Caller stated she was in the Mahogany Bar, 901 North Dorman, in Indianapolis when RAY came in, ordered and drank one "Weidman" and later left.

Patricia Statler stated RAY was wearing black trousers, white socks, black shoes, and blue sweater and had a "sort of a V triangle scar on forehead"; hair very neatly kept. After man believed to be RAY left bar, Patricia Statler asked bartender and waitress if they had ever seen man and they stated had never seen him before then.

Patricia Statler gave following directions to her residence on Rural Route, Carbondale, Kansas: South of Topeka on highway 75 to caution light in Carbondale, Kansas, turn right at light and go approximately six blocks to end of road and turn left to 2nd house which is a pink duplex (McCormick Duplex).

Caller stated she would be at residence all day on 4/30/68 and would be very interested in seeing more pictures of subject RAY other that ones seen in newspapers. Caller also insisted that her name be kept confidential re information furnished.
