Referenced communication states that in connection with identification of JAMES EARL RAY as subject in instant matter, the source of his funds becomes of paramount interest. Each office was requested to review his unsub bank robbery and bank burglary matters where latents were recovered and have latents searched against latents in MURKIN case.

Probability also exists that RAY may have been involved in burglary or robbery not in FBI jurisdiction and may be matter of interest to local police departments. Offices are instructed to contact major law enforcement agencies within their divisions and determine whether or not any armed robberies or burglaries perpetrated in which latents recovered or in which unsub may fit general description of subject RAY. In connection with this, SA LEO V. EWING should contact the Kansas City, Missouri, Police Department; SA OTTO T. HANDWERK, JR., Kansas City, Kansas, Police Department; SA JAMES P. HOSTY, JR., Johnson County law enforcement agencies and SA LARRY D. FINK, Independence, Missouri, Police Department. In addition, each RA and Road Trip Agent should contact law enforcement agencies in their area.

Also Agents with sources with knowledge of the boothill area of Missouri should be contacted regarding JAMES DAVID DAILEY who is an alleged former friend and associate of RAY who reportedly

MONTH PERIOD AT MSP HE WAS ACQUAINTED WITH SUBJECT RAY AND WITH INMATE RAYMOND CURTIS MENTIONED IN THE UPI NEWS RELEASE. SERO STATES HE MENTIONED TO RAY AND TO CURTIS ON ONE OCCASION THAT HE HAD HEARD SPECULATION TO THE EFFECT THAT IF MARTIN LUTHER KING EVER ATTEMPTED A BOYCOTT MOVEMENT IN MEMPHIS, IT WOULD BE WORTH A LOT OF MONEY TO THE LOCAL BUSINESSMEN TO HAVE KING MURDERED. SERO STATED HE CANNOT RECALL WHO FIRST MENTIONED THIS TO HIM BUT HE DOES RECALL THAT IT WAS MERE SPECULATION, THAT NO PARTICULAR GROUP OF BUSINESSMEN WAS MENTIONED AND THAT THE STATEMENT ITSELF HAD ABSOLUTELY NO BASIS IN FACT. HE SAID THAT IF RAYMOND CURTIS AND RAY INTERPRETED IT OTHERWISE THEY WERE READING MORE INTO THE STATEMENT THAT WAS INTENDED.

SERO STATED HE HAS HEARD NOTHING FROM RAY SINCE SERO LEFT THE MSP IN NINETEEN SIXTYFOUR AND HE HAS NO IDEA WHERE HE MIGHT BE EXCEPT THAT RAY MENTIONED HAVING FRIENDS OR CONTACTS IN KANSAS CITY. SERO STATED RAY IS NOT A LONER BUT SIMPLY DOES NOT KNOW HOW TO MAKE FRIENDS. HE STATED RAY HAS A HATRED FOR NEGROES AND HAS A STRONG DESIRE TO PERFORM SOME

NOTORIOUS ACT THAT WILL MAKE HIM FEEL IMPORTANT. HE DESCRIBED RAY AS A BORN LOSER AND QUESTIONED RAY'S ABILITY TO PLAN AND EXECUTE EVEN THE SIMPLEST CAPER. SERO IS AGREEABLE TO ASSISTING THE FBI IN ANY WAY POSSIBLE.

KANSAS CITY HAS INDICATED THAT A PCI OF THEIR OFFICE AND FORMER PRISON MATE OF THE SUBJECT IS WILLING TO TRAVEL TO ANY PLACE WHERE HE MIGHT ASSIST IN THIS MATTER. MEMPHIS HAS NO REASON TO BELIEVE SUBJECT RAY IS IN ANY PARTICULAR PLACE AND IS UNABLE TO SUGGEST ASSIGNMENT FOR THE KANSAS CITY PCI.

NUMEROUS LOOK ALIKES BEING INVESTIGATED AND ELIMINATED.
