Following information furnished this date by GENE BLAKE, reporter for the Los Angeles Times, Los Angeles, California:

Movement of JAMES EARL RAY on the day before the shooting. He was picked up by someone in Athens, Alabama, and taken to Memphis. He registered in the rooming house in which the shooting occurred and another man registered under the name of SAMUEL LEWIS. LEWIS was to be the back up man in case RAY unable to kill KING on the balcony, and that night LEWIS would take care of it at the rally. After the shooting RAY walked 2 or 3 blocks to getaway car, accompanied by a girl and a man. Getaway car not the white Mustang but a new blue Buick, Alabama license with first two digits "14" and driven by man named EDDIE WILBURN, Huntsville, Alabama. Car equipped with a police radio.

Meanwhile, SAMUEL LEWIS stayed overnight in Memphis at the rooming house. The next day he took an early bus to Knoxville.

Meanwhile RAY driven out of town in the Buick by EDDIE WILBURN, accompanied by two girls and a child. They went to Kansas City, 6 1/2 hours to make the trip. The two girls and child from Huntsville.

In Kansas City RAY stayed overnight in a home described as being small, gray color, one bedroom, about 3 miles from central downtown Kansas City. Direction to house on a main street downtown intersecting a street which goes up an incline to the right on the left side of street as you turn on a secondary street Western Union office on left hand side. Up hill until it levels off, then on the same street 2 1/2 to 3 miles, nice brown apartments on left hand side housing university students, a short distance further a moving company on the right hand of the street, behind that large grocery or supermarket which sells beer, beyond that street that turns off to the right, on the right hand side of that street

a vacant lot with lots of weeds, on the left hand side two or three or four doors from the corner is the small gray house.

The next day 4/5/68 RAY flown out of Kansas City in a private plane about dusk to Belle Glade, Florida, using private field used as a training field for the military. Arrived at Belle Glade, Florida, early on the morning of 4/6/68.

Plane owned by WILLIAM PLERCE said to be a wealthy man who owns own airport in Belle Glade, Florida, and also owns a contracting company in Cuba. Not known whether he flew the plane. PIERCE also owns a motel in Palmetto, Florida, and cottages on a nearby lake - Okeechobee. PIERCE is said to be a KKK. RAY stayed in PIERCE's motel or one of the cottages and may even still be there or he may be in Cuba.

On 4/11/68 RAY got on a yacht, probably a chartered fishing boat in Key West owned by BEN THOMPSON (a BEN THOMPSON in Miami ownes three fishing boats).

PIERCE frequently flies a private airplane to New Orleans. Said to know the District Attorney, Mr. GARRISON. PIERCE and WILBURN said to be related. WILBURN might be at VFW Club in Huntsville, he is believed to be a member.

A rifle supposedly left in the furnace at the Memphis rooming house.

RAY said to be wearing bifocals.

White Mustang owned by RAY not in Memphis on the day of the shooting and never left Georgia in April.

On 4/4/68 RAY made telephone calls from Memphis to Belle Glade, Florida, believed to be from a bus station with credit card issued to a RIDELL Catering Company, either a subsidiary of U. S. Rubber Company or does business with the U. S. Rubber Company in Detroit and possibly name on credit card is ROBERT BRINKLEY.

Weeks before shooting RAY stayed somewhere in Belle Glade, Florida.

The payoff came from WILBURN's pay off in Reno,

Nevada. On the night before the killing someone hit a key note ticket for \$25,000 at the Palmetto Lodge done with the knowledge of the man who runs the Palmetto, CHARLIE CATE, 6880 Pebble Beach Drive, Reno. Another name BEN or JACK STURGIS, St. Louis, who worked in a bar on 2nd Street in Reno.

RAY (first or last name) stayed in Clark Hotel, Room 700, on 4/17-18/68. LAMONT WHITE, Western Union in Louisiana, has sent money to Louisnana and bought two pistols under his name but pistols really went to mannamed FRANK. BICKLEY of Chattanooga in prison with RAY and BICKLEY in Los Angeles now. Harold's Cafe, 555 South Main Street, Los Angeles, where RAY worked as bartender week or so and a man named CONNI that knows him quite well.

WILLI SHEA (woman) once worked at Top Rail Bar, 7th and Aldorado Street, Los Angeles, and RAY married to her at one time. She is from Missouri, now lives in North Hollywood, seems to have a lot of money, has a mother in Compton who drives a purple convertible, now lives 812 South Wesley, living with bar owner whose name may be CLARK.

SAMUEL LEWIS, back up man, discharged in 1963 from Federal Yough Correctional Agency, Milan, Michigan. Also served time in Chillicothe and Terre Haute.

LEWIS supposedly took a bus from Knoxville to Los Angeles on 4/7/68 through Memphis and El Paso. Informant turned over bus ticket dated 4/7/68 in which the routing exactly as stated, turned over to Los Angeles Office.

WILLIAM PIERCE once married to ANNA LEE WILLIAMS, now owns a vegetable packing house in Belle Glade, Florida.

More information on the house in Kansas City - no garage, dirt driveway, living room, big deep freeze well stocked with food apparently being used as an after hours entertainment place and hiding place, one bedroom in the back.

A number of WILLIAM PIERCES in Florida, one in Miami who flies, two in Belle Glade, one in a shanty in the Negro area and the other has a machine shop. PIERCE supposed to be the man with the money.



The following investigation was conducted by SA TROMAS E. WRAVER:

AT JUSTIAGON CITY, MISSOURI

On May 15, 1908, CREIL CLAYTON LILLIERINGE, also known as CARL LILLIERINGE, who requested the Value identity as the source of this information be concealed, was contacted at the Cole County Jail, and he furnished the following information:

He knew JAMES BARL RAY for quite some time before RAY was moved into his cell at the Missouri State Penitentiary (MEP). He had had some minor dealings with RAY in poker. RAY himself played very little poker, but he would lend money to immates who did play poker at the "3 for 2" rate requiring \$3 to be repaid for every \$2 leaned. RAY was "too tight" to play poker, and even when he leaned money at the exerbitant interest rates he required some kind of collateral. was a "walk man" in the MSP, having reference to an inmate whose duties called for his moving freely around the cell block, then RAY would have been a carrier for the usual prison lotteries dealing with numbers and parleys over ball game secres, in which eigerettes were bet, and the "walk man" would deliver the makers slipp and the winners' eigarettes, and would be paid a percentage by the insate who ran the lottery through this association, but the "walk man" would perform the service strictly for his commission and would not necessarily be "close" to the person running the lottery, but would be selected because he had access to other innates' cells. has no information that MAY was ever a "walk man" or ever ongaged in lotteries as described above.

In his conversations with RAY he learned that RAY was more interested in Mexico than in Canada. In speaking of places to go to "cool off" or "hide out", he suggested to RAY that it would be easier for a white American to hide out in Canada than in Mexico, since his skin color and language would be the same as the natives, but RAY had spent some time in Mexico and apparently liked the area and he expressed very little interest in Canada.

He and RAY discussed a newspaper article wich was published at about the time they celled together in which an Italian criminal's encape to Italy from the U. B. was apparently accomplished through his obtaining a Canadian passport, and it was suggested and HAY was apparently aware of the custom of the Episcopal Church and Church of Smeland and its branches in Capada of keeping baptismal records and records of birth for years, which records would be easily accessible to anyone wanting to assume a new identity. They discussed how one could go to a medium-nized Canadian city, find records of birth through an open, easily accessible church, for an individual about one's own age, verify through local inquiry or source material that some such person is deceased, then write to the Provincial capital of that province requesting a copy of the birth cortificate for that person, thereby securing documentary evidence of a new identity to use in securing a Canadian passport. BAY did not express a great deal of interest in this process and made no mention of planning. to use such a technique to escape or change his identity. He did not say anything about any plans to go to Canada or to Mexico and thereby to a third country, and he never mentioned any interest in Rhodesia or other country with a view of flight there in hopes of avoiding extradition. RAY did say that he had considered Australia as a place to go to avoid apprehension for a wanted person, but indicated that be bad dismissed Australian as a refuge because of the sparse population and the lack of tourists. RAY told him that he had written to Queensland, apparently before 1962, to some Government agency inquiring about the type of employment available there for foreigners, but his conversation indicated be bed no interest in Australia at that point.

Most of RAY'S conversation revolved aroung Mexico when speaking of places to go after "pulling some job". He made no mention of marcetics sauggling to Mexico, and he did not say how he planned to obtain the "hg haul" he wanted to make in order to "retire", other than that he might happen onto a large supermarket with a lot of money on hand which he could rob. He did not mention any specific supermarket or area of the country in this regard. From his conversation, he felt that RAY had actual experience in and knowledge of

smaggling small appliances into the Campeche Bay area of Mexico for resale. He mentioned that there were some dollars to be made in this racket with a very small investment required. RAY'S associate MATEO LOPEZ GARCIA or MATEO GARCIA LOPEZ or some similar node previously described by LILLIBRINGE as described by RAY was a real person, and LILLIBRINGE remembered the name he gave because it was similar to the name of a "vet back" he had known previously in prison.

RAY spoke of the possibility of obtaining colored contact leases to wear to change the color of his eyes in avoiding detection. RAY did not say where he would try to obtain contact lenses or that he had actually ever tried to obtain them or that he had ever vorn contact lenses. RAY'S eyes as LILLIBRINGE recalls them are a faded, pale blue, br "sky blue", and he would want to darken the appearance of his eyes in changing his appearance. He told LILLIBRIDGE how he had experimented in the past on portions of his skin covered by his clothing with staining his skin a darker color using some kind of "walnut dye". He had apparently tried the dye out of curiosity to see how long the stain would last, and be told LILLIBRIDGE that the dye would "just have to wear off". As to changing his appearance, LILLIBRIDGE feels it is significant to note that MAY'S weight would vary greatly from month to month. RAY would go through pariods of weight-lifting, strictly for the exercise, and he would occasionally become concerned over his weight from a health standpoint and would lose weight quickly. RAY was not a competitive weightlifter and would probably not seek out a gymnasiwa to practice wighlifting, but he was conserned over a heart problem he imagined that he bad, and he wanted the overeise to strengthen his heart. He mentioned that he knew it would be easy to obtain a fictitious Social Security care simply by filling in a form in any name, state that he had been self-employed, and he would be mailed a new Speial Secarity card. No did not mention any problem with regard to obtaining a driver's license under an assumed GREED,

RAY told LILLIBRIDGE about a shack he rented on the outskirts of Campeche, Mexico, and how he had considered the possibility of buying the shack instead of paying rent. Money and not paying more for anything than necessary was of constant concern to RAY. He told LILLIBRIDGE of the difficulty in

Mexico for a foreigner to own any property. He told of the practice of "Rentista Papers" through which a foreigner by paying a fee could receive permission from the Mexican Government to own a small business in Mexico or purchase property on a small scale in Mexico. He mentioned how it was an effort to have anything done by local Government officials in Mexico since everyone moved so slowly, and how in order to obtain "Rentista Papers" one would apparently have to pay two or three persons "under the table" for a few peses in order to get the papers through the Government red tape, and from his conversation, it appeared that RAY never was in Mexico long chough to wait out the process of obtaining "Rantista Papers".
