On May 14, 1968, BERCIA LEE BARBARICK, MSP #12587, born said he was admitted to the MSP in 1959. He was in until 1965; released and returned on a murder charge in 1966. He said he knew RAY on sight, but that is all and he knew nothing of his habits, associates or escape. He said a guard told him that some "kid" had seen RAY last summer sleeping on a hill near Jefferson City with a "long beard". He also said that there is an organization in the MSP which wanted KING killed. He said it was not the "COOLEY organization", of which he had never heard, but the KKK. He said he did not hear any mention of this before Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING was murdered and he could not identify anyone who has mentioned it since.

He said he had heard nothing concerning any bounty and knew of no lotteries.

On May 14, 1968, Mr. MC CORMICK WILSON, City Judge and Attorney, said he was appointed to represent JAMES EARL RAY in connection with an attempted escape by RAY in 1966. He said he talked to him at the Penitentiary and once in court. He said he also arranged to have him examined at State Hospital #1. He said he received no fees of any sort and was relieved on the case because he was appointed as an Assistant Attorney General. He said WILLIAM QUIGG completed the case.

On May 14, 1968, WILLIAM QUIGG, Central Missouri Trust Company, said he represented RAY by appointment of the court. He said he received no fees of any sort, and knew nothing about him, his background, associates, or whereabouts.

On May 14, 1968, Mr. W. C. SHELEY said that JAMES EARL RAY was represented in connection with a writ of habeas corpus case in January of 1963 by PHILLIP LEE BAKER.

OnMay 14, 1968, Mr. WADE BAKER, no kin, Secretary, Missouri Bar Association, Jefferson City, Missouri, said that PHILLIP LEE BAKER is an attorney and lives at 214 South Spring, Independence, Missouri.

The following investigation was conducted at Kansas City, Missouri by IC WILLIAM F. ROHR on May 15, 1968:

A review of Kansas City, Missouri Police Department file #94249 disclosed JAMES WILSON BROWN, described white, male, born 2 1abs  $5^{1}6^{1}$ , 176 lbs., FBI # 504 977 3, was arrested by Alabama, the Kansas City, Missouri Police Department on November 23. 1959 for investigation - hold for homicide. arrest disclosed BROWN shot and killed a man in Kansas City in what was termed a "lover's quarrel." The victim had been dating BROWN's girlfriend and thereafter BROWN shot and killed victim. BROWN gave a signed statement admitting this murder and on March 6, 1960, this charge was reduced to murder second at which time BROWN entered a plea of builty and was sentenced to a period of 20 years to be served at the Missouri State Penitentaary, Jefferson City, Missouri. It was noted that from the date of arrest, Nevember 23, 1959, until date of sentencing, March 6, 1960, BROWN was incarcerated in the Jackson County Sheriff's Office, Kansas City, Missouri.

A review of Kansas City, Missouri Police Department file 92747, disclosed JOHNNY VELANTA, also known as RAYMOND DUTTON JACKSON, MELODY RENO LA VALLE, ROY DOUGLAS/TAYLOR, CARL DUTCHIN VON DEMERON, MILES SWIFTWATER, "RENO". VELANTI described white male, born Virginia, 5'8", 175 lbs., FBI # 416 361 2.

VELANTI was arrested by the Kansas City, Missouri Police Department on February 10, 1959 for investigation recent activities. It was determined that VELANTI held up a hotel clerk in Kansas City and he furnished a signed statement admitting same. VELANTI was tried by a jury for this holdup and tried under the habitual criminal statute and was found guilty by the jury, sentenced to 20 years to the Missouri State Pentientiary, Jefferson City, Missouri, date not given. This file disclosed that after the jury returned the guilty verdict and the Judge sentenced him to 20 years, he walked in front of the jury box and cried out "Twenty years is a hell of a long time" and slashed his wrists with a rezor blade.

File also contained a newspaper article which disclosed VELANTI, while disarcerated in the Jackson County Jail, Kansas City, Missouri awaiting trial, had fashioned a gun from a bar of scap and covered it with black shoe polish which made this gun look real. The gun was located during a routine search of VELANTI's cell.

At the time of arrest by the Kansas City, Missouri Police Department, VELANTI advised the arfesting officers that he had no father and that he did not know his mother's name.

A copy of the KD1 identification record of BROWN and VELANTI were obtained as were photographs of these two individuals.



The following investigation was conducted by SA DAVID D. THOMAS at Folsom State Penitentiary, Folsom, California, on May 13, 1968:

HAROLD DEAN KLEMP advised he knew JAMES EARL RAY and had met RAY through RAY's crime partner, JAMES "SHORTY" OWENS. He stated that he and OWENS had been cellmates from October, 1961, to December, 1964, at Missouri State Penitentiary (MSP) and that this was the time he had been acquainted with RAY.

KLEMP described RAY as a non-descript person who no one would remember unless one had had direct dealings with him. He said that "when word got around" concerning RAY's abortive attempt to escape from the MSP, the question asked by all the inmates was, "Who is JIMMY RAY".

KLEMP described RAY as a quiet, close-mouthed, even-tempered and self-educated individual who minded his own business. He said RAY's only concern was escape and that he had no interest in problems of the Negro people. KLEMP said as a "for instance", the occasion in which race riots broke out at MSP in an attempt to integrate the prison facilities, KLEMP stated that even though some of RAY's friends were involved, he, RAY, had nothing to do with the disorder and was completely disinterested.

KLEMP stated that RAY's mind was consumed with the idea of escape and that RAY would not, after escaping from prison, be so stupid as to shoot a "big-wig like KING". KLEMP said he did not believe RAY killed KING; that to his knowledge, RAY had no dislike for Negroes.

MLEMP stated further he thought RAY was probably hiding somewhere within the United States although he did remember that RAY and an inmate at MSP, whose name he recalled as EDMUNDSON (phonetic), often discussed escaping to Canada.

He said, as he recalled, EDMUNDSON did escape from MSP and was captured at Expo 67 in Canada.

KLEMP advised he had not heard of or had any connection with RAY since he had left MSP on December 31, 1964.

his release in April, 1967, he became very friendly with an inmate identified as LEROY MC MANAMAN. MC MANAMAN was originally from western Kansas and was alleged to have bootlegged in Mississippi. According to NISSEN, he and MC MANAMAN worked together in the shoe factory at Leavenworth.

NISSEN said he had previously met MC MANAMAN before going to the penitentiary in Jackson, Mississippi, and he recognized MC MANAMAN again at Leavenworth.

Just before NISSEN was scheduled to be parolled from Leavenworth, MC MANAMAN approached him and stated that he knew NISSEN was going to Atlanta and that he wanted NISSEN to set things up for him.

MC MANAMAN told NISSEN that \$100,000.00 had been offered by the WKKKKOM to be paid to anyone who would kill MARTIN LUTHER KING.

MC MANAMAN allegedly instructed NISSEN to contact a Mrs. (first name unknown) EURE, at the Eure Realty Company, Jackson, Miss. MC MANAMAN claimed Mrs. EURE is listed as a correspondent by him at Leavenworth Penitentiary. According to MC MANAMAN's instructions, NISSEN was to contact Mrs. EURE and ask her when she next writes to MC MANAMAN at the Penitentiary to tell him "DON" had arrived. MC MANAMAN indicated he would write and tell EURE that NISSEN was "O.K."

If NISSEN wanted to try to "pull this" himself, Mrs. EURE would put him in contact with two people identified only as FLOYD (lnu), an Honorary Colonel in the National Guard at Jackson, Miss., and a second person whom NISSEN could not now recall. NISSEN stated that the unidentified person, according to MC MANAMAN had recently been appointed Deputy Unit ed States Marshal at Jackson.

A review of Leavenworth Penitentiary Parole Progress Report for LEROY BASIL MC MANAMAN dated October, 1966, disclosed MC MANAMAN began his sentence at Leavenworth on January 18, 1963. The offense is listed as receiving and concealing stolen vehicle from interestate commerce. Under the Sentence Captioned there is an entry "Harboring a Fugitive 9 Years". The codefendants were listed as BURTON HARRY HERPEL, RUBIE CHARLES JENKINS and CHARLES E. TESCHER.

The Classification Study Sheet discloses the following description of LEROY BASIL MC MANAMAN:

The Arrest Record Sheet in the Classification Study shows MC MANAMAN was arrested 12/22/34, Dodge City, Kansas, for investigation. He has numerous arrest since that time in Kansas, Omaha, Nebraska, Colorado Springs, Colorado, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, and Springfield, Missouri.

MC MANAMAN is a native of Kansas and has resided in that state most of his life. He has been somewhat nomadic in the past several years, drifting throughout both Kansas and Oklahoma. His last residence was with his parents in Dodge City, Kansas.
