR WAYNE RICHIE TO DETERMINE WHETHER HE MIGHT BE HELPFUL IN IDENTIFYING THESE FENCES.

On 4-23-68 records of the Magistrate Court, Laclede County, Lebanon, Missouri, reveal WILSON appeared there on 8-7-67 and plead guilty to charge of driving intoxicated. He was fined \$100.00 and \$14.20 costs. His residence was listed as 1001 Lock St., Dade City, Florida and he had Florida Drivers License G172074 and was driving a Willis Chaw truck from Springdale, Arkansas.

On 4-23-68 Sheriff FRANCIS MURPHY, Deputies VERGIL DAVIS AND RALPH WATKINS, along with MSHP Officers Sgt, CLAUDE ARNOLD, JIM MORELAND, GLENN WILSON, and SI DAVID were exhibited a photo of subject but none could give any information concerning him or make any identification.

Sheriff MURPHY advised there are only two taverns in Lebanon, Missouri. City Tavern and Mary's Tavern.

On 4-23-68 LOUISE MUSSELMAN, City Tavern, 120½ W. Commercial and MARY SPARKS, Mary's Tavern 107 No. Madison, both Lebanon, Missouri, observed photos of subject and stated they were unable to recall him as ever being a patron in their respective taverns. Both said he is not a regular or occasional customer and they were unable to give any additional information.

BEN GOODIN, FORD SALESMAN, JEFFERSON CITY, MISSOURI, ADVISED THAT HE WAS A FORMER CHEF AT THE MISSOURI STATE PENITENTIARY AND KNEW SUBJECT WELL. HE WAS SUBJECT'S BOSS FOR SIX YEARS. GOODIN STATED RAY WAS A GOOD FRIEND OF AN INMATE BY THE NAME OF LEWIS DOWDA. HE STATED DOWDA HATED NEGROES.
